According to the report (*Jornal da Tarde*, São Paulo) the eyewitnesses said that "a bright light, shaped like a VW Beetle automobile, hovered above the little town of Sena Maduera, in the remote State of Acre (far N.W. corner of Brazil) where there had of late been many UFO sightings. This event happened on July 12, (1999?), at about 10 pm. According to Lt. Wesley Rocha, Commandant of the local Military Police Headquarters, the total number of people who saw the pig going up was 'more than 50'.

report by using - as I have done - headlines of a hilarious nature suggesting that the UFOs are carrying out their patrols in search of a tasty meal.

BIG TRIANGLES AND OTHER SPECTACULAR CRAFT. BY GORDON CREIGHTON.

Triangles continue to be reported ever more frequently from all over the world. Long ago it became quite impossible to log all "ordinary" UFOs or lights in the sky, and soon it will be equally futile to try to keep up with all these new accounts of giant triangular craft.

We are of course constantly being assured that they are all **U.S. military aircraft**, the very cream of latest technology. If so, what a hell of an enormous Air Force the U.S.A. must possess **-and what does it all cost! And they are active over every part of the world, it seems!**

Here are a few recent cases -just a sample!

ENGLAND

In Gloucestershire, at 6.30 am on December 7, 1999, a Mr Dave Cosinette saw a giant triangle near his home. When it finally vanished over distant hills, he and other witnesses reckoned that it still measured three inches in width, estimated at arm's length.

CHINA

Until recently we do not recall ever having heard of triangles over China, but in this last big China "flap", in the closing months of 1999, there seem to have been quite a lot of them seen there. The general recent flap over China has been enormous -we shall report on it later.

U.S.A.

On October 22, 1999, a witness saw no less than four totally silent big triangles, estimated at "about 75 ft. long and 75 ft. wide", passing over Brookfield, Massachusetts. On October 9, 1999, a security officer and a policeman saw a silent great triangle passing, at a height of about 200 ft., slowly over Pensacola Beach. Estimated speed: about 100-300 knots.

MEXICO.

At 6.30 pm on November 14, 1999, witnesses saw a large green flying triangle passing over Monterrey. It had vivid green lights.

NEW GUINEA

The *Post Courier* (Papua, New Guinea) had a report from Port Moresby on November 4, 1999, of a UFO 660 ft. long and 165 ft. wide that looked like a great city lit up in the sky. It moved slowly overhead, emitting a "faint puffing type of sound". The eyewitnesses, on the Gazelle Peninsula of East New Britain, numbered thousands.

ITALY.

In Italy both Mt. Etna and Mt. Vesuvius are rumbling menacingly. Large areas of central southern Italy are being forced upwards fast, and an immense recently discovered underwater volcano, its top only a short distance below the surface of the sea, is starting activity not far out from the Bay of Naples, and when she blows -it could be very soon- it might affect the entire Mediterranean very seriously -probably by producing an enormous *tsunami* wave.

In Italy, just as in Mexico, we have known for years past that UFOs are intently watching and studying volcanoes.

On October 23, 1999, At Adrano in Sicily, Italy, a luminous UFO was observed hovering over the summit of Mt. Etna for the space of about 10 minutes and performing various manoeuvres. Hundreds of witnesses in Adrano, southwest of Mt. Etna, described the object as "a white circular thing with a dark central mass that looked as though it was 'scorched' ". It also seemed to be occasionally changing shape. Several people videotaped it, and described it as a "disco volante" (flying saucer).

POSTSCRIPT.

There are many who think the years 2000 and following may be the most spectacular phase that mankind will have experienced for a very, very long time. If so, it looks as though huge triangular craft may have some sort of extraordinary role to play. What will that role be? And what is their role already, now!■

QUERIES ANSWERED.

1) In *The Vanishing UFO and the Vanishing Policemen!* (FSR 44/3) we had asked whether any readers could identify a gentleman named *Leslie* who had been mentioned in that report.

2) With reference to Desmond Leslie's article *My Personal Interview with the Infamous "MJ-12"* (in FSR 44/4), I had asked whether any reader could remind me

of where exactly Dr Hynek had published his devastating comment on Dr Donald Menzel's ridiculous "explanation" of the Papua (Boinai Mission) multi-witness sighting of June 26, 1959.

Reader David Hampton of Bishopstoke, and several other correspondents, have pinpointed this reference. It forms Appendix 2 of Dr Hynek's book *The UFO Experience*, published in 1972, and was titled *Analysis of the Papua-Father Gill Case by Donald Menzel*. ■

ROSWELL AND ANOTHER MYSTERIOUS DEATH.

To whom it may concern:

My name is Dennis Bossack, and along with my wife Ann, own and operate the **UFO LAB** in Richmond, Rhode Island, USA. We are a museum, a research center and gift shop. Later, Ann opened a second **UFO Lab** in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

Ann's father, Richard Clayton Harris Jr., had been the Budget and Fiscal Officer at the Roswell Air Force Base in 1947, and one of his duties was to allocate the funds required for cleaning up the Roswell crash and maintaining the cover-up about it. He would never discuss the Roswell incident.

However, in 1997, Strange Universe contacted Ann about her shop, which at that time it was the only one of its kind. They were engaged in doing a piece of filming about the shop, when they found about her father's previous connection with Roswell. They therefore asked Kevin Randle to interview Mr Harris, and the latter agreed to the scheme.

In the filmed interview with my father-in-law, he had admitted that the crashed craft at Roswell had been a space-ship. And on August 12, 1997, he was murdered in very strange circumstances.

I myself was previously employed by an "above top-secret" agency within a Government. I retired from employment with the agency two years ago, and I am now engaged in writing a book about the agency.
