#### **EDITORIAL**

#### WHY NO LONGER ANY "LETTERS SECTION"?

n FSR subscriber recently wrote to me asking why I had discontinued the "Readers' Letters" Section, and my answer to him was simply that, whereas I did once receive a steady flow of interesting communications from our readers, for months and months past scarcely anything of the sort has been reaching me any more.

One may safely deduce, I think, that **interference** is occurring: **Dirty tricks** are being played. (Remember that it is now SIXTEEN years since any publicity or mention of either FSR or myself has been permitted in any TV or radio programme in this country.)

That is not to say that enquiries to me from individuals in TV, radio or newspapers have not been frequent. I would estimate that in the past five years, for example, ATLEAST TWENTY APPROACHES TO ME HAVE BEEN MADE, EITHER IN WRITING OR, MORE USUALLY, BY TELEPHONE. IN ALL CASES, ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE FOR THEM TO COME AND INTERVIEW. ME. NOT ONE OF THEM HAS ARRIVED.

So far as I am aware, there **has not yet** been any sign of actual interference with readers' money. (After all, it isn't nice to be seen to be too blatantly dishonest, is it?) But how can one be sure that before long the next stage in the process will not have been initiated, and the screws in the stranglehold against FSR given another wee turn?

The society in which we live is a putrid one, and one that doesn't have much longer to run. So, whatever happens next, it shouldn't surprise us overmuch. That for hapless citizens there could be any hope of redress in the face of this kind of situation is **extremely** improbable. As I have said before, there isn't really all that much difference between our present type of society and the regimes recently prevailing in Germany and Russia, and still prevailing in China, North Korea, Iran, Cuba and elsewhere.

As a matter of fact, however, some of the methods now being employed in Britain were actually **invented and perfected** here long ago, in the days of "Good Queen Bess", when William Cecil ( Lord Burghley ), Elizabeth's famous counsellor and right-hand man, laid the foundations for British postal censorship, for the art of cryptography, and for the British Secret Service. So, for centuries past, we have had folk here who were pastmasters at the game.

Today the British Postal and Telephonic systems are unrivalled. Just as at remote Pine Gap, Australia is controlled by a foreign power that -in its turn- is most probably under the control of yet another foreign -i.e. alien-power, so too Britain has its very own "fibre optics" centre at Menwith Hill, near Oswestry (52° 52" N, 03° 03" W), Shropshire, where they have about thirty "golf-ball radomes" devoted to the careful study of all messages passing through the country.

For the dispensing of such attentive "treatment" it would be foolish to imagine that vast hordes of "listening personnel" are any longer required. Apparatus programmed to pick up key words and figures can be safely relied upon to do all the work.

As for the little matter of "who is actually in the driving-seat" here you can safely be left to draw your own conclusions. If, as it seems, it is "aliens" at Pine Gap, and "Area 51", then why shouldn't it also be "aliens" at Menwith Hill?

And, if they are "aliens", what reason is there for assuming that they care a hoot about the interests of the lesser forms of life like you and me.


That "other", and "higher", Cosmic Authorities do exist, is certain, and we must hope that These will prevail here in the end!

#### **BOAINAI REVISITED**

ost skeptics tend to overlook the fact that of the thousands of UFO reports filed in government and other archives during the last half century, many fit into the 'classic' category. These reports are made by multiple witnesses, often including professionally trained observers, involve daylight/dusk sightings, detailed corroborative evidence from many sources, and have been subjected to exhaustive investigation.

These sightings are termed 'classic' because of the volume of detail available and the fact that they cannot be acounted for in conventional terms, or for that matter by the implausible concoctions that some imaginative skeptics are able to conjure up.

One remarkable series of sightings which occured in Australian administered territory happened at Boainai Mission on the north-east coast of Papua in June, 1959. The whole case is well worth recalling as some readers may not be familiar with, or perhaps have long forgotten, the amazing sequence of events.

Stephen Moi, a mission school teacher, and other locals, described for the Rev. Father William Gill, a Church of England clergyman stationed at Boainai Mission, their observation of a very brightly lit object that hovered over the sea, gradually decreasing in brilliance and taking the shape of a saucer. At the time Father Gill, although personally strongly skeptical, wrote out a formal report on the sighting and sent it to Rev. D. Druiry in Australia. By way of postscript Father Gill

wrote, "My simple mind still requires scientific evidence before I can accept the 'from out of Space' theory. \* I am inclined to think that many unidentified objects are more likely to be some kind of electrical phenomenon. I prefer to wait for some bright boy to catch one and exhibit it in Martin Place".

Subsequent events caused Father Gill to change his point of view. On June 26, 1959, at 6.45 pm, standing in front of the mission house looking out to sea, he saw a brilliant light which began to descend towards him. Joined by two of the mission teachers at this point, he began to take notes of the events, as the light approached and then receded. Suddenly the object came to within about three hundred feet of the watchers and remained still for some time. They noted that it was circular, had a wide base and a narrower upper structure and appeared to have two sets of protruding legs on

the base. At periodic intervals a shaft of blue light emanated from the centre of the craft.

What happened next astounded the small group of observers. A human-like figure appeared on top of the UFO, soon to be joined by three others. Father Gill was later to write in his documentary of events, "As we watched it 'men' came out from the object and appeared on what seemed to be a deck on top of the huge disc. There were four figures in all, but only occasionally were all on view at once."

The group watched the UFO until 7.20 pm when the figures disappeared and it moved into cloud. At. 8.29 another smaller craft was seen over the sea and at 8.35 still another was sighted over Wadobuna village. The large craft reappeared at 8.50 and was stationary until 9.20 pm. Meanwhile the other two UFOs kept coming and going, reflecting light from their surfaces and could be seen clearly by the watching party.

The next day Father Gill questioned the locals and thirty-eight people besides himself signed a document testifying to their sightings. At about 6pm on the next evening (27th June) what looked like the original craft returned to the same spot. In very good light, the witnesses were able to see four figures appearing to be involved in some work on the upper deck. Father Gill wrote, "one figure seemed to be standing looking down at us. I stretched my hand above my head and waved. To our surprise the figure did the same".

In an effort to persuade them to land, one of the

teachers flashed a torchlight at the UFO crew. In response "it swung like a pendulum", Father Gill wrote, "presumably in recognition..... it hovered, came quite close towards the ground.... and we actually thought it was going to land, but it did not. We were very disappointed about that."

On the next day, Sunday 28th June, the UFOs were back for four hours, eight craft being seen at the same time appearing to shimmer and give off silvery light.

There is no doubt that these sightings, clear and detailed, seen over prolonged periods of time, multiple-witnessed, cannot be explained away as objects from within our normal spectrum of reality.

Incidentally, we now know that "strange lights" were often seen in the night skies over Papua even before 1914.■

#### CHUPACABRAS GALORE!

Some months ago, in ENIGMAS 2/2, we had a big report on *chupacabras*, which has led to widespread discussion. And now recent happenings in Portugal (ENIGMAS 2/10) and also in certain regions of Spain, give rise to speculation as to whether or not we already have in fact *chupacabras* here killing sheep in both of our countries?

While of course some of these reports of dead sheep (which reports are *numerous* in recent months in both Spain and Portugal) can indeed genuinely be attributed to ordinary causes — predators etc. — it looks as though we really do have the *chupacabras already!* (And maybe it is *not* something new after all, but something - concrete and real — as past historical cases do indicate).

Furthermore, contrary to certain folk who have tried to deny it, *chupacabra* activity is moreover still going on, not only in Puerto Rico, but also in other regions of Central America — *particularly Mexico*, where there is a total publicity blackout on it.

From the Cosmos foundation (Fundación Cosmos) in Monterrey, Mexico, we recently received this report by the engineer Marco A. Reynoso: -

"The *chupacabras* is a latent danger for all mankind. The results of necropsies performed by doctors of the Cosmos Foundation indicate that the perforations in the thoracic cavity go right straight down, converging on the heart, which is destroyed, along with the other vital organs, liver and lungs etc; the blood is totally extracted, — at times together with some organ or other, via the perforations, the diameter of which runs from 1cm. to 1.5cm.

"In 70% of the cases, there are sightings of UFOs in the same night or the preceding night, but we still have not been able to find a direct relationship between

the two phenomena — the UFO sightings and the killings.

"On the Island of Puerto Rico the gagging policy does not go to such extremes as in Mexico. However, certain TV channels did receive threats that their licences might be revoked because they were "alarming the population unnecessarily."

"The results of the blood analysis and genetic analysis made on samples of hair and blood from the *chupacabras* are themselves thoroughly alarming. It states textually: -

"From the results of the analysis it is deduced that it is impossible for us to place the characteristics found in the sample alongside those of any organism known to us. The organism from which that sample originated could be the product of a highly sophisticated genetic manipulation, or it could be an organism strange to our environment, or it could maybe be a species of animal totally unknown to mankind."

Other *preliminary* analyses of sub-types and analyses of a genetic nature are not yet conclusive, but the results obtained so far indicate that the sample studies come from an organism that is unknown to the present-day science.

On September 7, 1996, the Portuguese newspaper *Jornal de Noticias* carried the following article which already mentions the *chupacabras* in connection with attacks on flocks of sheep:-

"In connection with the deaths of sheep in Portugal and Spain, one of the Portuguese TV channels conducted a reportage comparing incidents in Portugal with those that had occurred in Latin America. The doubt as to whether it was a question of *chupacabras* having crossed the Atlantic or it was the work of some conventionally

known animal greatly alarmed the cattle breeders of this region and of other regions of Portugal.

Therefore, following the example of other countries with problems of this type, *The Portuguese Ministry of Agriculture attempted to make it clear that the killings had definitely been caused by a wolf.* Their spokesman, the veterinarian Alvaro Lopes, stated this publicly in the local newspaper, *Gazeta Do Interior*, at the same time as he criticized the sensational nature of the report put out on television. Nevertheless, we ourselves know that he was very surprised indeed by the wounds on the carcases of the dead cattle and was quite unable to say *what* animal could have caused them. He actually said as much to a person whose name we obviously are unable to mention.

A biologist, Pedro Sarmento, also said it was a wolf - but no ordinary wolf - an extremely intelligent and experienced one!

The most striking feature in killings of this kind are the orifices found in the dead animals' necks. And some folk even adduce the most fatuous solutions in their zeal to clear up the mystery. For example, on September 10, 1996, the provincial Portuguese newspaper *Povo Da Beira* carried the following story:-

#### TOOTHLESS WOLF KILLS NINE SHEEP. MYSTERY UNRAVELLED AT LA RAIA.

At Touloes, a place in the district of Idanha-A-Nova, the population were shaken by the mysterious cases of sheep found dead with an orifice in the neck.... At first the veteriniarians were to a certain extend intrigued over what had happened, because it had been observed that there was a tiny orifice on the animals which, *just by itself, had sufficed to cause their deaths.* Finally however it was given out that the mystery slayer of the 28 sheep — already known locally as a "chupacabras" — was nothing but an old wolf who had come down from the top mountains in search of food.

The results of the studies conducted by biologists and veterinarians had however permitted the final conclusion that it was simply a matter of "one old wolf with one single canine tooth."

Grotesque as this "explanation" is the *Pova Da Beira* was not the only newspaper that put it around, for, a few days earlier, the Spanish newspaper *El Mundo*, in Madrid, had carried a similar report:

#### PSYCHOPATH WITH A DOG.

"One hundred dead sheep found in Vizcaya (Spain's Basque Region. G.C.), all with a puncture hole in the neck. The cattle farmers think the perpetrator of the massacre is a psychopath who has, as a companion, an animal with one single tooth".

To learn more about this, we visited the region in question, the Valley de las Encartaciones.

We knew that the ERTZAINTZA (I presume this is the Basque name for the *Police* or the *Security*? G.C.) were in charge of the investigations, so it was to them that we went. To tell the truth, given the 'delicate political-social situation' of the Basque community, our hopes of finding out anything worthwhile were scanty in the extreme. However we must stress the very friendly

way in which they did treat us and also the value of the information that was given to us. We were allowed access to the archives, and saw the depositions, along with prints of the photos of the dead animals, and we were also given the addresses and telephone numbers of the people involved.

With regard to the wounds on the dead animals, a policeman, Fernando Gardiazábal, who had had the job of checking up on some of the statements made by eyewitnesses, assured us that the wounds did not look as though caused by wolves.

One particular detail, namely the nature of the strange instrument used in making the wounds, cropped up again here, as can be deduced from the words of one of the people. He said:

"A number of the animals had various of their bones and their vertebrae destroyed by some sort of needle introduced through the neck".

One of the people who recently lost a number of sheep was José Luis Ribacoba. With a certain degree of surprise he remarked:

"Apart from the fact of these wounds being very strange, it is puzzling how none of the animals ever recover.

"Years ago, some wolf would turn up and would wreak some damage. He would carry off a sheep. And that was that. Sometimes he would even tear off a few kilos of flesh from the hindquarters of a calf or a horse. When we discovered such cases, the animal would be very weak, but we trimmed off the hair and treated the wound with permanganate of potash and a concoction of herbs, and the wound would then heal up, and even though the wound had been a severe one, the animal would survive and would be alright. But these wounds nowadays are far, far smaller, and yet they do not heal."

To our query as to what *he* thought was the cause of these wounds, he replied:

"I don't know. Of course it is something new something that we never saw previously. But I don't know
what it is ... And the ERTZAINTZA still tell me nothing.
They tell me that they are investigating, but I don't know
whether they are saying this to calm us down or whether
they really are doing anything".

Another man, Ricardo Fernández, of Balmaseda, has got almost no sheep left. He has had 30 killed in these same circumstances, and in one night, in the Angostura area.

He doesn't think it is a wolf either. He thinks it is some dog with a killer instinct, which has 'gone wild'. He said: "Folk abandon their dogs when they go away on holiday, and the dogs take to the hills and 'go wild'".

Two other men who have seen their flocks of sheep cut down in recent months are Manuel Trasviña and Felix Diego.

The mountainous regions of Espaladaseca, Urbaliza, Islo, Angostura, Antuñano and Tromosamos are some of the settings in which the sheep-killings have occurred. And, further to the south, the Sierra de Urbasa is an area where the local bucolic tranquility has been shattered by incursions of the mysterious killer-beast.

José Vedayo, a cattle-breeder from Olazagutía,

found one of his colts dead. The animal had one wound in the neck and another on one side of the hindquarters.

We decided that we would ourselves pay a visit to the Sierra de Ubasa - a region hitherto only known to us from the cinema. The journey up to El Raso is almost like an initiatory trip prior to the achievement of Glory! Away up there, so near to the sky, amid the copses of beech trees and the rocks, we were snatched out of our idyllic rural reveries by the sudden sight of a tall shepherd emerging from one of the huts, an axe in hand.

One of the cattlemen there told me that there had never been wolves in that region. He said: "The sheep have always slept out in the open here and nothing has ever happened before".

The same opinion was expressed to us by Anna-María Ormazábal and her children Roberto and Juan María Olazarán. All the same, they are quite certain that wolves are involved - not because they have normally been there but *because somebody released the wolves there!* They say: "The area where they are active is very specific and defined. Someone *must* have put the wolves there, because, had the wolves come from elsewhere they would have left tracks. And they haven't left tracks. Somebody released them here."

The curious thing is that these 'wolves' kill their victims, suck out their blood, and then leave the flesh intact.....

Roberto, her son, assures us that one night, right beside his flock of sheep, he saw two pairs of big eyes that made a great impression on him. It is for this reason that these folk have no doubts whatsoever about the 'wolf'. (But what if it were a question of some other 'impossible' creature?. See ENIGMAS, year II, No. 7).

However the facts of the situation may be, the whole business is a tremendous nuisance in the areas where it is occurring. As Anna-María Ormazábal explained to us: "The farm animals aren't the same now as they used to be. When night falls they come home themselves, because they are scared. Previously they would sleep out there on the hillsides, and wandered far afield. Also they now yield far less milk than previously."

#### "A PAIR OF PUMAS".

This is however not the first time that the stockmen of these areas have faced such problems. In 1986, the flocks of sheep in the Cinco Villas region of Aragón Province suffered attacks from a dangerous aggressor. The newpaper *Diario De Navarra* reported the events as follows:-

"The strange animal that is attacking the sheep in the Ribera Alta area of Navarra Province is, it seems, large, very agile, and runs very fast, though nobody has been able to identify it, so that speculation about it still continues".

As in other cases investigated by us, diverse and contrary opinions exist. Some say "It's wolves", and others say: "Dogs gone wild". Yet other investigators claim that it is a sort of big cat. The manager of the Lanar Group's enterprises in the region, Sr. Enrique Malo, says: "It's a clever animal, very fast, and one that doesn't attack man".

Some speculations are that the perpetrators are a couple of pumas and their young. This rumour is based on the discovery of some very large footprints - some of them of the size of a human hand - while there are others which are smaller than that. Regarding the creature's method of action, Sr. Malo continues: "The puma is an amimal that can pick up a scent at five kilometres. It does not attack cattle when man is around. Normally it enters and leaves via the same spot, and with an extraordinary rapidity it has jumped over fences more that 2 1/2 m. high".

One feature that has forcibly struck the people living in these areas of Spain is the creature's wide radius of action. This leads them to deduce that the father puma may operate from one side and the mother and kittens from the other side.

Equally unexplained by anyone is of course the *origin* of these 'pumas' in Spain! Some say that they escaped from a circus that was performing in Fraga. Others think the person responsible is "El Alemán", the German", - a very strange gentleman — according to local opinion — who trains hunting hounds at his farm, "La Carbonera".

Someone has claimed that, a few years ago, during a fire at this farm, they had seen two puma cubs there. However, when the Guardia Civil (Police) questioned "the German" about this, he denied ever having owned such animals. Some people whom we know recently visited him and remarked to us that he was a totally normal man and that there was of course nothing 'strange' about him.

Shortly after that, we were told that the problem had been solved. It wasn't a case of dogs gone wild or of the 'German's pumas. At Biota a huge wolf weighing 52 kilos had been killed by members of the Guardia Civil when they were participating in a 'game-drive' through the woods organized by the locals!

This "terrible animal", the 52-kilo wolf, was put on show on the main square of the town!

The foregoing report in the *Diario De Navarra* is perfect, and it puts us in mind of one of those children's stories in which the wolf always has to stand for whatever is *bad*. "Once it had appeared on the Square hanging from its rear end, its body seemed drawn out and longer, and a pool of blood started to form on the ground beneath its head."

The Biota veterinary man Fernando Labena hit the nail on the head when he queried whether, in reality, despite the great size and weight of the wolf, it could have possibly been the cause of all those disasters in the region. He said: "It's a very big wolf, but my personal opinion is that it isn't the sole cause of all the problems".

And of course it wasn't. The problem still continues and the precise cause of all these deaths is still unknown. Rumour and popular fantasy are in wild flood, and folk always seek for a known enemy whom they can fight.

All the same, when you talk to people here, face to face, it is clear that they do know there can be SOMETHING ELSE. "Something that has been brought here and that wasn't here before" - said one old

experienced cattleman. Many of them, when talking of these matters, come out with the words "THAT CRITTER!"

#### IT IS NOT SOMETHING NEW!

Despite all the bears, the wolves, and the dogs gone wild, and despite a whole number of other creatures seen as the possible cause of the killings, there still remains a part which is without explanation. It is this part that now interests us, for it remains and persists in the archives of inexplicable phenomena of today and of all time.

To conclude that these strange deaths are the work of an "Iberian Chupacabras." or, alternatively, to conclude that they are due to secret experiments by humans — such a conclusion is simply frivolous. What we are concerned with here is just one more piece in a complex jigsaw puzzle that is of course far, far older than has so far been suggested by the media or by certain specialised review journals. It would be adviseable if we recall some of those events and facts from the past:

- (1) In January 1874 one of these murderous creatures was committing depredations in Ireland. It too inflicted incisions in the throat and sucked the blood of its victims.
- (2) Around about that same date, another similar beast was killing animals and humans in various regions of Russia. The Russian Army went out searching for it. They combed every thicket. But without result.
- (3) In 1906 the flocks of sheep near Windsor Castle in England were attacked by a mysterious animal which could never be captured because it "vanished into thin air".
- (4) In 1905 a Police Sergeant in Groncestershire (sic. for Gloucestershire? G.C.) told the *Daily Mail*:

"I have seen mutilated animals and I can say with all certainty that it is impossible for that to have been the work of a dog. Dogs are not vampires; they don't suck the blood of a sheep and then leave the flesh almost intact."

In spite of everything, these statements from other times and other places are so similar to the statements that we are today collecting in Spain and Portugal and elsewhere that the only possible posture for us to accept is that we today are still being confronted by new manifestations of an ancient mystery.

As seems wont to happen with everything presumed at first to be new, the adventures of the "CHUPACABRAS" critter, so much discussed of late in the media, appear to possess some historical antecedents that - although equally or even more interesting - previously nevertheless achieved less fame-if indeed any if they ever escaped from strictly confidential limits.

In the year 1979 I was in Santa Cruz de Tenerife (Island of Tenerife, Canary Islands, 28°20N., 16°40W.) signing copies of one of my first books at the Akenaton

Bookshop (in those days run by the good Paco Padrón). Lots of friends and followers of my TV series came to the shop to greet me, and out of all of them I most particularly recall two men. They hadn't come to ask me to sign books for them, but to speak to me privately, to which I agreed - particularly after they had identified themselves to me as members of the Higher Echelons of Police and Security.

It was not an "official visit". They simply wanted to know my opinion about certain events that for some weeks past had been going on in the municipal region of La Laguna, and particularly around *Taco*. It had to do with sheep and goats found dead in extremely strange circumstances. They appeared *totally bloodless*, with not a single drop of blood in the bodies. But, surprisingly, there were no signs of any blood either around or on the bodies - as though they had been sucked clean.

Nor were there any signs of violence.

And another inexplicable detail was that the skins of the animals appeared to be soaked through with water without there having been any rain, and with the terrain immediately around bone-dry.

And finally, the sole sign left by the attacker was a small and perfectly circular orifice some 30 cms. in diameter at the surface and sufficiently deep to affect the immediately adjacent internal organs. The position of the orifice was different in all the animals.

Tenerife, like other islands of the Canary Archipelago, still retains in certain of its districts an ancient tradition of *MAGIC*, and there are many folk there who practice rituals aimed at various diverse objectives.

Such "MAGIC" was the initial hypothesis formulated by the Tenerife Police, but observation of the details which I just mentioned above caused the Police to discard such theories instantly. Whoever had done the killings had employed knowledge and methods in no way corresponding to those of a ceremonial sacrifice.

The two agents informed me in confidence that in the same area sightings of luminous objects were occurring, for which reason there was the possibility of a link between the killings and the UFO Phenomenon.

So far as I myself was concerned, the matter ended there. They did accept my suggestion that they send to me in Madrid, in a suitably prepared box, one of the dead animals, so that we might have a detailed autopsy done at the Veterinary Faculty. But I imagine that bureacratic procedures rendered the project unfeasible.

# II. IN GALICIA (N.W. SPAIN): WOLVES - BUT ALSO "SOMETHING ELSE".

Galicia, the Spanish region with most cattle, has recently been the scene of killings of animals. The peasants are seeing their flocks of sheep reduced, and, so far, no organisation has furnished any solution for the problem. In recent days we have visited dozens of the people affected. The data collected by us point in two thoroughly distinct directions.

On the one hand, we have a *wolf* or a pack of wolves, attacking animals and eating them - ar at any rate eating them *partially*. The carcases of the animals

are torn and scratched. Other animals are left wounded, and, after adequate treatment, they recover completely.

Arturo López Pérez, a wealthy cattle-owner from the locality of Sarria (Lugo) even fired shots to scare off the wolves. He told us: "Thanks to that, of my animals they killed only one heifer. Had it been otherwise, God only knows what destruction they would have wrought. They killed the heifer calf because wolves always attack the WEAKEST of the animals." (Statement to us when we visited his farm at Pena).

Others who lost a number of cows and heifers as a result of the wolf were Manuel Pombo, Carlos Valladares and Antonio Albaredo. A man named Ramón, owner of a furniture store, lost two valuable colts. None of these animal deaths pointed to anything *abnormal*, despite the fact that that particular region is not one with many wolves.

But, on the other hand, we encountered a whole series of cases showing a very distinct pattern and fully deserving of the label "Strange".

Julia Chousa Losada, co-proprietor of the farm "Os Dogos" (= English "The Bulldogs". G.C.) at Barbadela, lost 35 sheep. Her detailed account of the wounds was very different indeed from the other category mentioned above. She said: "The sheep had two little round holes right in the neck... Outwardly it hardly looked as though they had any wounds at all. All that you could see was just a tiny bit of blood... One of the sheep had a small gash... As for being eaten, none of the sheep were eaten at all.... Five were still alive, but after a few days all of those were dead. None of them recovered. There was even one that was still standing, and I got hold of it and said "This one can still be saved'. But no sooner had I said it than the animal fell down and died. Many of the ewes were carrying lambs. It 'went for' the youngest, the most lively. Normally, wolves always attack the weakest."

In fact, so do all the predators. Curiously, just as in other cases, we found footprints there of two different sizes.

These happenings in Galicia show us once again that we are confronted with two distinct problems. ON THE ONE HAND - THE WOLF. ON THE OTHER HAND, "THAT OTHER THING".

III THE REPORT IN THE NEWSPAPER DIARO DE

NAVARRA OF AUGUST 24, 1993.

A STRANGE AND ELUSIVE CARNIVORE KILLS SCORES OF CATTLE ON THE FARMS OF TERUEL \*. (TERUEL, 40°22N., 1°08W. G.C.)

VICTIMS LEFT WITH THROATS SLASHED AND BLOOD SUCKED OUT

More than 80 head of cattle have been killed by a mysterious predator that, over the past two months, has become legendary and is destroying both the sheep and the savings of farmers in the Teruel districts of Almohaja, Santa Eulalia, Ródenas, and Pozondón, the losses totalling Pesetas 800,000.

According to a statement published in the newspaper *Heraldo De Aragón* last Monday, nobody knows whence "it" came and very few have managed to get a clear view of it, despite the organisation of numerous unsuccessful "sweep-searches".

The characteristics of the animal are: *great intelligence*, shown by its stealthiness; its skill in leaving no tracks; it enormous ferocity (for it leaves its victims with the throat slashed and some folk even assure us that it sucks the victim's blood); and its terrifying appearance, a sort of cross between a dog, a wolf, and a fox.

There are already various theories as to what species the animal belongs to. Many think it is a wolf - an animal that vanished from this Teruel region (due east from Madrid. G.C.) all of 50 years ago. - and there are others who think it is a cross between dog and fox and even betwen dog, fox and wolf. But these hybrids would be biologically impossible.

The most reliable version is that it is a wolf or a dog "gone wild". Though it is quite possible that there are several of them, since the attacks have been very numerous and have often occurred in various places simultaneously.

A group of naturists have promptly started demonstrating in front of the Provincial Office of Agriculture saying that it is illegal to carry out sweep-searches without having secured the necessary permission - particularly if -as the ecologists insinuate - "the opportunity is being taken to shoot anything that moves".

There have also been warnings that it is illegal to kill a wolf, or several wolves, because in any case this species is already protected thoughout Spain.■

# SOME DENIZENS OF THE "BLACK NETHER-WORLD" AND THEIR ABDUCTEE VICTIMS

[Don Worley, one of our most senior and most experienced UFO investigators, has been operating for many years. His first work goes back to collaboration with Dr. J. Allen Hynek, and even further back than that, to the days of Donald Keyhoe and his organization, N.I.C.A.P. of which - like myself - Don Worley was a member).

Don tells me that he has on file a "choice collection" of no less than a hundred or so truly "nasty" abduction cases. I hope that eventually we may even be able to publish *all* of them. In the meantime, I asked Don to let us have an initial instalment of six of his "nastiest", and here they are.

It seems that, apart from case No.1. ("Mary Brock" - a pseudonym), the names given in all the other five cases are their real names.

I suspect that there are not a few people in the United States and elsewhere who strongly disapprove of Don Worley and his writings - no doubt because he likes to try to "tell it as it was" - warts and all. A very bad habit! EDITOR OF FSR]

#### INTRODUCTION.

The presence of black-suited or cloaked entities and their autos in a low percentage of abductee cases is a documented fact. In this type of phenomenon, usually called "Men in Black (MIB)", it is abundantly clear that these unseen emissaries from darker realms dimensionally coexist with us in this time-frame. They are another extension of the UFO intelligence, surfacing to play their incredible games from the edge of a reality of which we are not aware. One can trace these enigmatic forms back into Antiquity. "Brethren of the Shadows", lurking in darkness, and very real to the Ancients, who rightfullly equated them with evil. You may choose to feel that all of this is hearsay and fantasy, but I have investigated the following cases and I am urgently telling you such an attitude is wrong and pure self-delusion.

The acquisition of MIB data has been very haphazard and apathetic so we probably fail to realize the actual inroads already made by this type of phenomenon. One thing is sure, the thick files I have on some of these cases represent gripping dramas that I can never portray in just these few pages. Although several cases have occurred quite near to me I have chosen to stay clear of the site when it was apparent that the MIBs didn't exactly welcome me there. I have chosen six of my best cases with MIB involvement, out of my total of 100 abductee cases. Seeking to simplify the MIB menagerie, I'll classify them into three groups; (A) CADAVER-LIKE MIBs, (B) TALL OR CLOAKED MIBs. AND (C) ORIENTAL MIBs.

# 1. CADAVER-LIKE MIBs. THE MARY BROCK CASE. (I did not have this person's permission to reveal her real name. In the other five cases, all names are real. D.W.)

A troubled voice on the phone was my introduction to this amazing case. As it turned out I never did get up to South Bend, Indiana, to meet her in a secluded outdoor place of her choosing. Seventeen years had passed, so Mary thought it was safe to telephone to me. We both were proved wrong. The silver saucer in a blue glow appeared on three nights running, and was witnessed by Mary, her family, and neighbours including a policeman. Mary's attempt at a photo got only black film and a damaged camera (which the Government men took away and never returned). As Mary was pulled toward her doorway, a coded bubbly voice came into her mind. It began asking about her work (under \$20,000 bond) in a manufacturing plant in Cleveland, Ohio, where she

worked on a secret Air Force device containing tiny glass tubes. Her physical effects following this event were severe headache, eye pain, brittle orange hair, and sunburned skin.

Several days later when Mary answered her door she found herself looking at a deathly-white-faced, glassy-eyed individual. The figure wore a black silky topcoat and a hat. His message was that she was not to say a word about the UFO incident. Then he walked away with a limp, got in the back seat of a big black car with tinted windows and it drove away.

Now, after 17 years, Mary, with her children away and safe, had gotten up the nerve to call me. Four days later she was back on the phone and it became apparent that the MIBs didn't want blabber-mouth Worley finding out about this case. She said a big black auto was parking on the street out in front of the house and would leave when she turned out her lights to go to bed. Our next attempt to communicate was to send her 11 pages of questions and plan to set up a meeting date. One month later I heard from Mary for the last time. Our attempt to use the mails had brought the MIBs back to her door and this time the envelope containing Mary's answers to my questions that she had mailed that morning was displayed to her. She was told that they had people working everwhere, and that if she loved her three kids, three grandchildren, and herself, not to send me any more information.

# 2. CADAVER MIB. THE MILAN, INDIANA, CASE.

This series of events occurred only 25 miles south of me, in Dearborn County. On a sunny afternoon in January 1967, schoolboy Reed Thompson took an amazing photo of a monitor-type UFO as it moved slowly through the trees within 32 feet of his home. Dead tree limbs later marked its route. This was the start of a series of events which I would investigate continuing into the 1990s. Reed experienced lost time during the event, and later had nose-bleeding problems.

On a warm April day in 1973, two thin, longhaired, grotesque-looking individuals entered Reed's auto parts store in Milan, Indiana. Reed's shepherd dog ran to a corner and whined in terror. Several patrons in the store later could not remember the event. The beings were dressed in tan jump suits, and wore heavy gloves. It was their faces that were upsetting. A local news reporter later coined the term, "Plastic-Facers" to describe them. One of the creeps, speaking in a mechanical monotone, knew exactly when Reed had taken the UFO photo. He demanded the photo and negative immediately. Being of a stubborn nature, Reed replied that the photo was in a bank vault and would stay there. "Plastic Face" said it didn't matter, they would get it anyway. Meanwhile a man named Craft, a friend of Reed's, had hurried outside to see the car in which these weirdos had come. It was a 1969 bright yellow Buick LeSabre. Peering through the dark glass, Craft was stunned to see that the auto had no steering wheel or seats. As the creeps neared the car, Reed's elbow brushed one of them and this seemed to disturb it.. (Craft died two years later, and two autopsies failed to find the cause of his early sudden demise.)

Reed hoped his strange visitors were gone, but, as he was en route to the welding shop at Versailles, a wild twilight chase began, when his "nemesis" appeared, inches from his bumper. At the welding shop the "Plastic-Facers" parked right behind him, and followed him to the shop door like shadows. As Reed opened the door a blue arc- welder flash was emitted. Reed looked around, and found that the unwelcome pair and their phantom car had vanished.

Reed Thompson has had his share of abductions. His exits and returns at the hands of the aliens have been phenomenal. He is no stranger to scoop-marks and puncture-marks; Grey alien face recall; debilitating accidents; and ill luck in general. Big black Cadillacs or Lincolns might be thought "out of place" in quiet Milan or on nearby highways, but Reed and his friends have seen them, usually following at a distance. Reed never knew that his persecutors can appear in this fashion until I told him. I have urged him to make his UFO photo available and set it, as a protection, on his bedroom dresser, for the sake of his loved ones and himself. My own presence on the scene always seemed to be countered by them in various ways, so I have stayed clear.

#### 3. CADAVER-LIKE. THE PAMARA CASE.

Pamara Johnson is a mother from Richmond, Indiana, who has near total recall of one of her abductions and of her strange experience with the MIBs. As often happens, Pamara was taken at sandbox age. When she was 14, on a sunny June day, a black limousine began to slowly circle the block where Pamara lived in Richmond. She went out on to her front porch to watch for it. The limo stopped, and a figure got out, and approached her up the walk. Pamara describes him this way, "He had on black pants, a black jacket and a black hat. It looked like a chauffeur's hat. He walked normal. His complexion was real white. His eyes were dark, and I didn't see any pupils in them. He spoke in a normal tone English. "I didn't hear any motor sound from the limo with tinted windows." The figure was polite, and wanted to know from her if a Rhonda Smith lived there. Pamara had never heard of such a person, so the figure thanked her and returned to the auto which then departed.

Shortly after that, Pamara and her sister left to go to a nearby store. The limo seemed to appear again out of nowhere. It pulled up to the kerb and Pamara saw a rear window go down and a rifle-barrel appear in it. Badly frightened, she shoved her sister behind a wall and jumped behind a nearby tree. Three shots were fired and she heard them hit the tree. The limo then sped away up 18th street, which is a dead-end. A nearby lady had seen it all from her home, and she called the police who soon arrived at the scene where the two weeping girls were. They dug the bullets out of the tree. And decided that it must have been a case of a hit-man choosing the wrong target!

Four years later, Pamara was to undergo the abduction she remembers most clearly. She and her mother and sister were taken near the little town of Abington seven miles northeast of here. it was a cold

December day but as the UFO came down, it buzzed the tree-tops. (Since dead.) Aboard the craft, Pamara had her confirmed foetus taken from her. The culprits were the Grey type aliens. A vibrating wire-type instrument was used. Pamara was also shown large jars with foetuses in clear fluid with wires running to them.

The family arrived home four hours later, and Pamara was in such a state that, terror-stricken, she had to crawl from the floor of the car and into her house. The mother and sister have chosen to never talk about their abductions to me, but the sister hides a neck implant with her hair. Each December it swells up and fluid runs out of it.

## 4. TALL OR CLOAKED MIB. THE PATSY WINGATE CASE.

Patsy, who lives in one of the Appalachian mountain towns, has had all manner of paranormal activity all through her life. (Maybe her Blackfoot Indian/Dutch/ Irish ancestry has something to do with it?) Perhaps her strangest abduction incident was on the night when the little aliens came to take her again and she was pregnant, and angry, and wanted no part of it. As the three little Greys approached her across the bedroom floor, she jumped up and grabbed the middle one by its thin neck. She squeezed, and there was a crack, and its head fell back on its spine. Startled looks appeared on the faces of its companions who were on each side of it. They quickly grabbed the disabled one's arms, reversed direction in a robot-like manner, and soon disappeared in the light that had appeared in the bathroom. Patsy went back to bed feeling remorse. She had not intended to hurt anyone. (The only other time that I've heard of this sort of happening was in a case familiar to Dr. David Jacobs).

Patsy has been branded, with a V with a reversed 7 in it, and a B with a circle under it, whatever these may mean. Once, when a child, she remembers walking down a forest path with a tall blond man in a suit. His eyes were "gentle", and she was transfixed with his face and his wings! He made a squeaking sound instead of talking. At another time, when living near a cemetery, she would see, on a windy night, a figure in a black robe that seemed to be watching her house. Then, again, one day in the cemetery, she encountered a tall black-cloaked man with light coming from his face. (Was he her guardian angel or was he a devil?) In several different residences, over the years, Patsy and others have had black limos follow them. Also they have been followed by what looked like police cars, but they had 'a low rolling fog' that moved with them. One afternoon, as Patsy was driving toward an intersection, she momentarily blacked out. Her husband nudged her, and she recovered just in time to stop at the intersection. Near the intersection there was a dark-windowed limousine. And the mental voice which she sometimes heard said, "See - we can kill you anytime we want to."

Black helicopters were also seen by Patsy and those around her. On one momentous night, when she lived near Windblow, North Carolina, in the middle of a huge peach orchard, three black helicopters were in the sky. These 'seemed to be linked to a huge curved piece of

lightning that was also there'. On another occasion, when the MIB accosted Patsy on her own front porch in Kentucky, her children had climbed up into a nearby tree and they watched it all. The white-faced beings were dressed in silky black suits, white shirts, ties and dress hats. Using a large needle they filled a vial with Patsy's blood.

## 5.THE ORIENTAL MIB. THE CARROLL WATTS CASE.

Watts was a cotton farmer who lived in the Texas 'panhandle' area. He knew nothing about UFOs, and pounded with his fist on the first one that landed on his farm, thinking it must be a Government craft! In his second encounter with the large grey cylinder object, he was abducted. The craft also appeared again later, so he got 7 polaroid photos of it. Watts was seeking some answers about it all from a reliable source, so he got in touch with the then ongoing Government-financed UFO study at the University of Colorado led by by Dr. Condon. He got no answers, and - according to Condon - the original photos and negatives got "lost". In fact Condon told him to "quash" and stop talking about what had happened to him. When Watts later went public he became a national sensation, and he began to receive threats to silence him. Dr. Allen Hynek urged him to prove his claims in a polygraph test.

As he was driving to Amarillo, where he was to take the test, he saw ahead of him a blue-green Plymouth parked along the road with its hood up. (Hood = British "bonnet"). An attractive young blonde woman was standing by it, and waved for him to stop. As he stepped out, he was knocked down by a blow to his neck. When he opened his eyes, two figures towered above him. They were clean-cut, brown-skinned, oriental-looking gents. They were about six feet tall, of maybe 190 lbs. or so, wore expensive looking dark suits and turtle-necked sweaters. They pointed submachine guns at him. Speaking in precise English one told Watts that he would fail the lie detector test or else. About an hour later Watts was very glad to do just that.

The following night a big black car haunted the Watts home, and finally shotgun blasts were heard coming from it as it moved slowly past. Watts had fled to a nearby field and he emptied his M1 Carbine at it without effect. In the home his frantic wife was calling the police. All this was more than enough for Watts. He proclaimed to all that his UFO story was a hoax.

Watts began having behavioural problems, and his brother told me he was influenced by a stranger who had come. Paranoia set in, and Watts now began to believe that certain people were out to 'get him'. Finally, out of mistaken fear, he pulled his gun on a law officer. Once upon a time he had been a happy husband and father. Then the aliens came. From his cell in Texas State Prison Watts told me, "The incident cost me my wife, my children, \$285,000, my freedom, my health (heart trouble) and nearly my life. Simply because something happened to me that I didn't uderstand, and that I talked about, and I think now that I would have been better off myself if I had died in the incident."

#### 6.ORIENTAL MIB. THE STANLEY INGRAM CASE

My friend Stanley, a former judge, city manager, news column writer, is dead. But he and his incredible struggle with the aliens will never be forgotten. In the end bankrupt, ridiculed, and disillusioned, he died of a heart attack. But he has never been forgotten, because I have preserved a large quanity of data on his situation over the years 1973 to 1976 in rural south-central Tennessee, USA. It all began when he and his daughter Becky began to watch UFOs from firetowers in the region. At school one day a jumbled voice began to come in the daughter's head. She was very upset, and sought her father's help. Later, when the voice became clear, it urged her to come to the football field. Finally one day she gave into it, and went there and found herself inside a brightly lit UFO. This was the first of the series of mental summonses to the craft wherever it had landed. Another local man named David Swanner was also affected in similar fashion. Stanley himself was never abducted but through these persons the struggle between him and the aliens ensued. His efforts to understand and cope would all end in final defeat. At first he thought the aliens might be "good", but with the arrival of the MIB he became sure they were not.

The two beings that his daughter Becky met in the UFO called themselves 'Alton' and Tombo' and said they were from the planet 'Plantos.' They were off-white stick-on suits, rolled-edged-stocking hats from which a little blond hair showed, and pointed shoes. They were about 4 1/2 feet tall, had thin necks, small eyes, ears, and noses, and pointed faces. At home after the event Becky had nausea, headache, thirst, frequent urination, and great sleepiness. She recoved after three months under a physician's care.

With regard to David Swanner's case, the oriental MIB came in June 1974, and when they stopped Swanner the second time, it was in an alley. They showed him a brief-case supposedly containing \$500,000 for the propulsion formula which he had been allowed to copy on the craft. Stanley Ingram had the formula, in his safe. The three alien figures were in a late model black Cadillac three-seated auto bearing a California plate. No one was ever able to get the long number.


The beings had big round dark complexioned oriental faces with piercing eyes. All were heavy-set in build, looked about 30 or 40 years old, and had thick black hair cut in the style of 'pre-crew-cut' years. They wore black suits, white shirts, and black ties. Their voices had a Chinese accent pitched low and gruff, and they spoke in a normal unexcited tempo. Amazed and afraid, Swanner sped off in a cloud of dust.

On Aug.2nd. 1974(?), Becky parked and ran into a bowling alley to get away from the limo behind her. On Sept. 23rd Swanner bluffed them out with a handful of rocks he had grabbed at the roadside. They backed up and left. On Sept. 25th Becky discouraged them by brandishing a small choppping axe when they got too close. On the night of Feb. 25th 1975 the black MIB limo flashed around Becky on a rural road. Four MIBs with revolvers jumped out. The biggest of them, a barrel-

chested being about 5ft 10, jerked Becky out of her car. They wanted to know where her father was, and where the formula was. Really foolish questions in an "incomprehensible game. Becky received a blow to her stomach and another to her face which knocked her onto the hood of her car. Then her strange assailants drove away. When she got home, Stanley was furious. He took her to the sheriff's office and also called in friends with guns. Early next day he took his swollen-faced daughter to the doctor and alerted other law enforcement officers in the area. Becky would see the MIB one more time, several days later, when she looked out of her upstairs window. The MIB, wearing an old style Stetson hat, was standing in the rain in the yard and looking up at her. Evryone rushed out and scoured the area in two cars, but the MIB had vanished.

I have given you only an outline of these six cases. Clearly these are counter to the quasi-spiritual, loving guidance convictions held by some researchers and experiencers. (However there *must* presumably be some alien groups who have noble motives. *The trouble is that personally I have yet to find any that I would fully trust!*).

In the Brock case, remember, (Case No.1) the MIB said, "We have people everywhere." In some of my cases the MIBs show an intimate knowledge of all things human. I believe these lying forces of destruction and evil are just beyond your mental fingertips. Kept at bay by the love and truth of our original Creator who exists beyond the furthest galaxy. All too often now dear reader, you perceive the rising crescendo of Evil in its many forms engulfing the entire Earth. There is a special book that constantly warns of it. It is known as "The Bible".

# WHAT ST. PAUL IS ACTUALLY REPORTED TO HAVE SAID.. By Gordon Creighton

was intensely interested when I saw that Don Worley had focused his attention on these words of St. Paul's EPISTLE TO THE EPHESIANS, VI,12, because it is a passage that has been the object of my own speculation and study *for many years past*.

In these modern times every one of us is of course familiar enough with the idea of "cover-ups" in connection with well nigh every aspect of human life or thought or activity, — particularly "Government cover-ups," today apparently regarded as one of the chief banes of our existence.

But few, I suspect, realise that "cover-ups" and deliberate deceptions and distortions, many of them centuries-old, are also to be found in such places as the standard texts of Christendom — as of course indeed also in the texts of all or any of the world's OTHER "Great

Religions". By this I mean deliberate distortions or falsifications, either in the wording of the original language, or *in translations* of the same.

Obviously unwitting or accidental errors might easily arise in any sort of translation, on whatever theme, and however trivial. But that is not what we are discussing.

But when it occurs in a religious passage of truly massive importance like the one which we are considering, then we should always be mindful of the high possibility that we are looking at a piece of what can only have been *deliberate deception*, and not an accident.

And such is the case with this passage from EPHESIANS, Chapter VI., verse 12.

We have been hearing such an awful lot lately about "sleaze" and immorality and 'dodgy' ways of conduct in general, and according to what our own Kremlin Bosses now tell us, these dreadful defects are found exclusively in *just one* of Britain's political parties. (At least one other party, it seems, is 'as pure as the driven snow', and totally free of the blight.)

The language in which our texts of the *New Testament* have come down to us is a rather simple form of Greek — on the whole far less complex than the old classical tongue of ancient Greece. And here, in the box below, is a word-for-word translation which I made, about ten years ago, in order to lay bare what the Greek text of these lines *ACTUALLY SAYS*. Anyone who is familiar with this thing that we call "the UFO Problem" may find the result quite surprising!)

After the first ten Greek words we see at once of course that the main thrust of the statement is not simply against what today we folk would call "sleaze" or "immorality" or "dishonesty" in our own human social, political and financial/commercial lives. Clearly it embraces much more than merely that. It points to the presence of malignant non-human entities that were then (and, as we can now see, still are!) active in the skies of

our planet. And I suggest that whoever was responsible for the 'official' and 'accepted' translation as published in the Authorised King James Version of the Bible (its date was 1611) was knowingly perpetrating a 'cover-up' and undoubtedly was acting on instructions, and those instructions will have been received either consciously from someone high up in the Protestant Anglican Church or in our Government (someone who, as the Buddhists would say, "was on the Left-Hand Path") or, unconsciously, telepathically, from some non-human entity or agency of an evil type.

As Gurdjieff always emphasised in his writings and his teachings, there is "something" in man - his soul - which is part of the Divine and which has come to us from beyond Time and beyond Space and which causes us to seek to return to the Divine. ("To Him alone is the Return!" as the Koran puts it). Gurdjieff calls this 'something' in the human soul "the Sacred Impulse".

As the Swiss writer Blaise Cendrars (1887-1961) once put it, "Mankind has an enormous need for the Divine, and this is why there are so many Gods in the world".

But if - as seems only too evident - all of the world's "Great Religions" were infiltrated and vitiated long, long ago by the Satanic Forces, then surely it would have been of the very greatest importance that this piece of evidence in *Ephesians VI*, 12 ABOUT MANKIND'S REAL, DESPERATE, SITUATION SHOULD BE CAREFULLY BLOTTED OUT!

So you may be sure that this "mis-translation" did not come about by any chance or accident. Note how skilfully the very concept of evil forces flying in our skies has been eased right out!

Both Jesus and Paul referred to the SATANIC POWER as "THE PRINCE OF THE AIR". See, for examples, the Gospel of St. John, Chapter Xii, verse 31: "The Prince of this world".

And see also Paul's *Epistle to the Ephesians*, Chapter II, verse 2:

"The Prince of the authority of the Air, the Spirit that *now* works in the Sons of Disobedience". ( See the text below.)

This Greek word for *now*, which I have here underlined, seems to me to be most extraordinarily interesting. The "Sons of

Disobedience" seem surely to be the "Sons of Belial", who, as we are told in all the three religious sources - Jewish, Islamic, and Christian -



rebelled against God. They are headed by SATAN, *Shaytan* as the Jews call him, or *Iblis* or *Shaytan* as the Muslims call him, or *Ahriman* as the Zoroastrians of Iran called him, or *Lucifer* as he is sometimes - incorrectly -

called, (for "Lucifer" originally meant Venus or the Morning Star); he is patently the Leader of the Revolting Angels whom the Hebrews called the NEPHILIM



("THOSE WHO FELL") and whom the Sumerians and Babylonians called that faction of the ANNUNAKI, who were the Rebels. (See the books of Zecharia Sitchin, who, incidentally, although Jewish himself and presumably an excellent authority on all the Semitic languages, seems to have got it a bit wrong in his earliest books, where he began by calling the Rebels "THOSE WHO CAME DOWN", But the word "NEPHILIM" cannot possibly mean that. It means clearly "THOSE WHO FELL", and I note that in his later books this is the translation that he gives.)

With reference to the word "now" mentioned by me above, it is surely interesting inasmuch as it might be suggesting that there was an earlier period — i.e. before the Fall of Man" into the control of Evil Forces — when "things were different", and when mankind was "in a better state".

On this question of the great Battle which, according to all three of our great "Western Religions", has been going on for an immense period of time between the Forces of the Light (i.e. of Michael) and the Powers of Darkness (Satan, Iblis, Ahriman), I feel that nobody has written so much and thrown so much light as the great Austrian teacher and founder of Anthroposophy, Rudolf Steiner (1861-1925). A seer and clairvoyant from his earliest years, Steiner produced a vast flood of books and articles and lectures, much of which has still not been translated from his very difficult style of German. Some of his most important work has dealt with the Dark Forces that menace mankind, whom he describes under two categories which he labels "Ahriman" and "Lucifer". A series of lectures delivered by him in 1917 reveal an astonishingly prophetic view of the Bolshevik Revolution then just starting in Russia and the terrible results that it would bring for the whole of mankind. Most important however, are his books and lectures on the Satanic Powers. From around 1840 until about 1879, so Steiner claimed, another tremendous round was being fought between the Cohorts of Michael and the Dark Ones, ending in a severe defeat for the latter. However, says Steiner, the result was that the Forces of Evil have been driven down firmly upon the Earth and are now

closer to mankind, and working more fiercely to overpower and control us, than ever before. The present scene of unprecedented violence, drug-taking, sexual abnormality and general crime and disorder is the clear result, and it will all get far, far worse. (The Russian emigré Nikolai Berdyaev, writing in France during the 1930s, also produced several important books in which he warned that another Dark Age is at hand).

It is perfectly evident that Paul had seen quite clearly that mankind is engaged in an ongoing struggle against something desperately *evil*. But, Christianity having been already successfully infiltrated at a very early date, it was easy to hide the truth and distort the meaning when the time came for the Bible to be translated and printed on a massive scale.

Nowadays, of course, few are expected any longer to be wanting to consult the texts of the Bible. And who, anyway, any longer ( in our Western world ) believes in the **existence** of devils and demons and evil spirits!

In his wonderful little book, *The Screwtape Letters: Letters from a Senior to a Junior Devil (1942)*, doesn't C.S. Lewis have his Senior Devil pronouncing these famous words to his Junior Colleague?:

"Remember, Wormwood, our trump card is the fact that everybody KNOWS that we don't exist!"

There you have it in a nutshell!

N.B. Just because the text contains this mention of the "skies", don't assume that this means that the "Nasties" are all "ETs". Being the Prince of the Air", it is surely not surprising that Old Nick and his cohorts should be making such widespread use of aerial craft. Which has made it all the easier to bluff mankind into the fatuous belief that they are our beloved "Cosmic Brothers", from other planets, who have come here to get us off the hook if only we will place ourselves in their hands! #### FLYING TRIANGLES: THE GROWING THREAT?

last reviewed the progress of Flying Triangles over the U.K. in FSR Vol. 39, No.4 (Winter 1994) and Vol. 40, No.1 (Spring 1995). In those issues I concentrated mainly on the FT activity over the Midlands area of England. Now, with the aid of information made available from a wide number of groups throughout the U.K., I am able to present a wider picture of the increasing presence of Flying Triangles in our night skies.

Although there has been some speculation that the Flying Triangles are a new *Stealth* type of aircraft, there are numerous reasons why this theory can be discounted.

- a) Flying Triangles have been reported for many years, pre-dating the *Stealth* technology period. One of the earliest verified reports that we have is that of Mr Robin Gibbard, an experienced observer from Derby. At 11 a.m. on the 19th April 1956, Robin watched the approach of an 'Avro Anson' aircraft. As it drew closer, he observed a small triangular craft flying around the aeroplane; it then "shot straight up at a phenomenal speed".
- b) The shape of the Triangle is not related to any aerodynamic design. They have often been reported as travelling "wide-side-first".
- c) The FT can vary its velocity from hovering, quietly or with a faint hum, to an estimated speed range of between 25 mph to 650 mph. (See graph.)
- d) The FTs have been observed hovering low over nuclear power plants, main highways, traffic islands, and populated areas. Hardly the actions of a new 'secret' aircraft.
- e) Although there have been claimed sightings of the FT along the Lancashire coast, **it is not** based, and **does not** originate from the British Aerospace facility at Warton, Lancs.

Mr Simon Lewis, of the North Lancashire UFO Investigation Group, recently addressed a meeting of aeronautical engineers at British Aerospace, Warton. They had heard reports of Flying Triangle craft being observed in the Lancashire area, and had stated that "it is not one of ours!" Simon Lewis was invited to give a presentation on the FT craft. He later commented that there had been great interest in the subject, and particularly in the video of an FT passing over Morecambe, Lancashire, on the 2nd February 1996.

f) The Flying Triangle reports are not peculiar to the United Kingdom. There have been numerous FT encounters around the world for many years. Readers may be familiar with the 'Hudson Valley' (USA) flap, when boomerangs and triangular craft visited the area in the mid-80s. (See FSR 30/3, February 1985, for two articles by Philip Imbrogno and others.)

We have a first-hand report from Mr Clay McLean of Longview, Texas, who in 1967, at the age of twelve, was returning from watching a local basketball game at his school. As he was walking home a large, black Flying

Triangle quietly floated over him at a height of only 100 ft. "It was very black against the sky, emitted no lights at all, and was completely silent", commented Clay.

There was also the Flying Triangle 'flap' over Belgium (1989/90). The Belgian Air Force scrambled several F16 fighters in an attempt to intercept the FTs. They failed completely, as the FT craft were able to execute feats of acceleration, climbing and diving which utterly outperformed the F16 aircraft. (See FSR 35/2, June 1990, for several articles; also 35/4, December 1990 for more.)

I cannot stress the importance of the interchange of UFO information between groups. There are still a number of individuals who feel that the FT information they have obtained is 'theirs', but fortunately more than 30 U.K. groups are currently submitting their reports to the FT databank. Prominent among these is the Essex UFO Group, under the leadership of Ron West.

This information is being gathered and correlated by Victor J. Kean under the 'Project FT' programme. Victor's work has resulted not only in the number, but the speed, track and prime target areas of the FTs being identified.



Apparent speed of FT between N.P. stations based upon timed observations and distance. © Victor J. Kean.



### NIGHT A GIANT UFO BLOCKED OUT THE STARS.

It was huge. So large that it blotted out the stars for more than a mile as it swooped silently over Arizona. Thousands saw it and dozens videotaped it. After months of investigation, computer analysis and talks with eye-witnesses, experts have been unable to come up with any earthly explanation for the sightings. (13/03/97)

The V-shaped formation of red and white lights passed over several towns at a steady 30 mph, covering a distance of 60 miles.

Witnesses -who included pilots, air-traffic controllers, doctors and lawyers -said the object glided across the sky without sound, its height ranging from 500ft to several thousand feet.

The incident has captured the imagination of America like no UFO sighting in decades.

It has revived memories of the Roswell iincident of 50 years ago, when the supposed crash of a flying saucer in New Mexico was allegedly covered up by the authorities. Black and white film exists which purports to show autopsies on some of the aliens recovered at the scene.

Peter Davenport, of the National UFO Reporting Centre in Seattle, said the Arizona incident was the most dramatic in his experience. 'What we have here is the real thing -they are here,' he added.

The files of the UFO Centre record that the first sighting came from a retired police officer in Paulden,

60 miles north of Phoenix. He reported a cluster of red lights heading south.

The second call came from Prescott, 15 miles down the road. This time the report was of one red light and four white lights.

Within minutes the centre's switchboard was jammed with calls from Wickenburg, Glendale, Phoenix, and Scottsdale.

Bill Grava, a pilot and air-traffic controller for 12 years, was on tower duty at Sky Harbor International Airport. He saw the UFO but it did not appear on radar.

'I have never seen anything like that,' he said. 'It was weird and inexplicable. I don't know what to think.'

Tim Ley, a 54-year-old management consultant, had just arrived home and parked his car in the drive when he saw the lights.

'They looked like gas,' he said. 'There was a distortion on the surface. Also, the light didn't spill out or shine. I have never seen a light like that.'

Truck driver Bill Greiner, 51, said: 'Before this, if anyone told me they saw a UFO, I would say "Oh yeah, and I believe in the tooth fairy". Now I've got a whole new view.

'I may be just a dumb truck driver, but I've seen something.'

The video tapes were examined by a company which

designs computerised effects for Hollywood and supercomputers for the government.


They ran computer analysis of video footage and compared the lights to every other light in the Phoenix area. Nothing matched.

The Luke Air Force Base between Phoenix and Glendale has been a target for hundreds of callers who assumed that the sighting was linked to the base. Officials denied it.

Lieutenant Colonel Mike Hauser said many callers became angry and accused the Air Force of a cover-up.

There were F-16 fighter jets in the air that night and one of the last sightings was near the base.

Mr Greiner said he saw three of the jets take off and veer towards the object. 'Then it shot straight up and disappeared in the blink of an eye,' he said. 'Those pilots had to see it.' If they did the Air Force is lying.■

# PHANTOM SURGEONS OF THE NIGHT © By DON WORLEY (INDIANA), FSR CONSULTANT.

form of helpless paranoia hangs like a shroud over large areas of the western half of the USA. A mysterious agency strikes out of the darkness and leaves its grisly evidence behind.

#### CAROLYN McCALL'S EXPERIENCE

Cold chills rippled down the spine of Carolyn McCall, wife of the manager of Hay Creek Ranch near Antelope, Oregon. The bull looked as though he had just dropped in his tracks, since the lower limbs of a juniper tree were broken beneath him. Carolyn's horse reared up and would not approach the animal. After she had summoned other riders it was learned that the bull had been dead about a week, yet there was no odour, and the

usual magpies, buzzards, and flies refused to descend on the carcass. The nose, eye, ear, tongue, rectum, scrotum and centre of the abdomen had been excised by precision bloodless surgery, leaving serrated-edged cavities. A perfect triangle was cut into the hide of one shoulder. This was a typical "mute" (surgical animal mutilation). I learned about this case when I was appearing in Oregon on TV.

# INTO THE FOURTH DECADE AND NO CULPRIT EVER CAUGHT

We are now into the fourth decade of this frightening, relentless activity. No estimates can be made of the total victims, but it must be more than 50,000 just in the USA alone. By January 1997 Jean Barton, a Lassen County California cattle owner, had suffered some mutilations and when she publicised it she was overwhelmed by the number of other ranchers who had had similar losses. Through the years many have stopped reporting their losses, and the county sheriffs have sought to reduce the totals and so avoid criticism over so many unsolved cases. Silence has become the reaction to this eerie menace that cannot be stopped.

The time has long since passed for officialdom's "head in the sand" attitude. Only a delusional fool will cling to the untenable theories of predators or disease or quasi-military research or satanic cults. I will also not waste words on the ruinous strife that has occurred between Government officials, State lab-pathologists, criminal division investigators on the one hand and ranchers, farmers, veterinarians and county sheriffs on the other. Gabe Valdez, a New Mexico State policeman had it right. He said, "they are like coyotes coming from behind. Never saying who they are, but asking a lot of questions. Then they leave until the next "mute".

In the past, armed ranchers have patrolled their land day and night. Some of the most massive manhunts in the history of these regions have been mounted. During the peak year of 1975, in Colorado, Governor Richard Lamm ordered radar-equipped guard helicopters into the fray. The elusive surgeons remained undetected, just as they always have.

# IN BETWEEN THE CELLS AND SHREDDED ALUMINIUM

On a global scale, "Mute" phenomena are most intense in the western USA. Places like Canada, Australia, Puerto Rico, and Scandinavia are somewhere behind. In England, or points east into the Middle East, it seems a rarity. No human effects are found around a downed cow. Predators avoid the carcass and maggots stop at the wound edge. Often a circle of wilted grass is found. Dr. Levengoed, a Michigan biophysicist examined grass from inside ovals at Garnett (Kansas) and Chacon (New Mexico) and found cellular changes in the plants suggesting exposure to microwave frequencies. In the animals themselves cautery exposure of tissue to high heat results in "necrosis" (meaning tissue death by heat). On the other hand some cases have been found where it is not a laser burn. Instead microscopic study has revealed a clean incision precisely between the cell boundaries -

something totally beyond human skill! The reproductive system is frequently removed, and the anus cored out. Frequently the eyes are removed leaving the fatty pad. The tongue is missing from deep in the throat. Chest incision removes organs there, leaving no blood or evidence of bone fracture. A cow may have 40 gallons of blood, and some have had it all removed down to the capillary level. Another feat beyond "our science".

Some odd things have been found at "*Mute*" sites. Sheriff Yarnell of Elbert County, Colorado, found an udder neatly cleaned out and packed with sand. Teats have been snipped off and arranged in perfect order on a leg. Perfect circles or squares have been cut out of hide. Aluminium strips were found in one cow's mouth - the same metal fragments that fell in such profusion in the 1960s. Geiger counter readings at some sites have been higher than the surrounding areas.

#### THE SPECTACLE OF A FLOATING COW

On September 13, 1994 near Chacon, New Mexico, Larry Gardea spotted two dead cows while on his way to hunt bear near Luhan Canyon. All of a sudden he heard a noise like the sound of an arc-welder coming from the opposite direction from where he had seen the cows. On the other side of a fence he was shocked to find one of the cows moving on its side toward the noise. The cow was making a tortured sound and was moving over the ground with its back toward the noise and unable to get up. When it came to a ditch it floated right over it. The cow disappeared into a grove of trees. Unnerved by what he had seen, he fired two quick shots over the trees and fled. Later it was found that there were no indications that the animal had touched the damp ground. Linda Moulton Howe (P.O. Box 300, Jamison, PA. 18929), America's foremost "Mute" researcher, investigated this incident.

#### "BIG MAMA" AND HER "BABIES"

Two kinds of aerial objects haunt "Mute" skies. They are UFOs and the black helicopters. I will deal with the UFOs first, choosing a few examples from the thousands. The large Terry Sherman ranch in Uintah County, Utah, has been a hotbed of UFOs and bizarre activity since March 1995. They link the loss of several cows to UFOs. Three kinds of UFOs were seen, a small box-like craft, a 40-foot object, and a huge ship the size of two football fields. They've seen airborne lights, some of which emerged from orange circular doorways that appeared in the sky. They videotaped two sightings.

From Judith Basin County, undersheriff Jerry Skelton wrote me, "I don't know what you have got for facts on these UFOs, but people see them flying around here all the time." In that Montana area the usual diabolical things were happening to the cattle population. In Fergus County nine heifers were found together minus their female organs and one ear.

Pat McGuire, an outfitter and guide in Big Laramie, Wyoming, provided me with extensive "UFO-Mute" documentation in his area. He referred to the UFOs as "spaceships" and his multiwitness reports were many. In his closest sighting he described a 30-by-500-foot orange disc with domes on top and bottom.

In Logan County, in northeastern Colorado, eerie bright objects dubbed "Big Mama and her baby UFOs" were seen repeatedly by bewildered ranchers and law officers who linked them with the 77 "Mute" deaths in the county. Sheriff Harry Graves said ""Big Mama" looks like a huge brilliant star that hovers high in the sky for up to 90 minutes, then suddenly disappears at great speed. Sometimes as many as three baby UFOs come out of her belly. When the little ones get done with whatever they're doing they join up with the big one and disappear. We've chased "Big Mama" by plane and car, and sometimes she is round, other times pear-shaped, with her colours changing from white to red to green to white."

One night in May 1991 a Washington State ranchhand watched as a 1800lb bull went up a blue beam of light head-first. At the top, the beam seemed to flare, and the bull was turned end-wise five or six times. After the beam snapped off he heard an enormous plop as the animal hit the ground. In daylight the bull was found to be a typical "Mute" victim.

# LAWMEN ROUTED BY UFOs AND BLACK HELICOPTERS

Now let me move on to that other puzzling kind of craft seen at "Mute" sites. In his book The Choppers - and The Choppers, Thomas Adams, (P.O. Box 1049 Paris, TX. 75460) lists 200 helicopter - Mute" proximity reports. Not all helicopters are black, and some may be conventional aircraft. In some instances the copter flew up from the spot and a "mute" was later found there.

Of all the western sheriffs perhaps Roy Kitson and his deputies of Madison County, Montana, can claim the wildest experiences with the black copters and UFOs. By 1976, 22 mutilations had occurred in the county, but the witches' brew of alien craft far outnumbered this. Kitson and his men had learned to sleep with their boots on, for when UFO reports started up they knew they were going to get hit on the ground. One afternoon they headed up toward the head of Horse Creek, where six cows were reported mutilated. In the 12 hours before the officers got up into the rugged area the six calves with the cows had also vanished. In the rugged, dark, mountains of the upper Ruby River the three officers watched weird glowing lights darting over the tree-tops and around the mountain sides. On this memorable night silent jet-black helicopters also swept in at them, the two groups, copters and UFOs, having joined forces. The helpless lawmen finally retreated out of the area.

#### COPTER RIDERS IN BUSINESS SUITS

There were so many UFOs seen around the little town of Fyffe in north east Alabama, a state in the southeastern USA, that the State Senate declared it "The UFO Capital of Alabama". In 1992 this proved to be a harbinger of days when bovine corpses would litter the landscape. The ever-present UFOs and helicopters were around too. Ted Oliphant, the lawman heading the investigation from Fyffe, stated, "95% of these cases include reports of helicopters."

Jean Cole, wife of Albertville's chief detective,

watched a copter at close range when it came down in her back yard. She clearly saw four business-suited occupants in it. It rapidly flew away when her presence seemed to be noted. The following morning, detective Cole found one of his Black Angus cattle minus its sex organs and rectum.

#### A MEETING THAT NEVER HAPPENED ON RED MOUNTAIN

Another kind of figure has shown up amongst the occupants of our mysterious helicopters. In the Red Mountain area near Norris, Montana, a hunter watched as a black copter that looked like a Bell Jet Ranger flew over him. It landed down the hill, and seven figures began to come up the hill toward him. He began to hurry down the hill to meet them waving and shouting greetings as he did so. As the distance rapidly closed the hunter could see the figures had on ordinary clothing. All had faces that were olive-coloured and eyes that looked slanted. They chatted in a language among themselves that he had never heard. Suddenly they stopped as if realising he was not who they thought he was, and began to run back toward the running copter and it rapidly lifted up and away.

Actually the presence of black helicopters in "Mute" areas is a mystery within a mystery. Who controls them and why are they there? To begin with we must remember that the appearance of black helicopters in many abductions is a documented fact. Viewing the black copters as a separate group in all the normal military and civilian air traffic, I do not believe that these aeroforms are Government's attempt to monitor "Mute" activity, or that they are in any way Government-connected. I do believe that they are yet another alien creation similar to what we call "The Men in Black (MIB)". The final purpose for the employment of forces like the MIB (quasi-human) and black helicopters (quasi-aero machines) is beyond the scope of this article.

#### CATCHING THE FARM AND RANCH BUTCHERS AT THEIR DIRTY WORK

There are episodes where the aliens have been seen at the scene of the deed and I will now briefly describe some of those. At the Lebsack feed-lot, southeast of Sterling, Colorado, three animals were "Mute" victims on successive nights. Two ranch hands staked out the well illuminated site from a grain elevator. At about 4:00am three human-like forms glided in over the fence of the lot. Two cars of officers arrived within six minutes, but the beings had vanished leaving no sign of their passage in the muddy ground.

Another incident involving beings occurred on a grey overcast day when a Waco, Texas, rancher was doing a foot search for a lost calf. As he re-crossed a hill he encountered two creatures carrying the calf between them. The four-foot, greenish-coloured, big-headed beings had large black slanted eyes. The rancher ran from the scene, and when he returned with a companion the mutilated calf was found at the site.

For a Missouri farm couple a glittering thing in the distance turned into much more when they began to view it through binoculars. On the ground was a green cone-shaped object with a door and platform out to the side. Near this stood a "lizard-like" being staring at them with big eyes. Frantically passing the binoculars back and forth they spotted a downed black cow and two small silver-suited beings with packs on their backs. The beings were moving their fingers over the cow and looking at them. With their hands over the cow it began to float in the air. It then floated to the ramp and up it and into the trees which seemed to conceal the object.

# AT THE "MUTE" SCENE IN THE UFO OR UNDERGROUND

An important case in which the aliens were directly linked to "mute" phenomena came to light when Judy Doraty, driven by constant headaches, had herself regressed hypnotically by Dr. Leo Sprinkle Ph.D. (University of Wyoming). While driving south of Houston, Texas, in 1975, she and her daughter were amazed to see a calf rise in a pale yellow beam of light. Both women were then abducted and witnessed the surgical mutilation of the calf by two "Grey"-type aliens. These "Greys" had long thin tapered fingers with nails. Their large hypnotic, unblinking eyes were yellow with a black vertical pupil. In 1990 John Carpenter, a very experienced hypno-therapist, regressed Cindy, the daughter of Judy. The session produced the same details that had come from her mother years before.

The May 1980 case of Myra Hansen and her young son has many similarities to the Doraty case. They were on a rural highway near Cimarron, New Mexico, and came upon a fear-stricken cow belllowing. Two short, white-suited beings were doing something to it. Overcome with anger Myra approached the scene and soon found herself and her son abducted. The large glowing disc they were on took them to an underground base. Myra thought that it might be one kilometer beneath the Jicarilla Apache Indian Reservation, in the Las Cruces region. In both the Doraty and Hansen cases the women underwent the usual alien physical procedures.

# MEETING THE MASTER CULPRITS ON A COLD MOONLIT NIGHT

Let me now turn to a classic case that occurred in the peak year of 1975 in Colorado. This was originally published in the July 1978 bulletin of APRO. (I was a special investigator for this pioneer group from 1965 until its demise). This case is not fiction, for R. Leo Sprinkle PhD, and John S. Derr PhD. investigated it at the site. I will summarise as briefly as possible.

The beautiful ranch in the Rocky Mountains into which the Evans family had moved, overlooked a military base, and was above abandoned coal mines. A mysterious, loud, "turbine-sound" kept coming from a certain place in the house. In their limited stay at the ranch they would lose a total of six cows to mutilation. The family consisted of the husband, wife Susan, two sons, and a business friend named Jim. These persons and many friends who visited the ranch would see an assortment of UFOs, often at close range. On the amazing "six discs night", Susan got knocked off the couch and onto the front room floor by a beam. Visitors and residents of the ranch suffered induced headaches and paralysis in the harrowing stay there. One

night the transmissions of both their Cadillac car and their station-wagon got trashed. It was all an incredible onslaught of bewildering events too extensive to cover here.

When the discs were about, a mutilation might happen, and a pounding noise might begin on the house - by the "Big Foot" that occasionally appeared. Jim took a shot at the form, and got hell from the sheriff, who knew all about UFOs, black boxes and a lot more. There were 20 witnesses to "Big-Foot", and one night Susan was treated to the experience of being mimicked by him. She went out on the porch, leaned over, shielded her eyes and spotted him. There he was in the timber, doing the exactly same thing to her.

The most fascinating, unreal thing to happen on the ranch took place on a moonlit winter night when Jim noticed a dim yellow light in the pine trees up near the mysterious burned circle. As he approached he saw a black box on the ground that made a buzzing sound. He decided to go no farther and retreated. Then he approached again and found nothing there. Jim would always wonder why he moved on under the trees. He was suffeing from heart disease, and did not really desire to go, but a strange overpowering compulsion kept him walking. He entered a glowing area occupied by two individuals. Down the hill he noticed a dimly lit disc. One individual knew his name and said to him in good English, "How nice of you to come.". Jim asked then a series of questions and complained about the cars' transmissions. He also told them that they were attracting a lot of attention to themselves wiht the mutilations. They were non-commital but did apologise for any inconveniences, and promised a more equitable arrangement! True lies indeed, for the Evans were soon forced to abandon their beautiful ranch!

'Jim was able to study the two beings closely. They were about 5ft. 6 inches, seemed young, effeminate, and wore flight suits that changed from brown to silver. They were very fair, had blond hair with a partial cover, and eyes that were large and striking. The eyes were most impressive. In the blond "Nordic" type aliens we have four types: 1. the adolescent kind such as these; (2) the taller more mature type: (3) the old Nordics in robes, and (4) the giant Nordics. I would guess that these of adolescent type were in a supervisory capacity in the "Mute" operations which we see carried out by the Greys.

Since we really do know who is getting all the uncounted tons of bovine flesh and blood, the next question that screams in our brain is, "Why are they doing this?" Is it somehow linked to the widespread, relentless activity of human abduction and extraction and manipulation of egg, sperm, foetus etc? Do these clandestine primordials need the products of "Mute" in the development of earth/alien hybrids? Large fragments of cattle chromosomes are homologuous (sequentially identical) to human chromosomes.

Do the aliens know something of crucial importance that we don't know? Maybe they know, as is stated in many prophecies, that our fair little planet is doomed to be wracked by cataclysmic upheaval and life as we know it extinguished. So they are developing their own more durable quasi-human life-forms to survive elsewhere in the Cosmos? Only time will tell.

# OBITUARY: JOAN KATHLYN FELICE CREIGHTON, ("EVE")

n the evening of April 18th, 1997 "EVE" departed from our world. The remains of her physical frame -what Gurdjieff called the "planetary body" -BUT NOT SHE HERSELF -lie buried on a beautiful sunlit slope, surrounded by trees, among the rolling hills of south-west Hertfordshire, and less than half a mile from the remote farmhouse where I myself was born.

When I first met "Eve", in January 1947, she was already with the British Foreign Office and was serving on the staff of H.M.'s Consulate-General at Antwerp. She already knew that she was going to be the secretary of a man who was due to arrive shortly "from New Orleans", and, when she first heard my name mentioned, in December 1946, the "inner voice" which she had been hearing all her life, said "You're going to marry that man!"

In July 1947 we were indeed married, in the beautiful red sandstone church high up on Kinver Edge in Staffordshire. (In July of this year we would have completed fifty years of perfect married bliss. We could truly say that there had never been a harsh word or quarrel between us. No man could have ever had a more loving and perfect mate -and a widely talented one too. I have no doubt that we had already been together before, as we shall be again.)

During WWII "Eve" had worked with a Belgian firm in the Midlands, perfecting her French, and she had also taken the very unusual step of teaching herself to be highly proficient at **French Shorthand!** And so it came about that, for our first year, in Belgium, I was able to dictate my correspondence, and we got a great deal done!

In a hasty dash to see Paris -so recently liberated -early in 1946, she had been strolling down the Champs Elysées when she spotted the British Embassy and walked straight in and enquired whether they could give her a job. Shortly afterwards she had been called to the Foreign Office and interviewed and tested -and offered a choice of "either Antwerpen or Baghdad!" Fortunately for me, Antwerp won.

A gifted artist herself, Eve had two university degrees in the History of Art, and later, after our return to England from Brazil, she lectured on Art for years at a college here, and also taught English to foreign students. She was a gifted writer too, and produced many humorous pieces for *Punch*. (Indeed, they accepted the very first article that she sent them, and in following years they took many more.) For years

I had delightful vacations with her, visiting museums and art galleries and other monuments in Europe and in the Middle Eastern lands.

On the domestic side she was a wonderful mother, a splendid diplomatic hostess, and a first-rate cook. And when, in the 1980s, the small personal computer came along, a big article in our local newspaper "plugged" her -already a grandmother -as "the first local woman to own and use one". ( It was Clive Sinclair's ZX81, from which she progressed to the BBC computer, and later the present PC. ) She taught herself to write programs, and for years used computers to assist in her Art lectures. Later, when she had retired from teaching, she threw all this computer competency into working for FSR. By learning the desktop publishing skills needed to produce the magazine herself she was able to drastically reduce the printing costs. And so, for several years, we were able to produce the magazine together as a husband-and-wife team. Later, even with her health seriously declining, she still persisted and brought out the magazine through all her vicissitudes.

Owing to a grave bout of illness when she was a grammar school girl in her early teens (pneumonia, peritonitis, and abscess on a lung) Eve was never able to engage in strenuous sport or exercise, and this was what crippled her for the last six or seven years of her life, most of which time was spent fully on oxygen, which meant that she was largely a prisoner in the home, but ever cheerful and tenacious. During her last four years she was back in intensive care in hospital for long periods each winter, and would have died three or four times were it not for the marvellous work of the doctors and nurses -and her own will to fight her illness. One hospital consultant told me: "Mr Creighton -she is the bravest woman I have ever seen!"

Her final illness started early in April of this year, when she had already prepared almost the whole of FSR volume 42/1 and put it on disc for the printers.

By April 16 she was unconscious, but not suffering actual physical pain, nor indeed did she ever do so. However, by about 5 o'clock in the evening she suddenly rallied wonderfully, and called for our son, Philip, to go home and get the FSR manuscript. Then, with her oxygen full on, she sat up in the hospital bed until 8 pm and revised and corrected the entire text as far as page 23. So great was her sudden

improvement that I began to feel that she would, after all, be coming home once more. But she had done her bit for me and FSR and her mind was at rest. By next morning she was unconscious again, rallying only one last time in the evening, when she spoke in a breathless whisper and Philip, putting his ear to her mouth, heard her last words, which were:

# "IT IS AMAZING...IT IS AMAZING...THAT I AM SO HAPPY!"

She did not rally again, and her brave spirit finally left us on the evening of April 18.

She died as she had lived, a staunch follower of the Christian faith. At the memorial service for her in St. Mary's Parish Church, Rickmansworth, I held in my mind the wonderful words from John Bunyan's *Pilgrim's Progress*, "And all the trumpets sounded for him on the other side".

She too had been a pilgrim and a battler, so my special request in the service was that we should sing Bunyan's hymn "Who Would True Valour See, Let Him Come Hither!", together with Blake's Jerusalem.

The officiating priest made a special point of mentioning Eve's wonderful last words which, without any shred of doubt, can only have indicated that she was seeing and beholding something or someone very important as she passed over into the **Light.** 

Much of my own long life has been spent in the study of Comparative Religion and in dipping into the texts of most of the world's great faiths, always in the hope of seeing "as wide a Truth as possible", and this too Eve shared with me, fully convinced of the common ground of all mankind's spiritual search.

And in our Christian service for Eve that day, in a church of the old Anglican faith, I was happy to note that we also had there, among our many dear and good friends, Catholics, Jews, Muslims, and a Hindu.

FSR directors and their wives were there, dear friends all, to lend their staunch support, but few of Eve's main friends live locally, and there had been little chance to notify many of them.

(Mindful as I am of the shabby treatment that FSR and I have both received from the media over these past forty years and more, I confess that I had not even taken the trouble to inform any newspaper that our Joan had gone ahead.)

My son Philip and daughter Rosamund (twins born in Brazil) and their children, Nicholas, Alan and Chloe, join with me in thanking all of you who have shown us so much support.

But our mood is not of sadness. It is a mood of intense hope and joy because we all know that Joan is now liberated and freed from all that terrible

frustration of her last few years. For such an active, creative soul, to be always shackled at the end of an oxygen tube was a torment, physically painless though it may have been. G.C.
