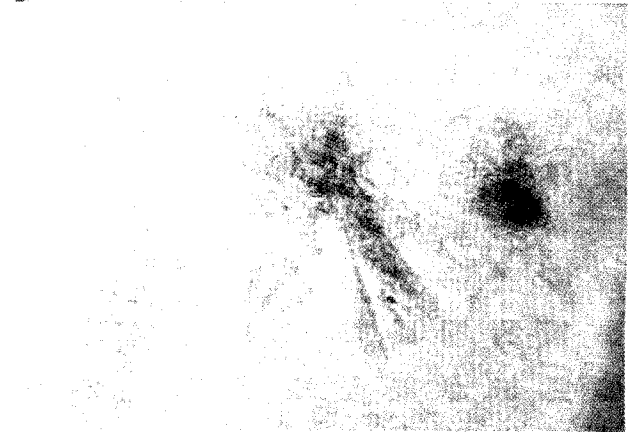

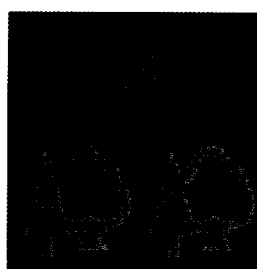

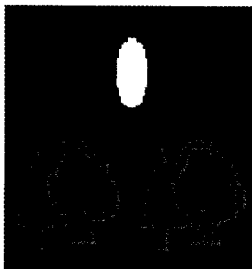

Guest editorial: "SCIENCE"

It is astonishing to see how much talk there still is about a "scientific explanation" of the UFO Phenomenon.

The Phenomenon has been a reality for an ever-growing proportion of mankind since it burst upon their consciousness in 1947. (Which of course does not mean to say that it had never existed previously to 1947. Maybe it has "always been there", but we simply weren't smart enough to know about it!)

So, since 1947, vast numbers of people have been beavering away with their typewriters and, later, with their word processors and their computers, churning out reams and reams of articles and scores of books. And what has been the upshot of it all? I have yet to learn of any sure evidence that anybody or any Government has gleaned anything whatsoever about the alien vehicles, about their means of propulsion, or about the source or sources from which they and their occupants come. (It is true that we now know – alas – a very great deal about what the entities are doing to us humans. But this unwelcome knowledge does not seem to have brought any compensating benefit to mankind).

And so I still say: I see no evidence that we have learned anything scientific. Perhaps we ought to bear in mind that the Latin word "*Scientia*" simply means "KNOWLEDGE". AND WHAT WE CALL "SCIENCE" IS *OUR* KNOWLEDGE. UNFORTUNATELY FOR US, WE FIND OURSELVES CONFRONTED BY *SOMEBODY ELSE'S* KNOWLEDGE. And I am left ruminating on the words of Dr J. Allen Hynek who, in the course of extraordinarily interesting conversation with me which ranged over a whole lot of things far outside the limits of our small and young "Science", had this to say:-

"If, of course, the 'floor' of *their* science is higher than the 'ceiling' of *our* science, then there may no possibility of a meeting of minds, and we may get nowhere."

In making such an observation, Allen Hynek was not acting in the least "like a typical American". For one is reminded of the curious fact that the Americans – maybe far more than any other nation – all seem to believe that any problem that exists *is bound to be*

solvable. No doubt this simplistic view of things stems in part from the fact that they are a relatively "young" and therefore "optimistic" people. Members of older communities such as those of Asia would be unlikely to view matters in that way, since they know full well, from their long, long histories, that not all problems – whether problems of Man, or problems of this poor Planet of ours – are "solvable" by Man. (*As we are shortly going to see!*)

Had the average American and average European possessed a better grasp of world history and other cultures (and especially of other *religions*) they might no doubt have developed a far less clouded vision of the "UFO Problem". And the error stems also from the fact that, as soon as the UFO Phenomenon burst upon their consciousness in 1947, it was instantly and automatically accepted by the overwhelming majority of people that, if these UFOs really did exist, then their operators simply *had* to be our "peers", folk from other planets, and, therefore, *ipso facto*, they had to be "other human beings, just like us."

If, as now seems certain, this sort of thinking is a piece of gross folly, and in all probability one that has been deliberately sown in human minds by the alien creatures, then the whole fatuous idea that they are "other human beings who want to meet us" collapses in ruin.

There is in fact not the slightest shred of evidence that any of them are here to "visit with us", or "to meet us". They have doubtless known all about us for ages past, and it may well be that many of them are the true "natives" of this Planet, and were here long before us. And they are here for their own purposes, and for their own benefit, not for ours. They are not "human beings", but creatures from an entirely different order.

If we fail to understand this, and still cling to the daft and ridiculous "E.T." theory of "Visitors or tourists from other planets", our peril will only be the greater.

More 'Flipping' Triangles: the story continues

Having discussed the background to Project Flying Triangle and how the field research began, in the last issue of Flying Saucer Review, this article will cover some of the significant events that occurred during the earlier stages of our investigation.

After establishing that the Flying Triangle reports from along the east coast of England represented a genuine mystery, further trips to the Suffolk coast were vital. The first was made with a London UFO group and introduced Sue Addison to Project FT; she was to become an integral part of the subsequent field research. On this occasion no Flying Triangles were witnessed – however a related phenomenon was seen and recorded on video. This was numerous 'sky flashes', which were bright enough to disable photosensitive street lights. A third trip was made during this first month of field research to establish a closer viewing area to the north of Sizewell nuclear power station. A suitable site was found, but unfortunately dense fog hampered any chance of a sighting.

Almost a month after the first visit, Sue and I made use of this new site and were to encounter a misidentification of the second kind! Due to the dense fog on the previous visit we were unable to scout the area completely. However, we had a good view to the north of the power station where the Flying Triangle had previously been witnessed entering the area. Shortly after arriving with a third member of the research team, we noticed what appeared to be car headlights behind a tree about 100 feet to the south of us. These lights appeared approximately 40 feet up but, as these were obscured by a tree, we assumed that there was a road beyond our observation point. The headlights then descended to about 5 feet above ground level, so we had again assumed that a vehicle had descended down a hill to literally a hundred feet away from us across the field. We thought it was highly likely that a security patrol may have been wise to our presence close to the power station.

As we discussed this with each other we noticed that these two white lights were now moving apart from one another. None of us had been watching the lights constantly, so we thought that perhaps as patrol had left their vehicle and were now scouting the area with torches. The two separate lights were now approximately 30 feet apart when an amber light came on next to the left hand light. We were now certain that that our presence had not been detected and this was obviously some sort of maintenance work on a faulty light.

The two white lights now moved back to their original position with the amber light remaining stationary. We began talking about how lucky we had been not getting caught so close to the power station, when we noticed that there were now two red lights moving away in the same manner as the headlights we had seen a few minutes earlier. We were now certain that these were the

rear lights of a vehicle which was now driving back up the hill. We did not witness anything else that evening but around midnight the amber went out and we gave up for the night shortly afterwards.

Despite having the success of witnessing the Flying Triangle phenomenon on the very first visit, it was turning out to be more difficult than first anticipated. We took a break for a month and arranged a visit the following month, along with German UFO researcher Wolfgang Stelzig. Having met up, we decided to show Wolfgang the observation point we had used the previous month. This was to check the area for perhaps a better site and see if there was easier access via the road we had seen the vehicle use behind the trees. We found a path leading to the area behind the trees and came across a stile along with an information point on a nature walk. We found this a little odd but all went over the stile and along the path behind the trees. Within a few minutes we had reached the end of the nature trail and came across yet another stile. Sue and I immediately realised that we had actually witnessed something extremely odd the previous month, as there was no road and in fact no vehicle access at all because this was a marsh surrounded by trees.

We can now only imagine what actually was happening behind the trees that night; however, it was highly likely that it was directly related to the Flying Triangle phenomenon. This event now posed many questions, what was the original source of the lights? We had assumed the white lights moving independently were torches, but now knowing this was not the case, we wondered how they were able to move apart. Also, we had now established that no static lights were positioned behind the trees, so we were left pondering what the amber light was that remained. Our only chance of finding out was to spend more time at that this particular observation point.

Wolfgang had arranged to stay in the area for the week, but was unable to get his equipment to this site, so found another area much further north. During his week in England he didn't witness anything, which was highly disappointing for all concerned. Having learnt from the misidentification experience, we purchased every type of map concerning the area, to ensure we were always fully prepared if a similar event ever occurred again. Through this we also discovered that my original sighting could have been in the same area, so we continued using this site for many months, but the experience was never to replicate itself.

Having accepted that we had missed a major opportunity to get close up to this phenomenon, we went 'back to basics' and returned to the original observation point that I had used on the very first visit. It was here that we obtained the first video footage of a Flying Triangle entering the vicinity of the nuclear power station. The sequence of video grabs on top of page 4 show the Fly-



ing Triangle approaching street lights situated in the power station's visitor car park. The Flying Triangle was then seen to go behind a storage building, emerging the other side before we lost sight of it as it reached the power station complex.

On the 30th January 2000 we arranged a trip with a difference; we were to use three teams. Sue and another member were to relay any sightings from the main site, a team of three members was parked in the power station's visitors car park, and I led a team of five on a bank behind the power station. We had meticulously planned this evening in advance, as there were few opportunities to risk being so close to the perimeter of the power station. At 12.50am the risk paid off. We had a call from the main site stating that a Flying Triangle was approaching the power station from the north.

The team in the car park was unable to see anything and although we were level with the top of the storage building and only a couple of hundred feet away we also unable to see anything approaching. We were having commentary describing how the Flying Triangle had 'flipped up' in an identical way to what I had seen on my first visit, and how it was going behind the storage building. Despite checking in every direction - including behind us and above - we were unable to see what was being witnessed from the main site.

As the Flying Triangle was moving out of view the police approached Sue and the other member and quizzed them about being in the area. Fortunately they were able to warn us as the police were approaching, so we quickly began to pack up our equipment on the bank. However, one member noticed an unusual sight above us - a huge V formation of lights was approaching us from above. As it moved along it blocked out the stars in the sky and to give an idea of its size, it blocked out the entire 'Ursa Major' constellation (see illustrations below). In addition to the V formation of lights at the



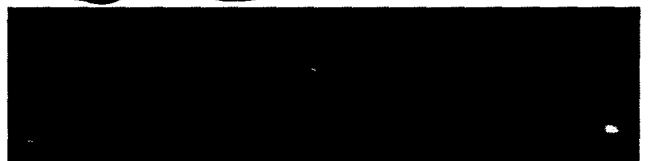
front, the object also had what has now been commonly termed as a 'starfield camouflage' that was visibly moving in conjunction with the object. The formation of lights stopped directly above us, and low cloud moved between us and the object. The cloud cover was moving quite fast and once it had passed, the object had disappeared.

The team in the car park had not been warned of the police patrol nor aware of our sighting on the bank, so we called them to see if they had seen anything. One of the members had alerted the others to the fact that he could no longer see the 'Big Dipper' and there seemed

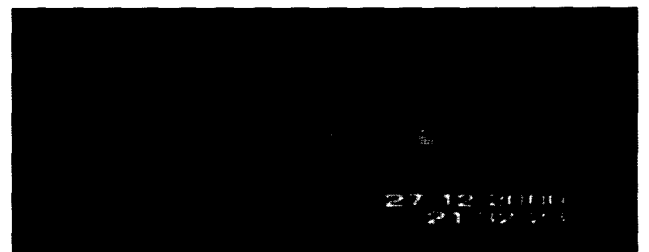
to be more stars which looked different and brighter, but they thought no more of it. We hastily arranged a meeting point outside the town as Sue and her colleague had been escorted from the area by the police and asked not to return. We were pleased with the successes of the evening, but yet again, the night posed more questions than answers. Why were we unable to see the 'flipping' triangle? How large was the object that hovered above us and just how high was it?

As we had gained unwanted attention from the police on this occasion, we felt unable to attempt another field trip so close to the power station and decided to move our efforts further away. We had established that the Flying Triangles came in from the north but were rarely seen leaving in the same direction, so we attempted to identify their exit path to the south. We now began to contemplate the possibility that the Flying Triangle phenomenon may be as curious about our presence in the area, as we were about theirs. Perhaps if we were to find a secluded area to the south of the power station, we might encounter the phenomenon without drawing unwanted attention to ourselves.

We selected a suitable site during the daylight hours and this was a decision we were never to look back on. Although the power station was not directly visible from this new observation point, on the first visit we were to see Flying Triangles entering and departing from the south. We also began to see other phenomena not previously witnessed from our other research sites. We were to see other shaped craft slowly moving above an approach road to the power station.

We also witnessed other strange sights at this new area. On one occasion we became aware of an inverted eye-

shaped light above some trees, as in the illustration on page 1.

At first the colour was pure white but the light seemed to rotate on its horizontal axis, changing the colour to red. This occurred again with the colour changing to green and then again to blue. The light then returned to white and continued the same colour sequence for a number of minutes. The colour order of these lights was extremely significant as during our research we had been experimenting with some meditation techniques. These techniques had supposedly had successes in the past of achieving alien contact. One of these meditations requires mentally sending out sequences of coloured lights in a particular order. The order being: blue, green, red, and then white. The eye-shaped lights were returning the same sequence but in reverse, perhaps this was the first sign of communication between us and the Flying Triangle phenomenon.

In the next article we will disclose our encounters with beings in this new location, accompanied by some compelling video evidence.

Postscript: Triangle seen near nuclear power plant in USA...

Subject: UFO Sighting, Location: Willoughby Hills, Ohio (Lake County)
Date: June 16, 2004

Summary On Wednesday, June 16, 2004, a veteran Deputy Sheriff in Lake County, Ohio, and his wife observed an unusual triangular-shaped aircraft from two separate vantage points at nearly the same time. The husband and wife couple discussed their experience in detail the following afternoon.

The wife reported sighting the bizarre aircraft at a closer vantage point and with more dramatic detail, spotting this unusual object while driving east along State Route 91 near the State Route 91 and 306 intersections near Willoughby Hills, Ohio (Lake County).

Deputy Sheriff Kevin Coleman sought to report the two sightings to the National UFO Center, advising of the situation in a comprehensive summary on the N.U.F.O.R.C.'s "online report form." His report and comments containing other details of the sighting are enclosed below.

Separately, the witness was also contacted by telephone on Wednesday, June 23, 2004 for additional follow-up. Coleman advised that he holds a position as Deputy Sheriff with the Lake County Sheriff's Department, and will see his 11th year in service this coming October. He was promoted to detective within 3-years of duty, has investigated all types of crimes and is a veteran SWAT member. He has also investigated plane crashes in the vicinity.

Deputy Sheriff Coleman reports that the high-flying object he saw travelling from west to east last Wednesday, June 16 was nothing he was familiar with. The object was apparently higher than a jet airliner that was

also seen flying through the area.

Most interestingly, according to the witness, was how this unidentified object seemed to be self-luminous. "I was concerned to find out if this object was just reflecting sunlight. But after studying this for the length of time that I could, it did not seem to change in intensity or seem to be reflecting light in any way," he said. "It had an angular shape to it, giving me the impression that it was self luminous. In my opinion, it was self-luminous.

"It was definitely traveling in the easterly direction of the Perry Nuclear plant when I first saw it," Coleman said. "Then this thing seemed to slow down and get bigger. The object was just 'gone,' not accelerating or flew off somewhere, it simply disappeared."

"I had a good visual on it, there was no question about it moving off."

When asked further about its departure method or how sure he was of this observation, Coleman affirmed his certainty that the object did not depart in a conventional sense. "This was, without question, the hardest part for me to explain about the situation, was how it was gone, mean it was just gone," he said.

Coleman said that the duration of his sighting was between 10 to 20 seconds from the time he first noticed the object traveling from west to east and increasing in apparent size to the point of its apparent disappearance.

The near-simultaneous sighting by Coleman's wife of a boomerang-shaped aircraft hovering only 100-feet from the ground was far more dramatic, according to Coleman, and the duration of that sighting was over 1-minute and discontinued due to traffic circumstances.

First viewed to her right and in a northerly direction, Coleman's wife thought the object was some type of military aircraft that was possibly in a holding pattern. "My wife thought this plane was somehow related to the events of September 11th, or even in some kind of investigation related to 911," Coleman said.

"What made this really interesting is that she was looking out her window to her right, which would be in a northerly direction which would have generally been the same direction as my sighting," he said.

When asked if he notified any other police agencies of the sighting, he said that he did not, only filing the report to NUFORC. Coleman was asked what his thoughts were about bringing this situation to the attention of Homeland Security personnel, or if he feels there is any need for concern due to the uncertain nature of the UFO and its June 16 proximity to the Perry Nuclear Power station.

"The concept of a huge, hovering, abnormal aircraft doesn't register with us to take action on. I don't know what this thing was, but it was far outside the scope of our routine training or duty. This did not seem to be an actionable situation. What I saw was not traditional."

When Deputy Sheriff Coleman was asked if he had ar

objection to his name being listed in this report, he said: "I have no objection to my name being used. This is a subject that is not a hobby to me, my interest in this is simply reporting the truth about this matter. I believe I have been affected by this, and nobody has given me a reasonable explanation for it."

COMMENT

The Perry Nuclear Power Plant is situated on the Lake Erie shore about 35 miles northeast of Cleveland and between 8 to 10-miles northeast of the June 16th UFO sighting location. On June 22 it was announced that the power station will undergo stepped-up scrutiny due to equipment breakdowns and other issues. The plant had been shut down on May 21 due to equipment malfunction, several weeks before the UFO sighting.

In March of 1988 a dramatic UFO sighting took place at the northern-most point of Route 91 (known as the Eastlake UFO Case) where Coast Guard officers and civilian witnesses watched a UFO over Lake Erie. Several smaller objects were alleged to have advanced from the large UFO over the lake and one smaller UFO was seen near the Perry Nuclear Power Plant.

Further postscript: UFOs over weapons areas, USA, and other ufo cases. The following item was filed to FSR on July 3rd 2004 by Brian Vike, Director HBCC UFO Research

Staff Sergeant Assigned To The 355th Security Police Squadron Reports Objects

I was stationed at Davis-Monthan AFB from July 1975 to September 1979, as a Staff Sergeant assigned to the 355th Security Police Squadron. I spent many nights in the weapons storage area and out on the flight line. There was never one rumor of anything out of the ordinary, other than reports of drug smugglers dropping their loads from aircraft near our off-site Titan missile silos, while I was stationed there. Davis-Monthan was very uneventful compared to my other assignments.

May 1972 - January 1974, NORAD Cheyenne Mountain, Colorado Springs: We had occasional sightings of red UFOs on the access road and flying up out of the surrounding woods.

February 1974 - May 1975, Incirlik Turkey: During the Cyprus conflict between Turkey and Greece in 1974, I

sighted a UFO just off base slowly flying around like a helicopter, then suddenly accelerating at a speed nearly too fast to follow them without a sound.

One night during April 1974, I witnessed a white glowing UFO hovered silently over the nuclear storage area at 3:00 am at approximately 500 feet above the ground for about one hour. It appeared to be the size of a Volkswagen. The UFO suddenly accelerated towards the city of Adana silently about 4 am. I had been on duty out there on swing shift until 11:00 pm., and witnessed the object from the Security Police dormitory about two miles away. The next morning my flight had training with the flight who had been on duty out there that night and we compared what we all had all seen. They stated that the only measures taken were to set up their M-60 machine guns, and that they were not to fire on the object unless it initiated a hostile act.

June 1975 - June 1976, F.E Warren AFB, Wyoming: I worked in Keys and Codes, which issued codes for authorized access to the unmanned Minuteman missiles. Keys and Codes was located within Central Security Control (CSC).

One night a missile launch crew reported to CSC that alarms were going off at a Minuteman silo located about three miles away on a rise from the launch center. Minuteman missile silos were unmanned and a launch center controlled ten missiles.

Topside from the launch center, the Security Police response team could see a bright white object lighting up the country side and hovering over the silo. The security team refuse to respond. CSC asked the launch crew what they thought about the situation and the SP refusal to respond. The launch crew states they would get back to CSC and hung up. CSC told the SP supervisor at the launch center to call back and let them know what they decided to do. We never heard back from them during the remainder of our shift.

Maintenance crews reported seeing big foot tracks in the snow walking around the fence line of the silos. Security Police reported colored balls of light drifting through their sleeping quarters at the launch center sites during the night.

At that time, Wyoming was experiencing cattle mutilations in the area. Security Police missile patrols reported several times that they had seeing helicopters at night sitting on the ground with no lights on and their engines running. These sighting were reported to the local country sheriff's offices, but nothing was ever found.

CLOSE-UP SIGHTING DOCUMENTED BY A MINERAL CLAIMS SURVEYOR

Note: The Yukon continues to attract the attention of ufologists, as it is a hotbed of flying cigar reports (see recent copies of FSR).

Montana Mountain, near Carcross, Yukon Territory, Canada. March 16, 1988

Des Clark's UFO sighting took place outside a cabin near "Feather Claim" on Montana Mountain shown above. The cabin is located high above the treeline. The UFO came in approximately over the ridge indicated (see p.1).

INTRODUCTION - by Martin Jasek

In March of 1999, an Engineer who I have known for some time came to our office at my day job with regards to "normal" business. He mentioned that he had read our recent UFO article in the local newspaper. He then went on to describe a UFO sighting which a friend of his had about 11 years ago near Carcross, Yukon, about a 45 minute drive south of the capital city of Whitehorse.

He also mentioned that he had a copy of the man's work diary where the sighting was described in some detail. The witness, Des Clark, was contacted for his permission to obtain a copy of the diary. We are grateful that he agreed. He also gave his permission to use his name in the story. A copy of the diary was obtained from the files of an engineering firm in the City of Whitehorse.

At the time, Des was part of a survey team laying out a grid for a VLF magnetometer survey for a mineral claim for his client "Feather Gold". He was the only one, of about 6 people involved, who stayed on site 24 hours per day. The others normally left after daylight ran out and returned each morning. He maintained a cabin for the survey crew, was involved in the survey work during the day, and performed calculations on the data late into the evening. He spent about 30 days up on the mountain and maintained a diary of the day's activities for his client. It was in this diary that he documented his UFO sighting, just hours after it occurred. At the end of the project he handed the journal to his client, never to see a copy of it until 1999.

The excerpt from the diary starts off with a description of the normal day's activities on March 14 and 15th, 1988, the UFO sighting account early on March 16th, followed by the normal day's activities on the 16th. This places the sighting into some context and adds wonderfully to the candour of the narrative.

EXCERPT FROM DIARY OF DES CLARK:

Monday 14 March

Spent most of last evening doing interim report to -

at 0230 hrs this morning - got up @ 0800 - J.W. @ 0820 hrs closely followed by Larry and Bill B. and Lambertson crew. Waited until 0930 for Larry W. return radio call - no luck. Went to work @ 0940 and called again @ 1000 hrs re: time of Larry's (W.) visit - he's not coming. Phoned twice more during day losing radio again @ 1530 hrs called Larry W. again - he may have radios by tonight - hope so. Screamed our lungs out on the hillside for 2 hours - gave up @ 1730 could have worked until 1900. Completed 4 sta's today (including 4 substa's) John TT and help did well also.

Tuesday 15 March

John, Bill & Lambertson crew up @ approx 0830-0845. Both crews out to survey in south valley. Larry B. & Larry W. showed up @ 1130 hrs - gave us radios. Damned radios have got same frequency as Lambertson's and don't have any CNT channels that we can reach! This radio thing is one big screw up. Tough going for our crew today - they are on ground with not enough snow for skidoos. Only got 26 stations in today while Lambertson crew got 43 over easier ground. On this ground the no. of sta's completed in working day is not necessarily indicative of effort. Throttle cable broke on Whelans skidoo today @ 1700 - had to shut down to talk to Whse. Bill waited until 1800 for radios & EDM batteries from Lambertson crew. John Tom Tom & assistant stopped for tea & discussed progress of the day. 1930 made supper and washed dishes. Had ham and chips. After cleanup made a big stew so that crew can share it if they wish. Put in carrots, potatoes, onions, celery & cubed steak after browning. Cabin very hot from cooking stew and wood stove - went for walk @ 2430 hrs.

Had experience of a lifetime! Coming back and most to cabin, aircraft came over south ridge very slowly lost altitude and hovered around sta's 26-26-2. Craft was so called UFO - blueish aura on periphery of inverted bowl - very low pulsing hum; wind so everything quiet except for barely discernible humming noise. Cannot describe blue/grey light - didn't seem to have any specific source - just over edge and upper overt. Craft was below the ridge to the west of cabin so distance easy to determine relative to our survey grid lines - large diameter - noticed blueish light or glow on my hands and clothing - and I am being observed I'm sure of it as the craft sideslipped to within 150-200 meters horizontal distance possibly 30 meters above us - damn! Could almost touch the bloody thing - when craft slipped in, started barking and ran behind the wood pile at cabin - first impulse was run to cabin and get shot

- stupid - just stayed there - not frightened somehow - cannot determine if any control surfaces - seemed omni-directional - no port, starboard, nose or tail - movements were smooth and I sense very deliberate. Christ! I've been at this cabin 3 weeks and even as I write I know some will think I've gone crackers. I'm bloody sure we (dog and I) were being observed but so overwhelmed did not notice ports, windows or such. Seemed like forever that craft in the valley. The machine left in a tight 180 degree turn to the NE quadrant; through east and up through the south - gained altitude with tremendous acceleration although no propulsion noise except humming and no sound of air displacement, -- the latter I found strange as it defies physical law! Will not call this UFO because it isn't - it's a bloody flying machine - true and simple. Although not frightened when all was happening; went into cabin and it took me 4 matches to light the propane stove - noticed that dog wasn't around - went back outside to call him - no dog - back into cabin - had to hold my cup of tea with both hands to keep from slopping it all over. The time is 0222 hrs of the 16th March and it has taken me an hour and a half to stop shaking enough to put this to paper - dog isn't outside - he just crawled out from beneath the bunk - he has been hiding under the bed all this time! As I write this the impact of the experience is coming home - I know I'll never be the same again and why wasn't there someone else here to witness it also - if only dogs could talk!

In April 2000 a trip was conducted by UFO investigators to locate the cabin where the UFO sighting took place. It took over an hour to find the location. The road that starts in the far valley above near the Community of Carcross could not be followed on snowmobiles all the way to the site. Steep side-slopes due to snow drifts made it very treacherous. In places the road has completely washed out with very steep drops of about 100 metres. The investigators had to find a round about way through areas of deep snow as well as wind swept sections that had no snow, making for difficult snowmobiling.

Des was standing about 5 meters in front the door with his dog when the UFO sighting took place. The UFO came over the ridge at upper right and hovered down inside the valley and above the height of the cabin casting a bluish-grey light on this alpine bowl including Des and his dog.

Wed 16 March

Got up late this morning - didn't get 2 hrs sleep last night with all the excitement. John up and followed by everyone else. Didn't think I'd make it but once I felt the fresh air it felt O.K. We worked the valley and east slope around camp to fill in holes left in the survey grid. John TT and partner off to survey on the south and central area. Heard the sta's he's calling out on the radio - the son of a gun is poaching on our easy pickings - he's surveying the plateau and getting

all kinds of sta's in while Bill is tearing his ass off walking and climbing the side-hill. Bill is going to be so skinny on this job he'll have to run around in the shower to get wet! About 1030 hrs I went back to cabin to make out cheat sheet showing holes in the grid - on the way by I gave that black skidoo a good kick - made me feel better - I've grown to hate that machine - good thing I don't carry the gun in the field. Got back to survey point to find that J.W. had rolled his new skidoo - only cracked the cowl but a shame anyway cause it looks so new and shiny - John wasn't hurt - guess he just stepped off when it rolled down the hill, -- I must remember that trick!

Further details of Des' sighting came forth through telephone interviews. Des also gave a compelling verbal description on the sightings on the Radio show with host Jeff Rense.

The UFO*BC portion (2 hours) of the show starts one hour into the program. It contains Des' interview as well as other interesting cases. Here are some details of Des' sighting which are not covered in his diary:

The UFO was about 18 to 25 metres (60 to 80 feet) in diameter and approximately 4.5 to 6 metres (15 to 20 feet) thick. It was flat on the bottom. There were no point sources of light or any other structure on the UFO, just a blue-grey glow. The UFO lit up the area around for a fair distance but was not painful to look at. The manner in which the craft approached the cabin ("in a smooth arc directly towards us, and then just dropped in") indicated to Des that the act was very deliberate. It was not like this thing was flying around and then noticed him and changed direction to approach him.

Des was particularly impressed at the craft's sudden departure. There was no noise other than the low hum, which was not loud enough to account for propulsion. There was no wind that night. Des went on to describe the departure: "You just don't move an object rapidly through the cold dense air like that and produce no noise. This thing accelerated like you wouldn't believe, and it didn't bank to turn. Even if the propulsion unit was totally silent you should have at least heard the air displacement. It had tremendous acceleration, totally awe-inspiring. It left and disappeared over the ridge."

"You just don't forget something like that!"

For a 15 to 20 minute period prior to the sighting, Des' dog appeared very agitated, unsettled by something. Speculation has it that he may have been able to hear the UFO, which may have been outside the range of human hearing. The emotional effect on the dog after the sighting lasted for quite some time. It was very skittish, tail down between its legs, walking down close to the ground, "very slinky" for two days after the encounter.

When asked about the object's origin, Des replied: "There is no doubt in my mind that it was not from our world".

UFO's and strange encounters - 'The French Connection'

For the three months of April-June 2004, Paul Ponsot investigated 'contactee' incidents in France as part of his University Course (Paris) and also worked on behalf of the Derby based Phenomenon Research Association (PRA). He has unearthed some intriguing cases and the first three are covered in the following article, states Omar Fowler. Anybody who is familiar with the several decades-long history of the ufo phenomenon in France will not be surprised at the French connection! PW, FSR.

France is well known for its good wine and cheeses. For UFO researchers, France is the country of the 'COMETA' report, where for the first time in the world, top military officers and scientists acknowledged that the UFO phenomenon was of ET origin. It is also well known for its close encounters of the 3rd kind such as Valensole. However, many people—including Ufologists—think that France is a poor country as far as abductions and contacts are concerned, but nothing could be further from the truth.

At a UFO conference, when one might ask if any people have experienced contact or contact-like symptoms, there will be an average of 3 to 4 people that will speak out. Although some might be deluded, most of them are normal people from various backgrounds.

My belief is that France, like the USA or Brazil is not spared from alien abductions. But because of the aura of ridicule that surrounds alien contact and the subject of UFO's in the eyes of the general public, the country of Descartes (France) has no network to investigate any abduction claim, therefore they remain unknown.

In my investigation I have uncovered no less than 3 abduction cases and they are just the tip of the iceberg. These cases are:

(1) Mr JC, who woke up as a child with black figures at the side of his bed which seem to have guided his thoughts ever since.

(2) Edmonde - a lifelong abductee - contactee who has also experienced the psychic phenomena often associated with abductions. Her account seemed at first to be extremely far fetched; however, after having spoken with her extensively, I realized she was telling the truth.

(3) Mr D, who experienced an abduction with physical effects on his body that were later medically assessed. This gentleman's account also included multiple witnesses, making it potentially one of the most important cases in the world.

Here I will present you with as much detail as possible on these cases. Later, in the second part of my article, I will relate what I think the abduction phenomenon means to France and the world.

Part 1 The witnesses

(1) JC is a forty year old man from the south of France he is of French, German, Jewish and African stock. His first encounter took place when he was just 3 years old. One evening he woke up to the presence of several beings: they were shadowy-looking with extremely pinning eyes. In their presence JC did not experience the that would have been the classic symptoms of a chill his age, instead he felt a sensation of inner peace and calm. Our witness also experienced another contact when he was five years old. He is certain that he has since undergone further contacts, although he does not remember experiencing any missing time.

When he was a child and a teenager JC thought that the beings he encountered were benevolent extraterrestrials; however, with the passing of time he has become increasingly wary of these entities.

He now believes that they control his thoughts and that they want him to do evil (for example, he recalls that when he was 25 years old he was compelled to encourage young children to smoke). JC says that he is a victim of these beings and he wishes that his contacts had never taken place.

Although the account of this man may seem like a spirit possession rather than a UFO contact, I have chosen to put him in the latter category as he is adamant that the beings he encountered were not spirits but non-human beings.

(2) The next case I will delve into concerns a 57 year old woman called Edmonde B. She lives in Paris and has undergone numerous contacts with extraterrestrial beings. In the aftermath of these contacts she has developed (like many other abductees and contactees), numerous psychic abilities, clairvoyance and healing powers.

What I am about to tell you will seem incredible to some, but having met the main witness and having spoken to her extensively I can vouch for her sincerity. Her first encounter took place near the town of Montebellain in the North East of France.

One winter afternoon of 1972, Edmonde was driving home from work with two colleagues when they encountered a landed saucer shaped object 10 meters in diameter, in a field near the road.....Suddenly it went dark! The three were puzzled at first and then shocked as they realized that 3 hours had vanished from their lives! It was only when she was placed under hypnosis many years later that Edmonde was able to reveal that during her episode of missing time she had undergone a typical abduction examination.

During the period of the abduction, Edmonde's colleagues had simply been left in the car in a comatose type state but she had been subjected to a medical examination by beings with a greenish scaly skin. Although they had such an unconventional appearance, s

had described them in her own words as 'beautiful'.

Edmonde's next contact took place in the town of Orange in south-eastern France in 1978. She was staying in the town with a colleague, for professional reasons. They were supposed to stay in a small hotel in the town centre, however at the last minute Edmonde heard a voice telling her to change her hotel and to spend the evening in the hills above Orange. She decided to take the advice of 'the voice' and changed her hotel. Then, later, together with her colleague, she went up into the hills.

Suddenly the pair noticed a huge saucer shaped object emitting beams of light. "It appeared from nowhere," said Edmonde. The UFO appeared to be structured and more importantly, it seemed to be playing with her: it was literally answering her thoughts. The scene lasted for over one hour, much to the astonishment of her previously sceptical colleague. That same night, Edmonde learnt that a shoot out had taken place in the hotel where she was supposed to have been staying, killing 17 people in all.

To this day, she feels the aliens saved her life!

Edmonde's next encounter is extremely spectacular and is situated between alien contact and space and time shifts. It took place in Marseilles one warm July evening of 1984. She was travelling with her personal taxi driver, a French-Tunisian. As they reached the Marseilles Sant Charles area (Central Station), Edmonde and her driver noticed how calm the city was: not a single passer by, not one car. They thought this strange, as in July the city is always full of holiday makers - (the 'Oz' factor).

Suddenly the pair had the impression that the car had lifted off the road. All of a sudden, they both noticed in horror that a strange 3 wheel car had passed by them. Its shape was almost round (nothing like the 3 wheel car made famous in the 'Mr Bean' series in the early 90's). However, what frightened them most was the driver of the car: a woman with totally green skin, green hair and enormous spots all over her body. Her description can be matched with that of the reptilian beings often encountered in the USA and Canada.

Then suddenly both Edmonde and the cabby found themselves back on the busy streets Marseilles. They both had the impression that they had travelled in another dimension. Edmonde noticed that after her journey in the other dimension her skin became smoother, her cholesterol level that had previously been very high was back to normal. Benoit's (the taxi driver) hair had regained its usual colour and his skin whitened in the weeks following their journey through space and time.

(3) The next case concerns a man named Mr D and five other witnesses. He is 62 years old and has worked as a senior technician in civil aviation. The events that changed his life occurred on the 10th January 1998 in Harivilliers (a hamlet near Paris). At 7am our hero was going hunting with four friends. They were going to join a party of 25 other local men. At 7.20am one of the party was just arriving near the meeting point when he noticed a gigantic saucer shape hovering over him. It was 50 meters in diameter and emitted extremely pow-

erful multi-coloured lights that bathed his car. The scene lasted about 30 seconds, and afterwards departed in the direction of Mr D's car.

As Mr D saw the object he felt compelled to go under it (he also described a feeling of intense sadness as he saw the object). As the 5 friends went under the saucer, they experienced a total blackout that lasted about 3 minutes. Afterwards, the craft departed and the 5 men joined the rest of the hunters.

They didn't mention the incident during the whole hunt but later discovered that the first man had also seen the object as well as another member of the party who had been following them. Gerald Deforges, a researcher who first investigated the case, discovered that the latter witness was a retired top military officer at the Taverny military base that is home to part of France's nuclear weapons. The importance the case played in Mr D's life was however only discovered later.

In the weeks following his encounter the main witness tried to forget all about it. However, he began to get bizarre impressions that led him to contact Gerard Deforges from the 'LUMIERES DANS LA NUIT' journal. First of all he began to have a feeling that he had encountered a being similar to the tin woodman in the film 'The Wizard of Oz'. For Mr D, that being was soulless and devoid of emotion. He also began to receive thoughts about advanced physics and astronomy, two subjects that had never previously interested him.

For instance, he told Deforges that the whole universe was 'binary' and that he had developed an interest in tachyons (elementary particles that may move faster than the so called 'speed of light barrier').

Mr D also began to think that he had a mission in life. He was convinced that he underwent an abduction during his brief period of missing time. This seems to be confirmed by various other signs that are very physical. In two months following the encounter Mr D developed a condition that was medically assessed as 'keratoconjunctivitis'. The optician that examined him stated that only an exposure to high energy ultra violet radiation could have caused such an inflammation.

None of the other witnesses suffered identical lesions; however Mr D stated that he had stuck his head out of the car as they passed under the UFO. Our main witness also suffered from a bluish growth between his toes. He believes this is due to the insertion of an implant during his brief period of missing time. Deforges also noticed a brown mark on the witnesses left cheek that he says he has had since the encounter.

This case is currently still being investigated. There have recently been a few discoveries made that could indicate Mr D might be a regular abductee and that members of his family might also have been contacted by aliens. Like many abductees, our witness has always felt that he had a 'mission in life'. More importantly, Mr D has suffered from a rare blood disorder called real polyglobulemia since his teenage years. Research in the USA has shown that abductees often possess rare blood groups.

Prior to the January 10th incident, 2 members of Mr D's family had sighted UFO's. Could they be abduc-

tees? Unless the rest of the family are prepared to talk, we shall never know.

Part 2: Analysis and Theories

These cases show us that the UFO contact phenomenon is very widespread in France and that evidence seems to point to the fact that it is global. Let us try and find the meaning to all of this.

First of all we might ask where do the aliens come from? Well the conclusion that I have come to after talking to the people that I have met, is that the UFO phenomenon has multiple origins.

Some UFO's seem to come from outer space, for they have been tracked on radar. Once here they leave multiple marks on the contactees' bodies, as was shown in Mr D's case. In many incidents the ufonauts seem as physical and as material as we are.

However to reduce the alien contact phenomenon to one single theory is far too simplistic, as a great part of the UFO phenomenon seems to overlap the barriers of psychic phenomenon. Let us reflect on Edmonde and her journey into space and time.

In that other reality the entity that she encountered was almost identical to the reptilians that are so widely described in the USA or Canada. We know that like Edmonde, many contactees develop psychic abilities that range from clairvoyance to mediumship. They develop second sight and are often plagued by a poltergeist-like phenomenon. Is it possible that some aliens could originate from other dimensions in space and time and that they somehow pop into our reality through some mysterious doorway?

There is also another point of origin that is worth discussing, although it is often dismissed even by the most liberal Ufologists, but I think it is a possibility like any other. 'Some' aliens could originate from underground bases/caves beneath the earth's crust, or even bases under the sea that have yet to be discovered.

This assumption is based on the fact there have been incidents where the UFO's have been seen coming in and out of the sea. Edmonde, who has become a channeler since her contact experience, has received messages telling her about a race of lizard-like humanoids that live in caves beneath the earth's crust and have always had contact with surface humans. Is this piece of news genuine or is it manipulation on the part of the aliens? At this time no one can claim to have all the answers!

What is the purpose of an alien or 'non human' presence in the skies of France and the world? To answer this question we must look at the intentions of the aliens. It is clear that one cannot say all the aliens are benevolent. From what we can see in the 3 French cases, some aliens seem well disposed while others seem not.

There is certainly a difference between the manipulative entities met by JC and the lifesaving aliens encountered by Edmonde. Other aliens seem total indifferent to humans: neither hostile nor benevolent:

they treat us like lab animals. One of the contacts met at a conference, but whose account is not mentioned in this paper, said very emotionally that what shocked him the most with the Greys (the aliens he encountered) was their lack of compassion, the lack of emotion showed towards their human victims. Mr D said that the impression he received from the aliens were that they felt cold, emotionless almost like robots of some sort. The fact that some aliens seem hostile or indifferent is worrying. However, even more frightening is the fact that we could be witnessing a silent invasion: in a way some aliens could be modifying the genetic structure of the abductees for their own reasons and purposes.

When one looks at the health reports concerning abductees, one can see that their blood is different to that of other people: Mr D is affected by polyglobulemia, a blood condition. About 15% of abductees possess the blood group that is rare in other categories of the population. Many of the population, be it in France or some other country, posses psychic powers (Edmonde velleux has a gift for clairvoyance and healing is just one example). If this theory is true let us hope that humanity will be the beneficiary of these alterations.... Alas, only time will tell.

Many readers will want to know if the French government knows what is going on. I think the answer is Yes. However, I think it is powerless to do anything about it. Therefore, under the cover of open mindedness (the creation of GEPAN in the mid seventies), the French government has imposed severe censorship on UFO matters.

Is it a coincidence that the SEPRA was more or less dissolved after its chairman Jean Jacques Velasco announced in his last book that the UFO phenomenon was of extraterrestrial origin? Why is the UFO subject not discussed on talk shows and in the mainstream press? How is it possible that an incident like the Haravillier event did not receive any coverage from the national press? Why was the COMETA report not even commented by national TV or a government spokesman? And what about the Roswell incident, in France, more than anywhere else, only assimilated to the infamous alien autopsy film, in magazines and in the media?

The answer to all this censorship lies in the fact that like most other major governments, the French government knows about the unearthly presence in our midst but is incapable of doing anything about it!

As I write this article, more cases of contact are being discovered in France and I will therefore keep you informed in a future report. But I ask you, with the alien presence and the blackout that surrounds information dealing with it, can we survive as a species?

consider that this is his first foray into the field of 'Ufology'. His investigations have been part of a project connected with a paper that he is producing as part of his university work. (ABDUCTIONS)

He first approached us earlier this year, asking if we would assist him with initial guide lines on how to approach the subject and then to assess his work and to publish it if possible.

You will have read his report and although his first case smacks of psychosis, he has persevered, aided by a 'contactee' questionnaire supplied by the PRA. The discoveries that he has made during his investigations help to confirm a pattern associated with contactee cases worldwide. This is convincing evidence from an investigator that was largely unaware of the incidents repeatedly found in contactee cases. We have his discovery that some contactees had early childhood experiences of seeing small figures in their bedroom. There was the

experience of the contactees who suddenly found they had lost three hours of time, with one being taken for examination while the other were kept in a state of paralysis. The meeting with the 'Reptilians'!

The strange case of the taxi travelling to Marseilles, with the two occupants becoming aware of the strange silence and lack of people or traffic being around. That is something that I too have encountered in my investigations and a phenomenon that the author and investigator Jenny Randles has described as the 'OZ Factor'.

Paul also came across instances where the 'contactee' had recognised a complete lack of compassion and feeling from the alien being, methodically carrying out a physical examination of the helpless victim. This is an example that once again confirms the lack of emotion exhibited by the aliens (or their robots). In all, an excellent piece of research carried out by Paul Ponsot and we anxiously await the follow-up!

UFO reports - and my Encounters with the Men In Black

Introduction by FSR

The 'Men In Black', or MIB, have been an accompanying feature of the ufo phenomenon for decades. Sometimes they dress in black, often they dress smartly in suits and other attire, and behave in a rather 'stiff or unnatural fashion. Typically, they come knocking on the door of a percentage of those whose reports of ufos make their way into the media - although they did not knock on Frank's door, they just sat in the car outside. Sometimes, the visits are interspersed with phone calls warning the witness to 'stay quiet from now on or else'. In this article, Frank Scassellati recalls his experience(s) of the MIB. In a postscript, FSR Consultant Don Tuersley, who knew Joyce Bowles - witness to a very close "encounter" in a quiet country lane at Chilcombe, near Winchester in 1976, England, a short distance from where modern crop circles first made their appearance near Cheesefoot Head, in 1978 - recalls how Joyce had her own strange experiences - some of them paranormal - before and after her encounter(s).

My encounters with the "Men-in-Black" occurred as I will reveal to you now. I was returning home from a high school football game on September 25th, 1970. I was three blocks from my home, in Jessup, Pennsylvania, U.S.A., when I sighted a most remarkable object in the evening sky. It was disk-shaped, approximately 1000 feet in length, aluminium-silver color, and glowing white. It had a large turret on top, surrounded by a row of rectangular windows. The turret was flat on its top. The underside of the disk had three large spheres, and a central, flat disk. I watched in amazement as this wondrous object drifted silently across the evening's sky, in

a west to east direction. The sky was clear. The temperature was about 50 degrees Fahrenheit.

When I returned home, I was quite shaken by what I had just witnessed. I felt, for more than thirty years now, that I had not been abducted. But I now realize that my abduction by these star visitors is quite possible. I left the football game at about 8:00 P.M., but did not return home until 10:00 P.M., after my extraordinary U.F.O. encounter. This two hour discrepancy had always bothered me. I did not have any memories of being abducted, but I do not remember walking home after my U.F.O. sighting. I had been transfixed by this amazing U.F.O., mesmerized by its capabilities to seemingly defy gravity, and drift silently across the evening's sky. The period after this anomalous event is a complete blank to me, and I am currently trying to retrieve these lost two hours of "missing time" through regressive hypnosis. An extraordinary event that I had thought had come to an end more than thirty years ago now seems to be unfolding into an ever deepening mystery.

I was 16 years old at the time, and I told my parents about the amazing event that had just transpired, and asked them if I should inform the authorities. My parents feared ridicule and said that I should wait for a while. While I was deciding what to do, feeling anxious about my encounter with the unknown, that object was still etched vividly into my memory, as it still is to this day. I can still recall and play this amazing event in my mind's eye at any time, it is forever burned into my memory - an extraordinary event that I will never forget.

I was pacing anxiously back and forth in my kitchen, and I decided to look out the window. While I was peering out my kitchen window, I saw a huge, black limousine parked by the side of my home. I could see this quite clearly because there is a street lamp directly

across the street from my home. The limousine had a rounded appearance in the headlight, front area of the vehicle. It was a very large vehicle, and appeared to be extremely heavy. It seemed to me at the time to be some type of car of the future. It seemed perfectly molded, with no seams. It was devoid of any of the insignias or decals that would distinguish it as, perhaps a Cadillac or Lincoln. It was very smooth in appearance, and seemed brand new.

The occupants of the limousine, the "Men In Black," were as strange, or even more strange, than their vehicle. Two of these entities sat in front, two in the back, of their limousine. Each had on black coats and hats similar to those worn in the 1940's. They sat motionless in their vehicle, and stared straight forward. I was most impressed by this behavior, or lack of it. They did not move, and appeared to be mannequin-like. Their faces were pale, white, expressionless. Their mere appearance frightened me.

I called my parents over to the kitchen window to show them these bizarre beings, and their strange vehicle. I asked my father if we should call the police, and again he said we should wait a while. "They are just sitting there," exclaimed my father. "If they do anything wrong, we will call the police." You see, at this time I didn't know who, or what, the "Men In Black" were. I did not even, at that time, associate their appearance at my home with my U.F.O. experience. It just seemed to me, to be several extremely strange occurrences happening at the same time. I thought that the "Men In Black" might be gangsters, who would retaliate if anyone informed on them. It wasn't until I read about the "Men In Black" years later in a U.F.O. magazine that it occurred to me that the appearance of the "Men In Black" at my home was in relation to my U.F.O. sighting.

The "Men in Black" returned close to my home for several evening's, five all together. They seemed to appear out of nowhere in the evening, and vanish in the morning. I was walking home on one of the five evenings of their appearances at my home, and I was able to get a good look at the front of their vehicle, and its occupants. The rounded headlight and front area were quite noticeable. I saw a Russian "Zil" limousine years later on T.V. and it seemed somewhat like that, but still not quite. It was so unusual and out of place, uncommon. The occupants, the "Men In Black," were also quite visible. They still remained motionless. Their faces were expressionless, appearing menacing even though they were devoid of expression. Their mere appearance outside my home filled me with fear. After their five night visit, they vanished, to return nevermore.

I reported my encounters with the MIB to Ms. Mary Sutherland, and her website: www.burlingtonnews.net and Mary told me that the MIB might have some type of listening or monitoring devices, and were monitoring what was going on at my home. I believe this to be true. I always felt that the "Men-in-Black" were "watching," or spying on me, when they were outside my home. I felt very uncomfortable when they were parked menacingly by my home. I don't believe the MIB to be government agents. Their appearance was so "out-of-this-

world." I believe them to be extraterrestrial, or perhaps, inter dimensional, in nature.

My U.F.O. experiences appear on her website under the "Paranormal and U.F.O. Files" section. I would like to thank Ms. Mary Sutherland, who has helped me a great deal to understand my U.F.O. experiences. She is helping many others to understand these anomalous U.F.O. experiences, and I would highly recommend anyone who has had U.F.O. or paranormal related experiences to contact Ms. Mary Sutherland, at her website should they wish an understanding of their anomalous experiences.

I hope this better enables you to understand the phenomenon known as the MIB and I will be available should you have any further questions about the MIB or any of my other U.F.O. experiences. I, and many others, are fighting for full disclosure about the U.F.O. phenomenon. We, and all of humankind, have the right to know the truth.

Background about me My name is Frank Scassellati, and I live in Jessup, Pennsylvania, U.S.A. I attended Keystone Junior College, and East Stroudsburg State College, both in Pennsylvania. I graduated with a B.A. degree in Humanities and the Arts. I have always been extremely sensitive, perhaps somewhat psychic, and I've always felt a strong attachment to the paranormal world, a world that lies hidden. As I have stated, I had my first U.F.O. encounter on September 25th 1970. I have had two other U.F.O. experiences. On July 11th 2002, I sighted two huge, diamond-shaped U.F.Os, in the town of Peckville, Pennsylvania. On November 3rd 2003, just a few short months ago, I sighted a huge, triangular-shaped U.F.O. in the town of Dunmore, Pennsylvania.

Here also is some information on a U.F.O. investigation I am currently working on. On November 9th, 1974, U.F.O. js alleged to have crashed, or perhaps intentionally landed, submerged, into a silt pond in the town of Carbondale, Pennsylvania, U.S.A. I was at this site on November 10th, 1974. I believe this to be a true U.F.O. incident, that has been kept hidden for nearly 30 years. Ms. Mary Sutherland, of BUFO Paranormal and UFO Radio, U.F.O. researcher Ron Hannivig, and myself are reopening this perhaps forgotten incident in the annals of U.F.O. history. Mary Sutherland plans to do a documentary on this event, and hopefully to be sold to the Sci-Fi channel and other cable outlets.

The more I research into eyewitness accounts and the more information Mary, Ron, and I gather, the more am convinced that this U.F.O. incident occurred. D roads were widened to bring in military and other vehicles, and a large crane, to retrieve the submerged U.F.O. Ron Hannivig told me that there is still an indentation in a fence where the U.F.O. was taken over it. Mary, Ron, and I hope to reveal facts about this U.F.O. incident that will prove this U.F.O. event to be true.

Joyce Bowles lived east of Winchester (England) ar

had moved from her previous home because of regular paranormal activity occurring in the house, which was subsequently demolished, the site remaining vacant for several years afterwards.

On visiting her after the event at Chilcombe, she talked to me and my wife, Peggy, about poltergeist activity – such as brass candlesticks flying across the room from her mantelpiece – which had been witnessed by a police officer. During one visit, Joyce asked Peggy to accompany her to one of her bedrooms, which seemed to be “active”. Both women experienced being enveloped by heavy fibreglass curtains when standing by the window, despite a lack of wind, so they moved to the other side of the room. To their surprise – but perhaps not to Joyce’s – a wardrobe they were standing next to lifted itself off the floor by about six inches and came down with a bang.

Misty figures

One on occasion, Joyce saw a figure in the house. It didn’t appear to be solid and was pointing towards Chilcombe and Cheesefoot Head. On another occasion a figure, again indistinct, followed her from her house to her garage. She became nervous and returned home by another route; when inside, looking out of a window, she could see the entity standing by the garden gate.

Joyce once told me about a visit, she had by a person claiming to be a “government scientist”. The visit came after the publicity about her close encounter at Chilcombe – at which she was not the sole witness, by the way. She also told me about phone calls she had received from supposed “government agents”, who advised her to keep quiet about the encounter.

Her encounter: (Source: Leslie Harris, *FSR*, February 1977 (Vol. 22, No. 5), p. 3., sourced from http://www.ufocat.com/on_this_day/November14.html) In 1976, Joyce Bowles, 42, and Edwin Pratt, 58, were

driving near Winchester, England to pick up Joyce's son and girlfriend from a farm at 8:50 p.m. when they notice an orange glow in the sky. They turned down a narrow lane and immediately their car began to “shudder and shake” as though it were coming to pieces." The car was pulled diagonally off the road. When the car came to rest they saw a glowing, orange, 15-foot-long cigar-shaped object about 5 yards in front of their car, hovering 12-18 inches from the ground. They were both badly frightened and the driver turned off the engine.

The UFO appeared to have jets beneath it from which a vapor was issuing. In the top left portion of the craft was a window, through which they could see the heads of three men. A 6' tall man with a slim build, wearing a silvery suit, emerged by passing through the side of the object. He had long blonde hair, a dark beard, and his skin was pale. Just as he approached the woman noticed a “whistling noise.” Reaching the car, the man bent over, placed one hand on the roof, and looked inside. His eyes were pink “like an albino rabbit,” and were so penetrating that when the woman looked away she could still see spots of light as an after-effect. She also felt that the man transmitted some kind of influence that caused them to remain calm. The being stood at the side of the car for 2 minutes, then moved away to the rear of the vehicle. He did not reappear, and when they again looked forward the UFO had disappeared.

Note by FSR. The full report details the burn marks left on the car roof where the “alien” had placed his “hand”. What many do not know is that Joyce had other close encounter experiences. She told Don and Peggy that on one occasion the car she was in, close to the scene of her Chilcombe encounter, was “suddenly inside a flying saucer shaped craft,” still inside her car, that deposited the car, with her inside, on a road many miles to the south of Winchester.

UFOs continue to be seen in our skies, close to the ground and even on the ground (in Cuba) - as our selected cases, courtesy of Filers’s Files and other sources, show

BRISTOL/CANANDAIGUA – An almond shaped disk type object

was observed hovering over the hills on April 30, 2004, at 11 PM. An object that was bigger than the light it projected was observed through binoculars and the outline of the object was visible but it was not lit. Two other similar objects were seen but they changed shape as they moved back and forth, then up and down. These were not planes, satellites and stars. The witness stated, “They moved within milliseconds of any activity in the sky that I have ever seen.” I could see almost every turn they made and as they changed from almond shape, to disk shape to something that seemed perfectly round, and hovered right over my house. There was a design on the bottom of this one craft, almost looked like that of a phoenix or some type of fancy geometrical design.

The one that came the closest was mostly grey that would shift into a bright blue, white and then it would flash something red once in a while. It had an aura around it and it would move towards the other two in the sky (which were farther away than the one I was observing), when that happened then the other two would seem to move rapidly and disappear at random moments and then reappear. As I watched this one come closer, I could feel a “pull” that is hard to explain unless someone knows or has experienced what I am talking about. I was outside when this happened and these objects were appearing in the eastern skies.

I stood there studying them for about 3 hours. I lost track of time and then became too tired to continue. I remember that before walking into the house around 3 am, there was a huge thing that swept right under it (the

VANCOUVER, BC - A call came in from two witnesses who were sitting in their car at English Bay, British Columbia April 28, 2004. They reported that they were watching three unusual objects and giving me the description over the phone as they observed them at 10:45 p.m. The witness said she was watching the objects through her binoculars and said the one object was huge and the other two a lot smaller. The large object was circular in shape, bright white and filled with what she described as darker dots. In the center of the object there was nothing, or one would be able to see through it.

The object was also rotating and had two smaller objects flying around it. One of the crafts was reported to be triangular in shape and the other again more circular. The triangular craft would move a distance away from the larger object, makes sudden turns and at times they were able to observe the full triangular structure and at other times see it being flat. The smaller circular object would travel around the triangle shaped object and also move around the circumference of the larger object.

Australia - Cluster Of White Lights - huge object

ADELAIDE -- Around 8.30 PM, on April 25, 2004 I was inside in the kitchen on the phone to my friend when my husband came into the kitchen and asked if I wanted to see a ufo. I didn't really know what to think as he is such a skeptic and is a very logical thinker, so I went outside for a minute. It was cloudy and at first I couldn't see anything, but then I saw a series of white lights, not round but more rectangular shaped lights and they formed a cluster, flashing. Then a second circle of lights formed around the cluster, then a third and final circle of lights surrounded the other two circles. The lights were rotating in a circle and were flashing. I could barely believe my eyes. What we were looking at was the base of something of incredible size. It was huge - about the size of a football field, massive - and the small circle of lights seemed to spin and the whole thing tilted.

I was frightened, and I kept asking my husband what is it? He said, I don't know, that is why I had to show you. Ten minutes later he went outside again and it had gone. It was huge and was definitely the bottom of something very large. The sheer size of it, is what got me. How could something that big be in the sky? The lights must have been extremely bright to shine through the clouds as they did. I am a mother of four grown children. I am a pharmacy assistant and my husband is a supervisor at his work.

Florida - Flying Triangle Craft Disappears!

FT. LAUDERDALE BEACH - At 3:35 PM, while on Pompano Beach we watched a black triangle shaped object moving at high altitude on May 8, 2004. We first thought it was a large military aircraft, but the closer it came it was apparent that it was huge in size and

dwarfed commercial airliners flying into Ft. Lauderdale/Miami Airports. We could see the contrail over the Atlantic Ocean that was huge circles. The craft a proaching land went into a partial cloud cover, but you could see through the cloud. We watched to see it come out of the cloud, but it simply disappeared. We waited and looked around in other directions but it was gone. Strangely the contrail stopped short of land and the craft was just gone and the normally busy flight path was empty of aircraft for at least a hour. The contrail stayed for 30 to 45 minutes. It was bigger than 10-15 commercial jets set side by side. They would not have covered it. It was flying at an estimated 35000 feet. I don't know what it was or why it vanished. There was no sound.

Missouri - UFO Sighted By Two

ST. JOSEPH -- St. Joseph News-Press reports. "After witnessing an unidentified flying object in the early hours of May 4, Ivana Calhoun, a carrier for the St. Joseph News-Press, painted the scene. 'I'm positive I saw it but what it was, I don't know,' she said. A couple of rural St. Joseph News-Press carriers 100 miles apart see the same UFO! Ivana Calhoun and David Stafford both claimed they did see something strange zip past their windshields one morning this month. That Mr. Calhoun, who was delivering papers in rural McFall Mo., saw the same object Mr. Stafford saw while traveling through Grayson Mo., makes it even stranger. "I've never seen nothing like it, and I've seen plenty of shooting stars. I'm out there every night.. I know what they look like," Mrs. Calhoun said. Mr. Stafford said he's driven the same road a million times and never seen anything like it, either. Not for several months, at least. "About nine months ago," he said, "I saw one on the side of me, like following me." For Mrs. Calhoun Tuesday morning, May 4, didn't seem out of the ordinary. After delivering a paper on her route, she saw about 50 feet away and 50 feet up a fluorescent orange sphere the size of a basketball zip across her windshield. The orb flew in a straight line and didn't make a sound she said. In less than three seconds, it was gone." It so happened that Mrs. Calhoun was on her cell phone talking to Mr. Stafford at the time. He was just leaving Grayson, Mo., when he saw the same "Day-Glo" orange object about 30 feet away. "We described it to each other, and it was the exact same thing," Mr. Stafford said. "I thought it was a falling star, but it was going parallel to the ground. And both of their watches read 3:45 a.m. Mrs. Calhoun made a detailed report with the National UFO Reporting Center. She was a guest on the "John Rense Program," a nightly radio show about UFOs. Mrs. Calhoun and Mr. Stafford both said the UFO hasn't kept them from their paper routes. They both were back at it the next morning. "That customer hasn't missed a paper," Mrs. Calhoun said. "But (the customer) has no idea I'm scared of his yard. Thanks to Mike Frizzell

Canada - Seven Fast Objects

EDMONTON -- On May 10, 2004, at 12:45 AM, the witness was looking northeast out a large picture window when he saw what he at first thought a meteor

shower in the northwest sky. However, the way the lights were traveling made him quickly realize they were not meteors. "I went out my front door and watched as they moved like birds flying south. There were seven objects moving at about the same speed but changing places. The creepiest part of the whole experience was that they didn't seem too far off and they were completely silent. I am involved with jet car racing and know that to attain a speed like what I witnessed would have to involve some sort of afterburning jet engine that would create an incredible amount of noise at that altitude and speed. They appeared to fly from Fort Saskatchewan towards the Camrose area. I was a bit 'creeped' out about the sighting.

Oklahoma - Diamonds Not of This World

MCALESTER - A couple saw diamond objects flying above them that seemed to be observing them. The wife first saw the objects at midnight on June 13, 2004, as she tried to point them out to the husband. He was unable to see because of a bright torch. The objects moved to the southeast away from the torch and he was able to see five glowing diamonds with four in formation, and the fifth just behind. As they flew the fifth moved in front very quickly. It was as though they knew I saw them.

When my wife saw them, they were about one hundred feet above us to the northeast. They moved up and away at about 45% angle to about one thousand feet in a short second. All the objects were diamond shaped and glowed in the center. The observer states, "I have always been skeptical of UFOs, but I was wrong this was a close encounter of something unearthly."

Transparent flying triangle(s)

The story 13/06/04 Sandy, Utah. From <http://www.undergroundvine.net/ufo/>. This is a more detailed report than that reported in Filer's Files.

There were four of us in the front yard -Me, my wife, and 2 cousins. We are all in our early twenties. We were just going to our homes from my mother's home, which we visit every Sunday to play a game of Risk, when we found my sister had left her keys in the car. So one of my cousins took the key out and put it on the doorstep because the house was locked behind us.

Then my other cousin pointed up at the sky and my wife and I saw this transparent triangle shape. It flew heading North to South. I could make out the edges because the transparency did not go all the way to the edge. It was kind of just fuzzy on the edges. The object made absolutely no sounds. There seemed to be no emitted light. The sighting lasted all of about 2 seconds before it disappeared from view behind some trees. The cousin who was putting the key on the doorstep did not get to see it there was a porch awning in the way. He ran out after we all said "what the hell is that?". He thought we were lying. After we all described what we saw and speculated what it could have been, we decided to stay there a few minutes to see if it would come back. The cousin that did not see the triangle went out to the middle of the

lawn and started running in circles staring at the Big Dipper. Then he all of a sudden stopped and pointed up.

A smaller triangle had appeared in the sky and was headed from North to more Southeast. It looked more like 2 shaded triangles that may have been linked by a transparent piece or something else. This one had more speed and disappeared into the night sky. At first we thought this one was just ducks or geese, but then realized that they usually make noise when flying and do not fly in such a perfect formation. The cousin that had not seen the first one, now believed us. We stood around and speculated on this one too, we all drew some pictures of what we thought both looked like on the hood of my sisters car, in the dust that was all over it, and the pictures turned out pretty much identical. My younger brother, age 15, heard all the noise we were making and looked out his window. We motioned for him to come down stairs and he did. We explained this all to him then went back to watching the sky. We waited to see if another would appear but after about 20 minutes we decided it is time to go home. All we saw in the 20 minutes was 2 Satellites in the sky right above us. One went north to south the other south to north.

None of us have ever seen anything like this. We all agreed on the shape and transparency of the triangles. We also all agreed that they appeared to be paper-thin. They made no noise at all, and also made no apparent air disturbance that we could feel or see. The night was perfectly clear. Not a cloud in sight or on the horizon. We also could not see the moon in the sky, it might have not risen over the mountains at that point. My cousins went home and found this article on this web page <http://www.nuforc.org/webreports/037/S37316.html> which sparked my interest to post my experience.

There was a sixth craft of the same shape and size flying outside the formation but moving at the same speed and direction. This sixth craft seemed to be leading the others as it moved its position relative to the others occasionally (maybe to signal a change in course). The formation of crafts were traveling west and moved quite rapidly. Although I heard no sound the crafts were fairly high in the sky. The color of the illumination was translucent yellow-orange."

New Zealand - Teardrop UFO

RUBY BAY, NELSON - The observer was down on the beach at 8 PM, looking out across the bay towards the Nelson Harbor. He states, "On June 11, 2004, I saw

a tear drop shaped craft with spinning red lights beaming light into the water." I sprinted to my friend's caravan and got him to look. The teardrop made an electrical humming noise and a thundering sound that could easily be heard by me and the residents of

McKees Domain, Ruby Bay. It moved closer towards the beach sending beams of light across the bay. The craft moved at phenomenal speeds and disappeared and reappeared in different places, it moved up into the sky. The objects seemed to be interested in the aircraft departing and landing at the Nelson Airport.

Over the next hour another six craft appeared in the sky that looked like giant orbs of amber light and over the rest of the night the objects moved around the area. The objects came in close and shot off randomly over the rest of the night until morning. Other camping ground residents also saw it and some reported flat batteries in their cars and dead fish being washed up on the beach in Ruby Bay.

NELSON, B.C.

A couple was traveling north along the Kootenay River on Highway 3A on June 16, 2004, when they saw an egg shaped object which sat stationary over the river at 11:55 PM. Around the center of the egg was a broken ring of blue lights which were very bright, but not flashing. The object was 500 to 600 feet above the river. The husband wanted to stop to investigate, but due to his wife being frightened they kept moving but at a slower pace. A short distance down the highway his wife looked behind and it disappeared. The husband estimates the object had a completely smooth surface that was 40 to 50 feet in length.

UFO lands in Cuba - 20th May 2004

Scott Corrales reports that witnesses in Havana, Cuba saw a UFO land. The Cuban newspaper Juventud Rebelde reports that a UFO was seen near a fairground. It was described as being "a small oval-shaped object, silver-colored and with a metallic tail, [which] landed in open field encircled by trees."

"I was tidying the shelves when a bright light came through the window. It was like a glowing ball with a tail in its lower section. I showed it to my mother quickly and ran outside to see where it would fall," says Raul Beltran. "It lifted off rather perpendicularly and then left through the palm trees. It didn't make any noise nor issue any smoke. The only thing I'm sure of is its size: more or less the size of a pickup truck tire, or thereabouts."

His mother Odalis says, "When my son pointed it out to me, I thought it was a kite or a parachutist, since skydivers drop over EXPOCUBA every so often. After, as it came down, I realized that it could be nothing of the sort, since it was smaller and glowed a lot. It looked like a mirror."

Remigio Sanchez, who works nearby, saw the UFO at about the same time. He says, "It was a powerful glow in the sky, but it was far away so I thought it was a flare. When I got to Odalis's house, she told me that a device had landed nearby."

The grass and small plants at the site where the UFO landed appear burned, although this could be due to the drought.

UFOs stopped and made right angle turn

Note This case is strikingly similar to a 1967 report from Peterborough, England, by a Mr Fairfoot, who witnessed the event in the early hours - 2.15am - of a July morning.

WINDSOR, USA. A pharmacy technician was staring at 12:15 AM, on June 20, 2004, when four translucent balls of red light dashed across the sky from the south, stopped, then made right angled turns to the east. One witness states, "We were starrng in the section of the sky where the Northern Cross lies when all of a sudden four balls of red light dashed across the sky in front of us. I saw four lights, my boyfriend saw three -- the fourth was somewhat behind the others and farther up in the sky. The objects were spread across the sky, dashed in front of us, and then slowed down to a stop before they darted off. I started laughing when they came to a stop because all I could think of was "Oh my God, they are flying in "military V" formation!!!"

7th July, Pennsylvania - Metal Hula Hoop

POLAND - Marilyn Ruben writes, "Dad's cousin and I had a possible UFO sighting on Wednesday, June 30 around 8:30 p.m. driving on state route 224 near the Ohio border." We were returning after a long awaited trek to the old family homestead, so mentally, we were quite alert. I was driving and Eileen was in the passenger seat. The weather was in the 70's, and sunny. Evening was approaching when I noticed about a dozen low flying puffs of what at first appeared to be bonfire smoke blowing above the street from south to north at a height of about 3x that of the farmhouses. Then I realized the smoke was too white to be smoke, and decided it must be very low wisps of clouds. That was when I noticed a solid metal rounded gray ring floating along with the wispy clouds. I asked Eileen if she could see the metal ring, and she indicated she could. We were both amazed and wondered how a metal ring could float over the road without falling down out of the sky? Ironically, Eileen who is a serious skeptic, was the first to ask if this could be a UFO!

The ring had the appearance of a very thick metal "hula hoop," and was the size of two or three fingertips at arm's length. I quickly asked my teenage daughter sitting in the back seat to snap a picture of this, but she said she could not see anything. Meanwhile, Eileen and I watched this light gray circular object which had a distinct dark edge to it, but which was totally transparent inside the circular area because the real clouds higher up in the sky shone through it. The object seemed to be periodically bending in on the side away from us, but that could have been caused by gravity distorting the light waves giving it the appearance of bending. When it went out of my visual range over to Eileen's side of the car, she said it vanished into thin air. Thanks to Marilyn Ruben.

Michigan - Five Oblongs

HOLLY – The witness was driving his mother-in-law home when I spied a reflection in the very upper 1/4 of his windshield that followed them me on June 19, 2004, just after 1 AM. I kept trying to see if it was a reflection from a street light but even when I was not near any lights it was still there. She looked up and forward and he states, "I saw quick flashes of light dance ahead of me, there were five that appeared to be lighted oblong shaped clouds moving overhead just above the Holly donut shop."

Gradually their number dwindled down to four and then three. And they would go strictly in a plain circular motion for awhile and then they would start to dip and dive. It looked as if they were chasing each other. It looked like they may have been playing but their movements were smooth, graceful and beautiful to watch. The air was thick and hazy and there was not a cloud or star in the sky. My mother-in-law saw the same as I saw.

My husband was able to make it in time to see what his mother and I were witnessing. I had him bring my camera but the pictures came out black with nothing in them. Argentina – Huge UFO with Port Holes

LOS CARDONES NATIONAL PARK -- El Tribuno reports that on July 10, 2004, three executives traveling including a surgeon Federico Andolfi, saw a giant UFO "some 100 meters in diameter, in the vicinity of Cachi-pampa near Tin Tin, a mountainous, semi-desertic region at 9:30 PM. "It was gigantic, shining, silent and luminous with portholes". "It was a truly marvelous spectacle," said Susana Urdines, of the Ministry of Education.

It was enormous and flashed without making a sound. It had multicolored lights and gave the appearance of being circular, with portholes all around. It wasn't a natural luminous phenomenon, but a device built by someone. It

Peru – Aircrew Sees UFO

PISCO – An airline pilot rated on B-737 B-757 and B-767 aircraft reported to Air Traffic Control abeam Pisco, Peru that he and other witnesses noticed three very bright slowly moving large objects on February 26, 2004. They passed by us at a distance of 25 miles flying at 20,000 feet. We were at 31,000 feet and there were four crewmembers on our B767-300er that saw it. There also was a Mexicana airliner overhead that noticed the objects as well. The objects were too large and bright to be aircraft and they were flying over the ocean. We called the local Air Traffic Controllers in Lima, but they did not acknowledge they had them on radar. Thanks to Skywatch-International.

Australia – Five UFOs Filmed

GRAFTON N.S.W. -- On July 8, 2004, Grafton based UFO researcher Barry Taylor caught five different UFO's on video. He states, "At 1:18 PM, I was outside waiting to be picked up for a business meeting when I noticed an unusual object at around 2,000 feet slowly heading north." I raced inside and grabbed my video camera and proceeded to film the object for the next five minutes. This object was a UFO 'cluster' with five individual orbs attached together. There were white/pink orbs with black to dark kaki colored 'spheres' attached and clearly protruding off the whitish orbs. The whole 'cluster' rolled and tumbled about during the observation. I left for my meeting and returned. An hour later, the UFO's were still coming overhead, so I filmed. There was a maroon red object approaching at lower altitude heading directly overhead that pulsed slowly. Another object looked like a disc with a flat base, or 'D' shaped. This object also had one black sphere attached to the outside. The object rolled back-and-forth during its flight. The last object seen was a white sphere with an energy halo.

The witness, un-named in this report, states: G'day to you all, I thought I would share with you a recent sight-

ing I had whilst staying at a friends place in the Victorian country side in Australia. I had just left my friend's home to go to the caravan that she had set up for me to stay in while I was visiting. as I

had not had the chance to view the night sky so clearly in years. I spent some time gazing up at the stars. The property was in Dunkeld, which is about 3 hours from Melbourne and was in sight of the Grampians (which is a series of mountains with very dramatic rock formations on them).

I had a good torch which I was using to send beams up into the sky, as I have always been a believer in ufos since my first sighting as a child on the great Australian Bight.

I turned around and saw an object high in the atmosphere that was just hovering near to where I was standing. I shone the torch in its general direction and flicked the torch on and off a few times. The object proceeded to descend towards where I was standing. I did start to worry that maybe it was not the best of ideas to try it as you never know... It was about twice the height of the

house when it was just hanging there. I could see that it was a metallic grid-like pattern underneath with a fair reddish glow. I was thinking about calling out to my friend and her boyfriend to come and see, but I wanted to observe it for as long as I could.

I am not sure how it changed but the next moment I saw it had a pyramid shape and glowed a faint golden colour. I saw 2 spots of light, one was red and one was green on the bottom part of the UFO. I called out to my friend and by the time she and her boyfriend had come outside it had moved about 1 kilometre down to near the neighbour's house (being on a rural property).

They both saw it as a series of bright lights zig zagging in the sky.

Huge "boomerang" buzzes car

HARRISON, USA – The witness was driving home just outside of the city on Lawrenceburg Road on May 21, 2004, at 1:15 AM, when he spotted a very big bright white light above the trees on top of the hill. It was sitting still and, in his own words "as I went around a curve the object started to move slowly, then as it was going over my car it picked up speed and disappeared in a matter of seconds. I then turned onto Brooks Road and as I came around the curve at the top of the hill a boomerang shaped object was sitting in the sky directly over my car shining two white lights down on me. It had red, blue and white lights all along the boomerang shape, some of them blinking and some not. It was big and low enough for me to see that it was huge. I was very scared

but it just sat there and shined its lights on me until I went under it and then I couldn't see it anymore. I lost sight of it behind my car. When I turned right on Bartlett Road, I saw two of the bright white objects, one on my left and the other coming around behind it. I stopped my car, got out and called my brother on my cell phone. The objects started coming in closer and started flying in a big circle that came over my house continuing on in the same pattern for an about an hour.

Occasionally I could hear sound from one but it was a muted hum. It is now 3:58 and has not seen one since 3:06 AM."

Portugal: UFO Photographed and Armed Forces High Command show interest - and Portugal military fires missile At UFO

The Portuguese military fired a ground-to-air missile at the luminous UFO that passed over their country during the early morning hours of Monday, June 7, 2004.

Portuguese ufologist Gregorio Sao Xavier reported that "the cigar-shaped UFO was tracked on radar. It moved in a south-to-north direction. It was reported in the Portuguese newspapers that 'a target on radar' was found at three separate military bases." These included "Beja, south of Evora and north of the Algarve region; Montijo, near Lisboa; and Oporto, the second largest city in Portugal. The news was released by a colonel in the Portuguese Army." "That same day, only one report came from a civilian identifying the trajectory of the unknown object as coming from north to south, and a cigar form was described.

"Some days later, it was reported on Spanish and Ger-

man TV that an official of the Portuguese Army confirmed that a missile had been launched. What most people saw "was trailing smoke from the missile launched at the UFO." "Visual contact with the object was made at the base in Beja," Gregorio added, "A week later, the photo of a cigar-shaped object appeared in a popular (Portuguese) magazine. And a few days later the military officials charged with the investigation of the incident closed the case, calling it an 'unknown object.'" One of the most curious aspects of this case was the multiple sightings of a radar-domed AWACS plane provided by NATO, which was seen flying offshores just west of Cabo de Sines, 120 kilometers south of Lisboa. ENTITIES SEEN AT SILBURY HILL WILTS, UK

FSR 49-2, SUMMER 2004

This previously unpublished sighting took place on the top of Silbury Hill, an ancient man made structure, lying off the A4 road, a few miles out of Marlborough, UK - a popular venue for tourists who travel from all over the world, to visit this and other ancient monuments such as the nearby historical Avebury stones. It involved three young people, Paul Baguley Sonia Bailey, and Robert, from the Leamington spa area. They decided to visit the area during the evening of the 30th of July 1994.

Paul: "We sat looking out over the open countryside. It was a warm night and we noticed what we took to be a bank of fog rolling in towards us from the direction of

Calne, obscuring some of our view near the base of the hill.

At this stage some of the others, who were assembled on the hill decided to move away, (by this time it was about 2am) when I noticed a smell like burning tyres, I looked round and saw a number of flickering orange lights appearing near to the West Kennet Long Barrow on the other side of the A4.

At first I thought these lights were cycle lights, then realised that this was not the case, as the light given off was illuminating the ground below the 'lights'. Then an incredible thing happened. Two objects appeared on the road. They were tetrahedral in shape with what ap-

peared to be a humanoid lit up shape inside—with the light given off from these 'shapes' cutting a swathe through the fog."

Sonya: "We could clearly see the head and shoulders of the occupants, who seemed to be looking for something on the ground. I flashed my torch at 'them', which made them turn round to face us as if acknowledging our presence, at which point I knew from their lack of facial features - such as hair - that they were not human."

The next thing that happened was that the entities seemed to be kneeling down inside the tetrahedron. I shone my torch again, at which point the 'craft' started to move over the ground into a nearby field, before rising up some 10 feet in the air.

Rob, our other companion, was so frightened by what was happening that he fell over backwards, at which stage everything seemed to slow down. I felt as if I was walking through water. I turned round and saw what I can only describe as what looked like a black tarpaulin material covered in wet mist or dew, covering the form of some other people who had fallen asleep. What this material was I cannot say except it wasn't tarpaulin sheeting.

Rob told me to stay put. We looked out over on to the A4 and could see two or three 'light beings' still in their 'craft', although by now these had been joined by three

or four other similar beings.

At this stage we could see car headlights approaching from the Marlborough direction, which could not have been seen from the lower position.

They just knew - it was if they were synchronized with our thoughts, moving out of the way of the car, when a strange thing happened: we saw them decrease in size to what looked like a slit of orange light like door closing, until all that was left was a globe of orange light hovering over the road, which then faded away from sight as if it had never happened."

Authors' Notes: The locality is well known to us, and although we cannot prove that (from any physical evidence left at the scene) that this incident took place, we have no reason to distrust the statements given by the participants, all of whom are known to us, in this matter. This was not the only time we were to encounter strange phenomena in the area. On one visit to Avebury, Dawn photographed what can only be described as an anomalous cloud hovering over the stones, unseen with the naked eye, similar to what we have been picking up at Rendlesham Forest over the last few years.

Another photo taken by Dawn shows (35mm camera) at the base of Adams Grave shows a most unusual object again unseen with the human eye, just before a storm approached.

Report on the Ozark UFO Conference 2004

The Ozark UFO Conference takes place in the first week of April every year in Eureka Springs, Arkansas, and is considered one of the more balanced conferences on the subject compared with some in the U.S. that present sensational material however dubious its origin. Even so, (middle-of-the-road) ufologists still groan at the choice of some speakers here, and we must still carefully pick our way between fact and fiction.

This particular conference has not changed greatly over the years and many of the attendees - such as myself - return year after year as much for the camaraderie that has built up among many of the regulars rather than in the hope of gaining any new insight into the UFO phenomenon. The conference is organised by veteran ufologist (Lou Farish) who lives in the state of Arkansas, and the first such meeting was held in 1989. It all takes place in a large motel complex, the Best Western Inn of the Ozarks with conference facilities for over 600 attendees, against the scenic backdrop of Eureka Springs and the Ozark Mountains. Apart from the lectures by the various speakers, much of the serious discussion of the UFO topic takes place in the evenings between the regulars who tend to congregate in what is known as the Lone Star Bar.

This private bar is traditionally organised by Gary

Massey (of Sulphur Springs, Texas) and a few friends in a specially reserved suite at the conference hotel. The discussions, and indeed the drinking, goes on late into the night and often videotapes of UFO program segments are shown in the bar, played over and over, and subjected to close scrutiny. All conference attendees are usually made welcome in the Lone Star Bar.

Over the past 40 years perception of the UFO subject has changed considerably and likewise long term researchers and UFO conference attendees have often changed their ground too. Back in the 1950s and 1960s most UFO believers speculated in terms of nuts-and-bolts alien spaceships - or flying saucers - and these were thought of in entirely physical terms. The UFO contactees of the 1960s reported meeting physical extraterrestrials and travelling in physical flying saucers. But during the 1970s and 1980s came reports of alien abductions and experiences of a far less material nature sometimes akin to out-of-the-body episodes or astral travel. Then there were cattle mutilations, crop circles, channelled messages from extraterrestrial beings and a weirdness, and a possible psychic dimension, set in that seems to have become an inextricable part of such encounters.

Unsurprisingly, various UFO celebrities sprang to

prominence during these years of metamorphosis of the UFO subject. Some have claimed a special knowledge of what was going on as a result of their research, and some claim to have experienced alien encounters themselves. Often these luminaries have inspired huge excitement and enthusiasm among their audiences, but like the phenomenon itself, these bursts of conviction - and the belief that the aliens will land shortly with all being revealed - soon fade. Some of the old timers at the conferences have seen it all before and nod sagely, no longer knowing whether to believe anything at all. Others cling to their inner certainty that this planet IS being visited by beings from elsewhere and they are the ones most often in denial when fakery is exposed, refusing to be dismayed by successive disappointments of this kind.

Lou Farish welcomed attendees at Eureka Springs and opened the conference at lunchtime on Friday, April 9th. For the next two days the lectures continued almost non-stop. The first lecture, by Don Ledger, was about the Shag Harbour (Canada) incident of October 4th 1967.

Don Ledger and Chris Styles are the authors of the book "Dark Object: The World's Only Government-documented UFO Crash". Witnesses had claimed that a large object with flashing lights, which they had seen, crashed at night into the harbour of this fishing village in Nova Scotia. No aircraft was reported missing, but certainly something was seen burning on the water and navy divers conducted an underwater search some days later, though nothing was found. Unfortunately the case is far too dependent on eyewitness statements and a lot of rather unsatisfactory hearsay evidence. Even so, it made a most fascinating lecture.

Other speakers such as Beverly Trout, an abduction researcher, and veteran researcher Wendelle Stevens gave lectures based mainly on familiar themes. David Rudiak, who had spoken the previous year on deciphering General Ramey's celebrated Roswell telegram (which was said to include the key words "victims of the crash"), this time presented a piece of video footage said to have been taken in 1994 at the USAF's Nellis Range in Nevada allegedly depicting a UFO. It was indeed hard to say what we were looking at and many, including myself, found the footage unconvincing.

In my opinion the best presentation was that given by Grant Cameron who has previously spoken chiefly about things said by former US presidents relating to the UFO subject and their reactions to questions on it. This year his lecture was entitled "The UFO Capital of the World". Grant is a Canadian and lived during his teenage years in the 1960s near Carman, a rural community 40 miles from Winnipeg in Manitoba. This area saw a major UFO flap during this time and large numbers of people had seen strange objects in the skies. He and his friends were most excited by what was going on and spent many hours out on remote highways watching the night skies and sometimes observing strange glowing objects that flew silently across the prairies. Some of the places where these events took place he had revisited and filmed recently and this formed part of his presentation.

So why did the UFOs and their presumed occupants take such an interest in this remote and sparsely inhabited area which straddles the US/Canadian border? Grant Cameron has no doubt of this whatsoever. During the sixties when the Cold War was at its height, the US government was engaged in a vast program of installing nuclear intercontinental ballistic missiles in hundreds of underground silos in (nearby) North Dakota, South Dakota, and Montana. Nearly a thousand missiles were deployed then in silos spaced at roughly ten mile intervals across the northern and central parts of the US Midwest. These were controlled by USAF bases such as those at Minot and Grand Forks in North Dakota, and Malmstrom in Montana. During those times there were quite a number of reports of UFOs seen hovering over these highly secure areas and indeed over missile silos, including a well-known case at Malmstrom AFB. Were alien ufonauts acutely aware of the extreme threat to the human race posed by these nuclear missiles? And did they take measures which would neutralise them if they were ever fired accidentally or in anger? There are many who would tell you the answer is 'yes'.

Nancy Talbott gave a lecture on her crop circle research and once more we were intrigued at her stories of strange events surrounding some of the individuals who were involved with the circles in Holland and in Poland. The similarity of these happenings to events connected with UFO encounters emphasised again the paranormal aspect of the crop circle phenomenon despite the fact that it is generally thought these days that the vast majority of circles are manmade. Whatever the truth of the matter there can be no doubt of Nancy's sincerity as a researcher.

Another speaker was our own Timothy Good from England. Tim is always a polished presenter and he gave us a lecture entitled "UFO Contacts, Mystery Triangles and the European Union". Plenty of interesting material here and he moved effortlessly from one case to another, often ranging back in time to the fifties when "flying saucers" were in their heyday. This is undoubtedly the period Tim likes best, though many of the UFO celebrities of that time, such as George Adamski, are now viewed with a good deal of scepticism.

One other UFO celebrity speaker was Linda Moulton Howe whose presentation was entitled "Earth Mysteries Updates: From Mars to Cuba". Linda is an indefatigable researcher and covers the whole gamut of weird mysteries from cattle mutilations to alien abductions to crop circles and beyond. She is a regular speaker at the Ozark Conference and has a considerable following there. Last year she gave an excellent talk on the Hessdalen light phenomena in Norway and also presented the claims of extraterrestrial contact made by the notorious Brazilian Urandir Fernandes de Oliveira.

During the 2003 Speakers' Panel Discussion I had sharply criticized her promotion of Urandir and his outrageous claims which are generally dismissed as false by most UFO researchers and especially by AJ Gevaerd who has been the leading ufologist in Brazil for over

twenty years. For this disbelief I was quite severely attacked by some of the conference attendees who felt that I had mounted an attack on Linda herself though this was not the case. I'm glad to say that I appear to have been forgiven in 2004 and there was no further talk of the fraudster Urandir.

Controversies of this type rage from time to time and are then forgotten. New cases are presented and once more we set out in our quest for the truth behind the UFO mystery. Again and again we come away puzzled or disappointed, but some of us keep going back for more. I think

most of the old timers realise that we shall never know the truth, never find "one solution" – at any rate one in terms with which we are familiar. These things are seen through a glass darkly (to use a Biblical phrase) and there are no clearcut answers. Nevertheless, there are many of us who will continue to attend UFO conferences, such as the excellent Ozark conference in Eureka Springs which has become very much part of our lives.

The Real Wonderland – by Richard M Dolan

Dateline: August 5th 2004 Unless you consciously look for such news, you would never know that UFOs continue to be seen by people every day around the world. The difference between the reality of the phenomena, and how it is ignored, reminds me of what Alice experienced when she jumped down the rabbit hole into Wonderland.

But the twist in our society is that the reality of UFO experience is part of the normal, topside world, while mainstream media coverage is part of Wonderland. Indeed, our mainstream media has become so incompetent and downright screwy, our political and corporate leaders such self-serving liars, and our common culture so escapist and empty-headed, that I think "Wonderland" describes this warped reality quite well.

Ironic that UFOs are considered to be "bizarre" by the official, Wonderland, culture. But then again, maybe not so ironic. It's astonishing when I reflect on this. In my personal life, outside of my "ufological" world, I have probably spoken to 120 to 150 people who have shared their personal UFO experiences with me.

Basically, they find out that I write on this subject and soon confide to me something they often haven't even told their close friends – sometimes not even their spouse.

Last week, yet again, a person I met in Wonderland told me about her reality on the topside. This was an encounter from back in 1975, when she was a high school student and witnessed an enormous aerial object hovering low over a building in Rochester, New York, the town where I have lived these past nineteen years.

It was late fall, at a time (unbeknownst to her) when there were quite a few military UFO sightings along the northern U.S. border. The object was dark and huge, she said to me. It was absolutely not anything of human origin, she maintains. She never reported this anywhere, and in fact has hardly told anyone after nearly 30 years.

Another person I know – someone who is a fairly well-known celebrity in Western New York State – had a UFO sighting just outside Syracuse. It was late afternoon on a sunny day. Driving with a friend, in the small town of Manlius, this person asked his companion if she could see the large object outside her window.

She answered, "I'm really glad you mentioned that, because I didn't know what I was going to tell you." According to this person (who also never reported his sighting to any organization), he and his companion got out of the car and watched what

he described as "right out of a Steven Spielberg movie."

It was a classic flying saucer. Silent, hovering over trees, "as large as a football field." It has rotating lights around the perimeter - red, green, and yellow, as he recalled. The object wasn't doing anything - merely hovering silently and impossibly in broad daylight.

Not surprisingly, my acquaintance was rather startled. "If we're seeing this thing," he decided, "other people have to be seeing it as well." Sure enough, a light commercial aircraft flew by, which he maintains had to have seen the object. At around the same time, a news traffic helicopter - "Eye in the Sky," as he described it - was in the vicinity. He assumed at the time that the crew on board had video equipment and was filming the amazing object.

Then, about a minute or two later, two fighter planes, probably F-15s, buzzed by this object. At this point, it took off "like a bullet." In the time it takes to snap your fingers, it was gone. No sound at all. "It's a good thing it left when it did," he said to me, "since I was about to dive into my car to get the hell out of there."

The kicker of the story is this. He was sure that this would be on the T.V. news that night, and stayed up till 11 p.m., specifically to hear the much anticipated report about a massive UFO seen just outside Syracuse. But not only was there no story on any UFO, but it seemed to him as though the talking heads in Wonderland went out of their way to downplay anything odd at all. The new announcer actually said, "another boring day in Syracuse."

I recall the words of singer and composer Gil Scott-Heron: "The revolution will not be televised."

In Wonderland, reality is upside down. Living in this world is like living on a nonstop LSD trip, in which the "reality" we are being fed bears little to no resemblance to the actual experiences of people. In Wonderland, UFOs are imaginary. Unfortunately for Wonderland's managers, the operators of those imaginary UFOs don't seem to get the message. ~ Richard Dolan is Senior Editor of Phenomena Magazine, and author of "UFOs and the National Security State" (Volume One: 1941 to 1973). ***It was silvery in color, had a bun-shaped top, a flange like two saucers in the middle and a bun underneath, and could not have been far off because it overlapped my wind-screen! — RAF fighter pilot, 1954.**

August 6th 2004:- Alien message 'may be in our DNA'

Forget waiting for ET to call - the most likely place to find an alien message is in our DNA.

Professor Paul Davies, from the Australian Centre for Astrobiology at Macquarie University in Sydney, believes a cosmic greeting card could have been left in every human cell. The coded message would only be discovered once the human race had the technology to read and understand it.

Writing in New Scientist magazine, Prof Davies said the idea should be considered seriously. For more than 40 years astronomers have been sweeping the skies with radio telescopes hoping to catch a signal from an alien civilisation. So far the search has been in vain. But Prof Davies believes it is wrong to assume that extraterrestri-

als who may be hundreds of millions of years ahead of us technologically will have chosen to communicate by radio.

Leaving artefacts for humans to find once they are sufficiently evolved - like the obelisk in the movie 2001: A Space Odyssey - might be a more attractive strategy, he said. But ensuring the survival of such an artefact over possibly millions of years would be difficult.

A better solution would be to incorporate information into the human genome, allowing it to be copied and maintained over immense periods of time.

One way to do this might be to deliver alien viruses which could infect cells with message-laden DNA, said Prof Davies.
