# ENTITIES IN THE HEADLIGHTS. © BY JORGE MARTÍN, Editor of EVIDENCIA OVNI

Sr. Miguel Calderón is the owner of an estate near Caguas in the Municipal area of Utuado (west-central part of the Island of Puerto Rico) - and it is to be noted that Arecibo, where the big Radio-Astronomical Observatory is, lies not far to the north of Utuado.

Sr. Calderón states that, one night in May or June of 1997, at about 8.30 - 9.00 p.m. he was driving his 1990 *Suzuki* jeep along the road from Mameyes in Utuado Municipal Area towards Caonillas when suddenly, at a distance of about 100

or 150 ft. ahead of him, he saw "two little boys" dressed in silver-coloured overalls, tight-fitting one-piece suits with turtle necks. They wore no helmets, and had very pale greyish-yellow skin and big black "Chinesey" eyes showing no pupils. The entities halted, and one of them raised an arm towards him. Instantly his engine cut out and his lights dimmed. His starter would not operate, his battery seemed dead. His radio had been playing, and that too was dead. His lights remained on, very faint.

Then the entity suddenly lowered its arm and both of



them totally silently shot straight up into the air and vanished into the night. His engine sprang into life again and, scared to death, he drove off at top speed.

And then came the reaction. First he began to weep violently, and then to vomit, and he was obliged to pull up for a while. He said that at no time had he glimpsed any craft or heard one.

As is reported in so many cases, Sr. Calderón said that throughout the experience he felt it totally impossible to take his eyes off the two beings, and something seemed to be telling him the whole time "Look at us! Look at us! Look at us!"

Jorge Martín asked him about their hands. He said that the hand held aloft by the one entity "looked like the gloves we use to handle hot things, with just the thumb separated and the remaining fingers all together as a whole. The gloves, also silvery, looked like part of the uniform itself."

Calderón said he had lived for 22 years in the Utuado area and that residents of the region were constantly

talking about incidents and episodes of this sort and at night were constantly seeing lights moving about in the sky, making sharp right-angle turns, and so on.

## UFOS OVER THE BRAZILIAN STATE OF BAHÍA (1998). © BY ALBERTO ROMERO,

Early in January 1998, at a place called Barreiras de Jacuruna in this State, a man (N - N - , unwilling to reveal his name) was lying in bed, but fully awake, when he suddenly became totally unable to open his eyes or to move, and felt the presence of "somebody" in the room. Then came the sensation that "something" was touching his head, and he felt what seemed to be a needle entering the rear part of his cranium, just behind one ear. Then slowly he felt the instruments following a precise trajectory inside his head and descending until it reached the dental arch. Throughout all of which, Sr. N - N - had not felt the slightest sensation of pain.

Then, shortly afterwards, he felt the needle being withdrawn, until it was right out. Then, instantly, he was able to open his eyes and move his body again.

At the time when this occurred, Sr. N - N - was living in the house of his brother-in-law Sr. V - S - (also unwilling to have his name divulged). And, two nights later, glancing out of a window, N - N - saw a grey figure which was walking away past the house and which was watching him as it went.

And, on the following night after that, Senhora M - S, the wife of Sr. V - S -, was sitting on her bed attending to her two-month-old baby, when she too felt the presence of "someone" behind her. At first she assumed that it was of course her husband - until, to her horror, she perceived two long whitish hands extended towards the infant!

Terrified, she shouted for her husband, who came at once. And then both of them saw something like a "faint, indistinct, light-coloured stain" moving away towards the door!

But this particular lady has been having "experiences" and phenomena in her house for years past! And it is very important that we do not fail to record one particularly striking event!

She was pregnant at the time, with her first baby. And she saw what seemed to be a "beam of light" enter the house between the tiles of the roof and descend towards her. She then watched it run slowly over every part of her body, pausing for a few instants right above

her lower abdomen. \*

And this lady also remembers "dreams" in which she seemed to have seen herself as a passenger aboard a helicopter which then proceeded to dive into the sea.

And, curiously enough - a nephew of this same lady has had an absolutely identical dream...

In other dreams that Sra. M - S - recalls, she says she has been taken to unknown places, one of them being a sort of hospital operating theatre, with dozens of people undergoing examinations. Some of the people, she recalls, were having sex-change operations - "for the sake of increased harmony", as it was explained to her!

We have not managed to proceed further with the investigation of this lady, M - S -, as we have been totally unable to persuade her to accept to be hypnotized.

But that is not the end of the stories at Jacuruna. For, between 22.00 hrs and 22.30 hrs. during the night of February 18, 1998, there were three reports of "lights" flying over the town.

One of the eyewitnesses, Sr. Renato dos Santos, says he saw, in a break in the overcast sky, five long cigar-shaped craft as big as commercial air-liners. When behind the clouds these "cigars" shone through them, "strangely luminous".
