His diagram of a flying saucer mechanism, involving fixing carbon with acid is equally challenging as both the cancer cure and the saucer contain elements of the vital conversion process used in alchemy. By January 1974, a final letter states Maceiras is now practically insane. Another casualty of an alien mind-altering technology?

Another psychic link mediated by bursts of light and ozone? Extract from an article by Sebastian Robiou Lamarche (Stendek September 1973). Translation: Jane Thomas Guma. Glendale, AZ, USA December 2007

Young Ricardo Martínez Rivera, 17, actually resides in Cataño, Puerto Rico. In 1964, together with an uncle and his maternal grandmother, he witnessed a UFO in the early hours of the night. "We saw a formation of 12 or 16 bright objects, cigar shaped, and flying at a fantastic speed. For a moment I got scared and got into the car then I felt like a sense of peace, of ecstasy and got out of the car some months later I started to feel the need to write strange things."

Some two years passed before the witness started to write real

hieroglyphs. "I don't enter into any kind of trance. A short time ago I was feeding my fish which is something nobody stops me from doing and suddenly I had a strong desire to write, a need to write. I'm capable of controlling my hand but don't want to do it. I can tell you that when I get this need and resist it I get a headache. Sometimes I tried to resist it but I couldn't."

Young Martínez told us that during the last 1972 Wave in Puerto Rico he had another UFO sighting. Although he doesn't recall the exact date, he believes it happened on August 1972. "At about 10.45 am I saw an object in the shape of a cigar; it looked more pointed in the ends; maybe it was a disc on its side, silvery and metallic looking. I saw it when it flew over the Levittown water tank". A curious fact was that according to the witness "the wish to write was stronger before and during the last UFO Wave". From the 10 pages compiled these last times, "more than half were written before August 1972". That would be before the UFO Wave in this geographic area. What is the meaning of these scribbles? "I'm anxious to know what all this means it's possible they may mean something

but I don't know. I'm under the impression that they are read the way they are written in columns from right to left, and from top to bottom."

He also states that he had the impulse several times to draw strange things, amongst them the face of an enigmatic being, reproduced in Fig. 16 together with writing samples. The witness also claims having seen "more than five times a circular and bright flash like a beam of light", which never lasts "more than 2 seconds". Some three times the incident was preceded by an "ozone-like odour or a penetrating odour" which at one time was noticed by people with him. On the other hand, the witness claims to have predicted several events that later happened. We are investigating to try to verify them.

FSR Commentary: Is this flash the action of mind altering technology at work, the telepathic key to directing remote influence into a human mind. Are the clairvoyant episodes the consequence of time slips in the subject's altered state of consciousness?

Buhler's Little Box.

The late Brazilian contact researcher Walter Buhler took a special interest in cases of telepathy and mind manipulation. He was ideally placed in the right country during the peak incidences of humanoid activity from the 1950's to the 1990s, his witnesses being poor agricultural people had very little to gain by manufacturing their stories and very little cultural contamination, so he was uniquely placed to get a grip on alien humanoid communication.

In a letter to FSR in 1994 Buhler identifies a piece of technology that may be responsible for broadcasting telepathic speech directly into the humanoid witness's brain.

In contactee Onilson Patero's first meeting with a ufonaut (SBEDV bulletin 94/98, pg36) we described the following observation, "We only suspected that the little box represented an extraterrestrial "language translator" when we heard of other cases where a little box featured." The Brazilian case of Jesus Antonio Moreira, a security guard at the Hydro-Electric Plant at Marimbondo, stated that he was contacted by the team of a flying device. The witness at first was unable to understand the language spoken by the

ufonauts, but one of the three got hold of a gadget the size of a shoe box which was held at shoulder height and suddenly he was able to understand and the conversation began. (Pg 88 White blood of Flying Saucers, Guilherme Ferreira, Wendelle Stevens, Ney M Pires, and WK Buhler). The nature of the language-voice-transmission may be still more evident when we focus on the "means of communication" as described in SBEDV bulletin 132/135 pg 34. The case of Brazilian farmer Arlindo Gabriel dos Santos of the town of Baependi in the highlands of the state of Minas Gerais. Arlindo realised that the lip movements of the ufonaut weren't synchronised with the words he heard. He had some very curious comments about it. In Arlindo's case we came to the understanding that there may have been not a translation of words, but of cerebral signals. Were those signals sent out by Arlindo then transformed by the "language transformer" and emitted to the ufonauts and then in reverse from the ufonauts brains to the transmitter and then transformed by Arlindo's brain into the Portuguese "signals" which express the sounds and names to him? (Notably, Buhler refers to the signals as "keys" a very similar word to Desmond

Leslie's use of the term to describe cases that involved telepathic conversation as a way of authenticating cases in the early days of ufology before this fact was widely known).

A clear cut incident of telepathic transmission is the Venezuelan case at San Pedro de Los Altos, in Los Teques (some 50-60 km from Caracas) which took place on August 7th 1965. This case was investigated by the Venezuelan ufologist Horacio Gonzales Ganteaume, in his correspondence with Ganteaume; Gordon Creighton describes it as a "KEY CASE." A gynaecologist and two industrialists were interrupted by a saucer landing while they were inspecting thoroughbred horses. They were approached by two blonde Nordics of two metres in height. All three of the witnesses heard a voice telling them at the same time "Do not be afraid! Calm yourselves." The peculiar aspect of this voice was that they did not see any lips moving or any other movement on the part of the strange beings. They heard the message in their heads or rather in the brain. This confused them and their confusion seemed to be understood by the blonde creatures because they heard another voice telling them, "We are speaking to you directly!" The men then understood that they were having a telepathic communication.

Could this same hypothetical alien telepathic technology also be responsible for conducting telepathy into electronic communications media?

The late British crop circle researcher and UFO enthusiast Dave Probert described a remote voice in his car in 1990 repeatedly shouting at him to "Stay out of the crop circles!" He felt that this voice was being deliberately beamed into his car. Were all these gross electronic manifestations of a much more advanced subtle mind altering technology?

FSR Commentary: *Perhaps on occasion this telepathic technology can act as a transmitter itself and superimpose its data signal onto any given electronic media. What if the following often times confusing poltergeist like audio signals are directed by telepathic technology:*

The radio messages of Valdar and the Confederation of Planets described in communications to a man called Edwin in Durban, South Africa in the 1960s.

The tape recorded voices and musical notes recorded by Philip Rodgers in the Peak District in the 1960s?

The audio taped messages that followed the Scoriton encounter investigated by Eileen Buckle and Norman Oliver in 1966.

The telephone calls from alleged aliens to Arthur Shuttlewood of Warminster in the 1970s?

The voice of 'Asteron' heard on television sets across the South of England in 1979.

The true number of such voices may have been legion.

A letter from the late Walter Buhler in a letter to FSR dated March 1987 Records the following. *A girl from Mirassol on a visit to the state capital of Sao Paulo was copying music to tape from a record. To her astonishment no music appeared on the tape but instead a stern admonishment from a person calling him self Ashtar was heard. He warned against the irresponsible paranoia of Earth governments with regard to nuclear*

experiments. On a further trip to the Southern state of Parana the girl was astonished to find another friend had witnessed same message over local FM radio which she also recorded on tape. She then kept quiet about the incident as she became scared by the blunt and strong language used by messenger who called himself Ashtar. It has come to me that this message has been heard elsewhere in Brazil, what if message has appeared in other countries better developed than Brazil, an identical message maybe in the local language.

There are many classic cases of saturation of phone lines with babbling alien voices or MIB interrogators during UFO encounters. Perhaps this straight to brain hypothesis is the key to the bizarre conversations from spacemen heard through telephone, audio tape, radio and television. Perhaps the gobbledygook often received in telepathic electronic-voice-phenomena are corrupted wavelenghts falling outside the ideal tidal spectrum of successful internal brain communication and thus will be a significant responsible for provoking meaningless audio hallucinations.

During his lifetime Walter Buhler provided us with abundance of telepathic evidence; the Hildebrando Martini case in the state of Rio de Janeiro of mid-July 1970 described intriguing evidence for this; Hildebrando Martini and his wife saw an immense glow coming from a military academy at Agulhas Negras, at the same moment both he and his wife a strange vibration in the brain which lasted 4-5 seconds. They noticed that the academy lights had gone out and their vehicle was facing the wrong way on the road home. Ten minutes before their probable abduction there was bombardment of the telephone lines of their home town with electronic voices. An employee of Martini, Lenir Alves Pec noticed that the telephone would not stop ringing. When he put it to his ear he could hear strange voices in it, also the doorbell would not stop ringing. Pedrosa said they were 'gabblers' rattling away non-stop in a sort of 'blah blah' voice. The same phenomenon had been noticed on a good number of telephones in the vicinity including the telephones of the railway station where one of Martini's friends worked.

A note by Harry Challenger on telepathic messages

Was this alien telepathic technology sweeping the minds of the inhabitants of an area by telephone? Was this a critical point to the multiple nonsense calls, perhaps transmitted by a telepathic technology to identify and locate Hildebrando Martini or one of his associates by reading the minds of his friends?

Having experienced this technology on stepping out of my house, the headlamps and internal light were on in my car without the ignition keys, there was a burning smell in the air then all of a sudden my head felt like it was under immense pressure as held under a great depth of water. An image of three women in a flying saucer was fixed in my mind in a location. We proceeded to the venue the following weekend and viewed the object as it sat hovering in the landscape.

The 777 East Field Crop Formation; What Does it Mean? By Winston Keech

We now turn to another pioneer in computer programming, Winston Keech, who in his own research capacity as a technologist, captured the precise timeframe and location of a crop circle forming on the 7th of July 2007 in East

Field Alton Barnes in Wiltshire. Keech is also a trained analyst of video evidence which allows for insights into analysing the crop circle as a legitimate channel of alien communication despite the orchestration

discouragement that wrecked this promising field of research ten years ago. From his work in artificial intelligence, Keech has evolved into an eminent theorist on the concepts behind organising data that could account for our recognition of innate intelligent responses in both artificial and natural systems. Could it be that the radical ideas of accomplished programmers like those of Winston Keech and Gerry Zeitlin will carry the high credibility we need for the next blossoming of our subject?

Much has been said about the 777 crop formation in East Field at Alton Barnes in Wiltshire, some commentators have ventured sweeping claims without any examination of the depth of the evidence. My reputation has been questioned by people who don't even know me and I certainly don't need them to tell me who they think I am or what I have witnessed and recorded. The phenomenon itself has danced with me for

these past sixteen years and I know it considers me little more than an inquisitive ant but unlike these detractors at least it cares enough about me, to laugh at me and throw me the odd bone from the table. Allowing me to film this event on 777 was one such bone.



For the sake of clarity, I have given only one interview concerning this incident and that is the well known half hour interview with the well known film maker and investigator Terje Toftenes from Norway. The half hour film was made at Terje's request soon after the formation occurred to try to preserve the witness testimonies as accurately as possible as quickly as possible. This Terje did and he should be congratulated for that. I stand by every word spoken in that interview. It was the best level of investigative findings at that time and the clips I agreed that Terje could use within it are just that, snippets of the full dataset; seconds taken from over fifteen hours of video and hundreds of still photos from that night. Many have asked why I have not released more. Unfortunately when the vast majority of responses were hostile to the point of abusive this was not possible (The little I released to the BBC for their website was in thanks for their genuine interest).

I understand that what we are looking at here is far beyond most people's comfort zone. The recorded data is what it is and the phenomenon doesn't give a jot what you or I or anyone else thinks it is or what it should be. So I will leave the detractors to get over it. It is the message that is most important, not who I am or what type of cameras I used or any

of that; this is my understanding of what was shown to me that night. I have written for this publication (FSR) because I have met members of its staff over the years, out on those hilltops in the dark and rain trying their hardest to understand and record just this. In spirit this is as much their success as it is my own.

Was this formation a hoax? No it was not! I would not be very interested in it at all if it was, nor would I stand up and face this barrage of hostile fire to bring it forward if it was anything less than important. Not only is there no sign of hoaxing in the video (almost continuous from 11pm to 4am), the difficulty of surveying a massive and perfect formation in the cloudy, almost pitch darkness of that night; with camera killing wind driven condensation combined with the difficult topography of the field itself almost instantly rules it out. For me, as soon as I saw the message I knew it could only be genuine. When the scientist in me entered the almost untouched formation and saw multi-weave lays and expulsion cavities in the un-buckled stalks I knew for certain. (To non-crop circle initiates this evidence of gross intense heat across the crop and intricate multilayered design has always been a benchmark of authentic formations).

The understanding of this summer's message originates in this same field sixteen years ago. This was my first ever expedition to Wiltshire, originally to see if I could find a direct link between UFOs and the circles. What I encountered was not what I had expected or planned for. I watched the field from my old Land Rover, tucked away in an overgrown corner below Milk Hill. With each night I became increasingly aware of an unseen presence that began to distract me from the golden yellow and white balls flying around the area most nights, which my video camera of the time could most times, just film. I felt it teasing and taunting, but had no idea what it was.

In the still of night, around 3 am I leapt to the cameras (one
