

Cllr Hicks, an orthopaedic technician in the A&E department at the Royal Hampshire County Hospital for some 35 years, said he saw the creature at about 1.30pm on a Saturday in late January or early February 2004.

For five years he remained silent about his experience because he did not want it to jeopardise his chances of election to the city council. Now, two years after securing a place for the Liberal Democrats covering the St John and All Saints ward of Highcliffe, St Giles Hill, Bar End and Winnall, he says he is willing to risk ridicule as he tells of the encounter for the first time.

Hilary Porter continues the story:

Harry Challenger, Editor of Flying Saucer Review, informed Ken and I about a Lib Dem Councillor by the name of Adrian Hicks, who claimed to have witnessed an alien walking down one of the streets in Winchester, Hampshire, UK, in 2005, and so naturally we agreed that we would go and investigate. A few weeks later (March 11, 2009), we met up with Councillor Hicks, and spent one and half hours chatting, and he told us many important things.


He told us that he would soon be releasing all of his gathered information in a document to be called "Illumination, which he would put on the net, but first he wanted us to shoot from the hip and get this information out to the public. Adrian said that he first became aware of this alien being because it had a strange galt when it walked, which stood out from the crowd.

Also he noticed the odd clothing it was wearing he even caught up with this alien figure and saw it's features at closer quarters it was female with large, bug-like pink eyes, with no pupils! And Adrian wasn't alone in seeing all of this either: As Winchester is something of a tourist lure, there were others there, standing open-mouthed, watching, staring in disbelief and at least one person was taking



photographs of the spectacle of an alien who seemed to be happy, simply walking along amongst people, twirling her arms, smiling away without a care in the world. Then he said, she turned a corner and he quickly followed her, but she just vanished.

Since his encounter Adrian has found out quite a bit more about just what is going on near Winchester: His sources have revealed that the aliens we commonly call 'the Grevs'. are really called, (and I am unsure of the spelling here), Regelians and the Nordics are really called Prosalonians (again, unsure of exactly how this title is spelt), and it was suggested to him that these 2 aliens races, unofficially run this part of the world.




Because of his political position, some of Adrian's contacts now include members of the Hampshire Constabulary, who have been talking to him about the alien in Winchester. One detective constable informed Councillor Hicks that the aliens were coming from a nearby underground base at Morn Hill, Chilcomb. iust outside Winchester. He was told that the base is covered by Intech, which is a Science and Technology park. Constructed in 2002

complete it has a stunning white pyramid, and a domed planetarium. Intech is a science centre for children aged 6 and over. Not far from Intech is the Chilcomb Military Range, and this is the place where Adrian says UFO sightings and landings are reported.

UFO sighted Near Intech Cheesefoot Head, Just Outside Winchester, Hants, 10/05/09

Researcher Bob Schindler, visited a location near to Cheesefoot Head on Sunday 10/05/09 to conduct some sky watching, and captured this object flying low over the fields there. Bob said "I was just photographing the landscape; I noticed something moving out of the corner of my eye and thought it might have been a bird perhaps, but didn't really see this object properly whilst taking pictures.



Then I looked at the images on my camera, and there it was there on the first shot, this black object, then on the next shot it had gone." Bob asked BEAMS to examine the 2 images. Well, here they are, completely unaltered, with one exception; because Bob switched to a panoramic setting on the second shot, the picture was too wide and I have had to trim the ends off to fit it on this page. After magnification and other tests, I am left with no idea as to what the object might be. It is something real, that's for sure not a bird, bug or any plane.

The next image was taken on another expedition to Cheesefoot Head in 2009 near Telegraph Hill and again close to Intech; He saw this object hovering, before moving over the fields and away into the distance.

Unfortunately Bob only had a stills camera with him or he could have filmed the whole event. Now sceptics everywhere I'm, sure will say this is nothing but a child's helium balloon, coming to rest in the field but is this a genuine orb with a characteristic dark halo often seen in UFO images, perhaps the same type of thing that is seen elsewhere.

The area around Chilcombe was the location of the famous landed craft case of Joyce Bowles and Ted Pratt. The experiences of Joyce Bowles' began one evening in November, 1976. "We realised that three figures were watching us from a window in the cigar," said Mrs Bowles. "Then one of the figures materialised by the Mini. He peeped through my window at the dashboard controls and walked to the back of the car. Then he and the cigar-shaped craft simply vanished. "The figure was 6-ft-tall and wore a "silvery boiler suit"; incredibly, the being was sporting long blonde hair and a dark beard! Like the alien Councillor Hicks saw in more recent times, the eyes of the alien which had come over to Mrs Bowles' car, were pink and "as bright as the sun." Mrs Bowles found his stare "horrible," whereas Mr Pratt felt only "peace and tranquillity" when the entity gazed at him. The pink eyes appear in both the Winchester and Chilcombe encounter.

Comment by FSR:

Councillor Hicks has risked everything to bring this information out, he should be commended.

The hidden alien walking in our streets secretively enters our world, yet so few know of their presence here. The majority of the general public reacted to the Winchester humanoid story in the press with muted incredulity; they sat impassive lost in their total incomprehension that an alien was on a British street.

How can the hidden footsteps of an alien-human civilisation be so expertly superimposed on our own and yet remain an absurdly open secret only open to those who know? The hidden alien among us has come up frequently in some early South American humanoid cases, as well as in the friendship and early UMMO cases, where aliens centre in on a specific location for clandestine activity rather like cold war spies.

The technology of the Italian friendship case used underground facilities merged within the everyday landscape. **They did not need home-grown official involvement or our secret facilities.** It could be that if there were strange alien activities in or around Chilcombe that led to the Winchester city centre humanoid encounter it may have been without any official knowledge. We have to come to terms that we are all living in open alien territory; our world is wide open to alien humans who have mastered the awesome power of invisibility, mind control and feats of disguise for concealment within our society. We as the tiny minority interested in UFOs can only see tantalising clues of what they are up to.

The final summing up, should bring the alien working with our military into context. Ufology is full of rumour that there are aliens working in certain of our bases and liasing with our governments. Could this be an appearance that is expedient to both sides because we have no effective control of their activities? Is the reality that they can appear to witnesses reassuringly working alongside other humans like us but who may indeed turn out to be aliens as well?

The link with the Intech site also needs to be reconciled with good sense. The people associated with the educational site will be highly bemused by the rumour that there is alien activity associated with their facility, and with an associated embarrassment that children could become distracted from its serious primary purpose of science education. If we take the Italian friendship case into consideration, we can hypothesise that alien activity could have merged discreetly within any existing facility; perhaps, the association with the site was because of its status as a readily identifiable landmark on the landscape rather than anything else. It also needs to be taken into account that the Intech site could be a red herring. The aliens may just as readily work in plain sight; they would rather hide in the open. That would be logical. Witnesses suggest creatures like the Winchester alien could easily morph to merge into an everyday scene as one of us. What is fascinating is why one rebellious alien would choose not to and walk down a Winchester street

A final point needs to draw attention to the kind of objects observed and captured on film by Bob Schindler. The concept of humanoids emerging from floating beach ball sized spheres may only be familiar to a few hardened humanoid researchers, but that is what is reportedly seen travelling at ground level in areas of high UFO activity in Wiltshire and other select alien activity sites across Britain. Humanoids flying across the landscape may be far more common than is currently suspected.

These humanoid spheres are often luminous, can be solid or alternatively fade in or out of vision and appear to vaporise on hitting the ground. Of course they may disgorge a humanoid at this point that will be far larger than the sphere and he may emerge completely outside the visible spectrum. Humanoids are passing into our landscape in many ways, some travel in craft, some are traveling in spheres, some move as flying men. Antigravity and invisibility comes in many guises.

A good 20 year old sighting recently uncovered by FSR took place at Hunton Bridge in Hertfordshire. A large sphere was seen descending from the sky in plain sight. It landed in a field next to a busy road and disgorged a conventionally dressed human looking figure. It appeared to the middle aged male witness as almost a mundane exercise like stepping out of a lift. The figure walked out and casually moved off intent on blending in with a scene out of everyday life.

Glen Steckling takes us on a cosmic journey

2009-2010 saw the welcome return of the craft of home-grown pro-ufology conferencing in a long awaited return to the witnessed phenomenon yielded by observation of the alien identity at its core. Russell Kellet ran the autumn 2009 and summer 2010 conferences at Scarborough and Filey in North Yorkshire.

Those of us present in the last hour of Russell Kellett's talk on the last day of Scarborough saw something not seen for generations in ufology. People up on their feet gathering around a speaker, excitement in the room, voices calling out, as Russell delivered a stirring oratory simultaneous to showing a startling film.

In Russell's own summing up: "In the words of Simon and Garfunkel song, a man believes what he wants to believe and disregards the rest, do not disregard this! It is not an astronomical phenomenon, an aircraft or a balloon, this is what it is, an alien craft, if you deny it after seeing it in plain view, then I will show you a fool,"

The Skipsea UFO film was first mentioned by Russell in FSR 51.4, pq4, winter 2006 in a piece called "A UFO Interception over the North Sea in August 2002." This film shows a brightly lit object hovering under the clouds over the British North Sea coastal resort of Skipsea for over an hour. During its migration the object comes to the attention of a black triangular craft, which appears to strike the object with its hull repeatedly, a second triangle emerges from cloud cover in close proximity. This extraordinary film is definitive evidence of the title of our Winter 2006 issue: Is There A Secret War? It is unequivocal: a hostile interception caught on film. Russell's object appears to 'pull in' nine gold lights from ground level before it departs: what are these projectiles are they humanoids or even abductees drawn up into the craft? Whatever they are, they are strong evidence of a completely unknown state of affairs.

Russell is perhaps the boldest ufologist in his exposure of the shadowmen and their influence behind the facade of normality we all buy into. He advocates that many of the abductees and contactees that have been experimented on have in fact been trained to fulfill a designated purpose for a planned conflagration in our future.

The keynote speaker at Flying Saucers Have Landed was Glen Steckling of the George Adamski Foundation. Glen's manner was impeccable as was his grasp of the cosmic proportions of the human alien equation. The sheer longevity of this man's involvement in the UFO question, started from a unique childhood raised alogside Adamski where his father was Adamski's most trusted aide. Steckling gave real insight into the kind of knowledge which, starts with an unassuming modesty that differs markedly from those far more vocal figures in ufology who have had far less direct involvement with a major figure of contact. Glen brought with him a visual treat: the digitally re-mastered Adamski films.

There were moments of impact for us as speakers: meeting a working man from Newcastle, a visitor to the conference who had recently had an encounter near Scarborough. Alongside 7 other witnesses he had encountered something which, terrified him, a story he was still too traumatised and unwilling to go into, his palpable fear was evident to us all. He was symbolic of the sense of abandonment and fear that comes when someone who is not prepared suddenly meets aliens in the flesh.

We also had a humbling experience from a very bright autistic boy who attended the conference with his father. He had seen a flying saucer and there-after loved the idea of having further encounters. His face was full of a wonder and exquisite human innocence that we will never forget. He brought it all home to us, telling us about the empowerment of every human face that is filled with wonder, each having tio deal with his or her own limited understanding yet still trying to grasp this human alien story. Perhaps deep within ourselves; we each have to face it with all our humanity.
