

The March 2010 UFO Academy brought about the kind of spontaneous debate that will really engage one to the kind of questions we should

be asking. Contact experiencer **Steve Jones** talked about his ideas on the vibrational transmutation of his physical body to something higher as part of the process during contact encounters and whether this step up was part of a critical future process vital to advance humanity.

FSR reader Larry Robson interjected and read out a stiring piece from FSR Vol 43/1 (1998). Myriam, a woman who was abducted in Puerto Rico 1979 and taken on board an alien craft, she heard the following in an **exchange with a humanoid being**.

"If you do not develop a consciousness of the spiritual world, side by side with your consciousness of the world of matter, then you will not survive, many, many lives will be lost. For the vibrational shock, which will be reflected on the physical plane, will be so great that you will be unable to stand it, you will die. Only by raising the level of your consciousness through knowledge, will you be able to refine yourselves vibrationally and be capable of trancending this process. The moment is approaching, and there is almost no time left in which to prepare your selves and the work that will help you understand where you come from, your relationship to us and to the universe."

Are there clues to a possible alien higher plane that is our ultimate destiny?

The two most under-analysed sectors of ufology are matters psychic and the concept of other dimensions. The editorial in this issue begins our endeavour to form a working model that relates psychic energy to the UFO phenomenon. Now we must tackle the concept of other alien dimensions which is somewhat more controversial.

In Steve Jones fascinating talks at UFO Academy, he described his more recent contacts with tall beings of light which led on from his initial encounters. In their presence he was feeling he was free outside his body in a timeless space where his every instantaneous thought was euphoric. Other people find themselves in a soft near dimension, less euphoric, though still traumatised to be weightless, no longer solid. A place where they are repeatedly taken, a softer plane where they can still see our familiar world yet pass through it's solid glass and solid wooden doors to somewhere beyond physical where properties of life and physics feel altogether different.

What is peculiar to this issue of FSR is the overlap of the alien psychic reality with a theory of mind and matter leading to opening up of a new dimension that George Hunt Williamson wrote about in the early 1960s. He referred to an Elder Race that evolved to transcend spacetime in his book "Secret of the Andes." Williamson wrote under the mysterious occult name of Brother Philip.

"The Els were not exactly three-dimensional beings as we are today, although they were definitely physical creatures in a physical world. They had been attempting for countless ages, as a race, to achieve a Timeless condition, to reach a place where they could not only create by mere thought, but escape from the chains of physical existence to break the ties that bound them to physical planets and systems. They were searching for the great secret that would make them Immortals, that they might march across Time and the Stars fettered by nothing.

Our planet was possibly the last world they colonized in the Milky Way Galaxy, for soon after their arrival here they achieved the power of creative thought. They conquered physical matter and became Gods. They annihilated Time and Space; no longer did they have need of the Earth world or the great Galaxy it belonged to. They were free! They had become true members of the Thought Universe."

It was their method of leaving physical existence and conditions that gave them the name of Els. Through the secret use of the Ninety Degree Phase Shift they abandoned the Earth and the entire Galaxy and left it vacant for humanity. A ninety-degree angle forms the letter 'L.' Therefore, when we call them Els we are referring to a symbol of their race and not really to a name. The Els elevated to another dimensional condition. They eliminated Time and Space. Although, in 1956, most of the Els were no longer on Earth, they still acted as Mentors, and were usually the Teachers of the Earth's Masters. We say most of the Els were no longer on our planet, because some of them did not leave when their race achieved the Theta condition and conquered M-E-S-T (Matter-Energy-Space-Time). Because of certain karmic reactions, a few members of the Cyclopean Race did not pass through the Ninety Degree Phase Shift, and were forced to remain on Earth to work out their destiny, eventually to rejoin their race in a later age. In the meantime, they would act as Mentors to human beings when the latter arrived on Earth.

Let it be known that man on Earth will never become an L, but he will achieve a Timeless condition as they did, for the present plan of the Hierarchy is: the production of a subjective synthesis in humanity and of a telepathic interplay which will eventually annihilate time! While man will not be an L, simply because he does not belong to the Cyclopean Race (now the El Race), he will conquer M-E-S-T, and reign as a true God, a Son of the Creator."

Is there a movement of intelligent life towards the ultimate mind ecosystem beyond space time?

George Hunt Williamson (GHW) was referring to an archaic race who had laid the foundation of life here on Earth that was now residing outside our reality. His description brings our attention to thought and mind being implicated in the ultimate control of our matter universe. Rather like Larry Robson's quote from the Peurto Rico abduction, the aliens are alluding to the power of conscious mind inside matter.

Can Grid Theory act as this fundamental source of the mind matter link? Grid theory has appeared among the many quantum universe ideas floating between alternative physics and the new age alternative science movement that tries to lift the lid on the power of the observer to control what he perceives in our world. The "What the Bleep" Movies compared the quantum world to the internal world of the mind. They attempted to paraphrase how mind-matter would behave and interact with the observers mind. A good hypothetical description of a location without an observer was a world unformed by intention, a softer reality of blurred incoherent space with some residual recognisable structure. This would immediately snap together to a hard reality the instant an observer appeared to reconcile the mind matter equation.

This being modern FSR an opportunity came to ask grid questions during a contact encounter with three witnesses in September 2009 in the notorious East Field. A landed object appeared to respond to verbal instruction, creating light bursts and the free exchange of mental energy. This was in answer to specific questions about opening the doorway between their world and ours.

What role do our minds have to play in shaping our external destiny with UFOs? Is there a mental grid that might link our minds more deeply to the nearby hidden world you inhabit?

The light responded "The grid we inhabit drives natures intention for infinite possibility, the internal mental grid we think on inside is one and the same as the external matter grid outside."

In summary: When UFOs connect with us, when they appear to us, we are both moving through this material existence by radically altering our positional wave patterns inside a universal mind grid that re-maps our world in every instant.

An entirely different thought communication is needed to navigate across dimensions and higher energy states on the grid. It all starts with igniting the alien idea in our heads by raising our understanding of the power of the 'l' and the tidal wave of intention herein that may radically re-connect our mentally shifting co-ordinates into a better overall synch with the UFO mind. Otherwise we are merely mentally blundering along the very edge of their habitat to no avail. It is unique brainwave patterns that separate the world of the contactee from everybody else's experience. In fact the deeper implication of this exchange came later from a master dowser in the audience at the spring 2010 UFO academy: Was it possible that nothing ever really moves here other than the scenery around us. What if there is no real movement, just matter restructuring its relationship to the observers mind on a grid?

If the grid energy exists and the power of mind and matter come together by intention, our limited view of our internal brain chemistry does not account for a collosal mental influence that expands way beyond the physical limits of our body. Rather like the way relentless advance in telescopes constantly re-adjusted our place in the solar system and then the galaxy, our influence penetrates beyond all familiar boundaries that govern our space into this new alien grid of mind space yet we do not understand our own power. Hence our incomprehension of them.

Was George Hunt Williamson the true Father of the **Ancient Astronaut theory?**

Where does he fit in Modern Ufology?

History has been cruel to George Hunt Williamson, like many significant figures in our subject he has been posthumously libeled in much the same way as Adamski, portrayed as an unqualified fantasist who thrived in the 1950s saucer hysteria.

Each sceptical assault misses the point; GHW was struggling with new ideas light years ahead of his time. Of great interest are his radio communications with alleged aliens in 1952 covered in FSR 53/4. It is alleged that he received information in these communications about the asteroid belt and the catastrophic destruction of planet X in antiquity, elaborated on by Sitchin some two decades later. Could GHW be the original source of this information? (By an uncanny thwist of fate in this issue Malaysian ufologist Ahmad Jumiladin proposes that the window responsible for humanoid incursions may lie here on the asteroid belt)

Both Adamski and GHW are perfect examples of modern day natural philosophers who travelled the world to propose new ways of re-interpreting our human story far in advance of their time. The fact is that these two men broke with the accepted wisdom after the first alien landing at Desert Centre. Both went on to receive original knowledge attributed from these off world human civilisations that have created a lasting effect. They went on to search independently to contemplate more advanced cosmic humans in our history and elsewhere in our solar system. They travelled the world for the rest of their lives searching for the new truth of our human story; something they knew with certainty was out there to be found. Who was George Hunt Williamson really?

The two best archivists of George Hunt Williamson are Michel Zirger a Frenchman currently living in Japan, and Italian UFO researcher Dr Maurizio Martinelli. It has been my privilege to put these two men in contact with each other. Both hold many original communications from GHW, including unpublished book manuscript material held by Martinelli called "Secret of The Lost Horizon (Shangri-la is alive and well!)." The following article by Martinelli gives the fullest impression of one of the most innovative characters ever in ufology George Hunt Williamson (GHW). The most important finding is the power of GHW as a trained psychic, and the communications he received following the Desert centre contact that would influence his global search for ancient alien influences for decades. Was it that GHW was party to unique information received both by radio and telepathically that propelled him on this outrageous life-long mission?

As we may recall from Emily Crewe's recollections of her meetings with George Adamski, he was manifesting psychic



phenomena, such as mental telepathy, weightless feelings and most of all a mesmeric personality that profoundly affected most people who met him. These are influences that no doubt revealed an altered state that related to their mental influence and the creative intelligence they radiated. What needs to be said in this return issue of FSR is the story of Adamski is very much stranger the more one hears about what happened off the record and the more obvious it is that we do not have the full story of both Georges, whose fortunes came together on November 20, 1952, at Desert Centre all those years ago. I am reliably informed by a witness that there were many more intimate meetings than were recorded; Orthon and others were seen in the house occupied by Adamski having clandestine meetings. There was direct information exchange including the original information that there are three inhabited outposts used by alien humans. Venus. Mars and one of the moons of Jupiter. Mars was a hostile power, the other two were benevolent. All were cosmic human societies whose destiny was linked to our own.

The close connection between GHW and the Flying Saucer Review is clearly shown by the articles written by GHW in the review during years 1957-58-59. The following article demonstrates that very like Adamski, GHW was an extraordinary man who founded many of the modern ideas that we associate with modern ufology. Ancient astronauts, star people: alien souls born into humans, an ancient war and the destruction of planet X by the twelfth planet and the subsequent formation of the asteroid belt. He pioneered alien telepathy, the tracing of ancient lines of earth energy and their connection to the appearance and disappearance of UFOs. Just how was this information sourced? Read on.

The herald of the encounter among Father and Sons Dr Maurizio Martinelli (Italy)

After a long period of silence, during the last few years there has appeared new important documentary evidence concerning the scope of the life of the maverick George Hunt Williamson (GHW). In this article I summarize the documents which allow to better understand the path of this remarkable man.

I have always been puzzled by the fact that few researchers have

written articles and notes on GHW, even though he was at the key place with George Adamski during the famous alleged meeting with the Venusian being on November 20, 1952. He wrote books on the UFO subject from the very beginning, he travelled more than anybody else in the UFO field during 1950s. He wrote books anticipating many themes which are nowadays very fashionable.
