The Allies of Humanity

An Urgent Message About Extraterrestrial Presence in the World Today

The Allies of Humanity: An Urgent Message About the Extraterrestrial Presence in the World Today is a summary of channeled messages received by Marshall Vian Summers. He was apparently chosen to be the spokesman for a group of spiritual beings that call themselves humankind's "allies."

According to Summers' book, the allies are here to warn the indigenous inhabitants of Earth that we are subtly being invaded by several groups of alien races. Although these beings are allegedly in competition for the resources of Earth, they are working in cooperation to employ the human race to harvest the natural resources of our planet.

Because they want to preserve these resources, Summers tells us, they are not here to destroy anything but to influence us to go along with them. The allies tell Summers that there are very few of these beings, and hence they have employed a four-fold strategy, which enables their small numbers to manipulate and pacify the vast populations of the Earth.

The invaders seek to (1) mentally and emotionally influence those in power directly through thought projections or (2) through religious impulses in order to (3) establish a physical presence that will enable them to continue and speed up their (4) ongoing interbreeding program.

The allies, who tell Summers the Creator has sent them, are here to observe these events and report to humanity so that we may have a chance to take back our God-given right to freewill and our own natural resources. Humans have allowed this attempted conquest to happen because, they say, we have not developed our mental abilities to the extent that our invaders have. But the book also notes that the invaders do not have the sense of individuality inherent in human beings. This, say the allies, is their weakness.

If humanity can learn the Way of Knowledge, or the "way of inner knowing," they maintain that we can reclaim our freewill and successfully rise into the greater galactic community. We would then be able to define the rules of the game for ourselves and interact with the multitudes of physical and spiritual beings who reside there.

Unlike many other books of this channeled type, *The Allies of Humanity* is written in an easy-to-read style. It appears that the allies have actually used an editor! Many books of this type—I don't want to mention any names—are plagued

with run-on sentences, weird phrasings, and strange words which have the potential to cloud the intended message. Here, though, the information is accessible.

However, like many of these types of books, the emphasis is on the message. Inevitably, no scientific data or research is included to support the intended communications. This will no doubt cause problems for those seeking scientific corroboration before something can be taken as valid. The allies, though, say that the message is designed to ring true in a person's heart and mind. Besides, says Summers, plenty of evidence supports the allies' claim. In fact, there are striking parallels with this essential message and what today's UFO and conspiracy researchers have found.

I noticed as I read the book that their description of the Way of Knowledge sounded a lot like gnosticism, shamanism, or witchcraft—what many commonly refer to as magic. This is supported by the work of Jordan Maxwell, who has come to the conclusion that society itself is a magical ritual designed to mentally influence the human race; or that of Michael Tsarion, who holds that a creative force is acting through inspiration to wake people up to not only the alien presence on Earth today but humanity's alien/human hybrid history.

Even without scientific back-up, there is clearly much evidence to support the allies' claims. A mammoth body of data acquired by MUFON suggests an intervention or visitation scenario is occurring on Earth today. Many American Indians are coming forward with their knowledge of the alien presence; the work of Nancy Red Star would be a good example of this. Says Summers, "What it boils down to is that it doesn't matter who the allies are, because they are not here to intervene for us. They are simply here to tell us that if we do not take back our power of freewill soon, it could be lost forever." UFO
